### LSU SERIES RECORDS VS. KANSAS STATE, NEBRASKA & SAM HOUSTON

• LSU has a 12-8 all-time mark vs. Kansas State; the teams last met in the 2023 Karcher Round Rock (Texas) Classic, where the Tigers posted a 7-3 victory over the Wildcats ... LSU is 1-0 all-time vs. Nebraska; the teams' only meeting came in the 2015 Astros College Classic in Houston, where the Tigers recorded a 4-2 win over the Cornhuskers ... LSU is 2-0 all-time vs. Sam Houston, and the teams most recently met in the 2023 Karcher Round Rock (Texas) Classic, where the Tigers logged a 16-4 win over the Bearkats.

### ABOUT THE TIGERS

• LSU has seven national championships (1991, 1993, 1996, 1997, 2000, 2009, 2023), the second-most in NCAA history ... LSU has the second-highest all-time NCAA Tournament winning pct. (.705, 177-74).

• LSU opened this week with a 7-3 win over No. 17 Dallas Baptist Wednesday night at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas ... second baseman Daniel Dickinson homered and drove in three runs, and starting pitcher Conner Ware threw 4.0 perfect innings to lead the Tigers' effort ... LSU leadoff hitter Derek Curiel sparked the Tigers' 12-hit offensive attack by reaching base five times in six plate appearances ... he was 2-for-3 at the plate with one double, three runs, two walks and one hit-by-pitch ... Ware retired the first 12 batters he faced before allowing a leadoff homer in the fifth ... Ware threw 60 pitches over 4.0 innings with no walks and six strikeouts.

• Junior first baseman Jared Jones is batting .474 (9-for-19) in the Tigers' last five games with two doubles, one homer, 10 RBI and five runs while recording a .560 on-base percentage ... Jones was 3-for-5 in last Saturday's 12-1 win over Omaha with a double, one run scored and five RBI, and he was 2-for-2 in Monday's win over Nicholls with a homer, three RBI and two runs scored.

• Freshman leftfielder Derek Curiel is hitting .389 (7-for-18) in LSU's last five games with two doubles, one RBI and seven runs ... Curiel is hitting a team-high .438 (14-for-32) this season with two doubles, one homer, 11 runs and seven RBI.

• Shortstop Steven Milam is batting .389 (7-for-18) in LSU's last five games with one double, one homer, six RBI and five runs ... Milam recorded a career-high five RBI in Monday's win Nicholls, as he was 2-for-3 at the plate with a three-run homer.

• Sophomore left-hander Kade Anderson pitched a career-high 5.1 innings in last Friday's win over Omaha, limiting the Mavericks to two runs on three hits with two walks and eight strikeouts ... Anderson is 2-0 this season with a 1.74 ERA, three walks and 16 strikeouts in 10.1 innings.

• Junior right-hander Anthony Eyanson delivered an excellent outing versus Omaha last Saturday, working 6.0 shutout innings while allowing just three hits with two walks and seven strikeouts.

• Redshirt sophomore right-hander Chase Shores defeated Omaha last Saturday, firing 5.0 shutout innings with three hits, two walks and six strikeouts ... Shores threw 84 pitches, 55 for strikes ... the outing marked Shores' second appearance since missing the 2024 season while recovering from Tommy John surgery; he was injured in March 2023 and returned to the mound on February 16 of this season versus Purdue Fort Wayne.

• **Coach Jay Johnson**, the 2023 National Coach of the Year, is in his fourth season at the helm of the LSU program ... Johnson, who directed LSU to the 2023 NCAA National Championship, has worked 13 seasons as a collegiate head coach, including one season (2005) at Point Loma Nazarene, two seasons (2014-15) at Nevada, six seasons (2016-21) at Arizona and four seasons at LSU ... he directed Arizona to College World Series appearances in 2016 and in 2021, and to the 2021 Pac-12 title ... **he has a 462-235 (.663) overall record, including a 145-63 (.697) mark at LSU.**

• Baseball America magazine has rated LSU's newcomer class of D1 transfers, freshmen signees and JUCO transfers No. 1 in the nation for the 2025 season. LSU's class of newcomers includes 12 NCAA Division I transfers, four JUCO transfers and 10 high school signees. Nine LSU players were ranked in August among Baseball America magazine's Top 100 College Transfers, and 11 LSU newcomers appeared in the Baseball America Top 500 Prospects list for the 2024 MLB Draft that was held in July.

• Junior first baseman **Jared Jones** has been named to the 2025 Golden Spikes Award Watch List. Jones, a native of Marietta, Ga., was ranked No. 1 last week on the D1Baseball.com list of the Top 50 First Basemen in the nation. D1 Baseball also named Jones a 2025 Preseason First-Team All-American. Jones hit .301 (69-for-229) for LSU last season with 14 doubles, two triples, 28 homers, 59 RBI and 56 runs. His 28 home runs marked the fourth-most in LSU history and the most by a Tiger since first baseman Matt Clark also hit 28 in 2008. Jones, a 2023 Freshman All-American, finished the 2024 season No. 2 in the SEC in walks (59), No. 5 in home runs, No. 5 in slugging percentage (.747) and No. 9 in total bases (171).

• Sophomore left-hander **Kade Anderson** is rated No. 17 on the D1 Baseball list of the Top 150 Starting Pitchers in the nation. Anderson, a 2025 Baseball America Preseason All-American, recorded an outstanding 2024 freshman season for LSU, making 18 appearances (nine starts) and posting a 4-2 mark with a 3.99 ERA and 59 strikeouts in 38.1 innings. The native of Madisonville, La., was especially effective in the postseason, working 2.1 scoreless innings over two NCAA Chapel Hill Regional appearances on the same day (June 2 vs. Wofford and North Carolina) with two hits, one walk and six strikeouts.

• Junior right-hander **Gavin Guidry** has been named to the 2025 NCBWA Stopper of the Year Preseason Watch List. Guidry, a 2025 Preseason All-America and All-SEC selection, made 22 relief appearances last season for the Tigers, posting a 2-0 mark, a 2.59 ERA and three saves in 24.1 innings with 18 walks and 36 strikeouts. The native of Lake Charles, La., pitched a combined 4.2 innings in LSU's SEC and NCAA postseason games, allowing just one unearned run on three hits with six strikeouts and one save.

• LSU outfielder **Derek Curiel** was named in January the 2025 SEC Preseason Freshman of the Year by D1Baseball.com. Curiel, two-time member of the 18U USA National Team, batted .314 with 33 hits - including 10 doubles - 21 RBI and 19 stolen

bases in his senior year at Orange Lutheran High School in West Covina, Calif. He was ranked as the No. 10 overall high school player in the country and as the second-best high school player in the state of California by Perfect Game. Also in January, Perfect Game ranked Curiel No. 1 on its list of the Top 75 Freshmen for the 2025 season.

• Eight LSU freshmen were included in January on the Perfect Game list of the Top 75 Freshmen for the 2025 season, including outfielder **Derek Curiel** (No. 1), right-handed pitcher **William Schmidt** (No. 4), catcher **Cade Arrambide** (No. 15); right-handed pitcher **Casan Evans** (No. 26); first baseman **Ryan Costello** (No. 32); right-handed pitcher **Mavrick Rizy** (No. 36); left-handed pitcher **Cooper Williams** (No. 67); and infielder **Mikey Ryan** (No. 69).

• D1 Baseball in October named **LSU the No. 1 college program in the nation, completing its ranking of the Top 100 College Programs** that began in September. D1 Baseball's ranking of the Top 100 Programs focused upon the establishment of a tradition of consistent winning in the last decade, and especially in the last five years. Its goal was to identify the programs in the best shape right now, with an eye toward the next five to 10 years. LSU was followed in the Top 10 of the ranking by Tennessee, Florida, Vanderbilt, Arkansas, Virginia, Texas A&M, Mississippi State, Texas and Florida State.

• **Jay Johnson** has produced **12 Top 5 round and 16 Top 10 round draft choices at LSU**, including the 2023 No. 1 overall selection, right-handed pitcher Paul Skenes (Pittsburgh), the 2023 No. 2 overall pick, outfielder Dylan Crews (Washington) and the 2022 No. 6 overall selection, infielder Jacob Berry (Miami).

• **LSU in 2023 became the first school in history** to produce the first two selections in a single MLB Draft when Paul Skenes and Dylan Crews were chosen Nos. 1 and 2. Each made his big-league debut in 2024, and Skenes became just the fifth rookie in MLB history to start on the mound in an All-Star Game.

• **An SEC-record** 13 LSU players were selected in the 2023 MLB Draft, including five in the first three rounds. A total of nine LSU players were chosen in the 2024 MLB Draft, including eight pitchers, a mark that **tied the SEC record** for most pitchers drafted in a single season.

- No. 2 in the SEC in strikeouts (116), opponent batting average (.167) and innings pitched (85.0) ... No. 3 in the league in ERA (2.54)  
Named to the SEC All-Tournament Team after defeating Kentucky on May 22 -- worked 6.0 scoreless innings, allowing no hits with two walks and seven strikeouts ... fired 100 pitches in the outing, 63 for strikes
- Defeated Ole Miss on May 17, limiting the Rebels to two runs on five hits in 6.2 innings with no walks and nine strikeouts ... Holman retired 10 straight Ole Miss hitters to begin his outing, and he retired 16 of 17 batters through his first 5.1 innings
- Defeated Alabama (May 11), working 5.2 innings against his former team, limiting the Tide to one earned run on four hits with four walks and two Ks
- Recorded 10 strikeouts in 5.0 innings vs. top-ranked Texas A&M (May 4), allowing three runs on three hits with five walks
- Pitched 6.2 innings vs. Auburn (April 27), allowing just one earned run on two hits with three walks and nine strikeouts
- Delivered an excellent performance on April 13 at Tennessee, holding the SEC's top offensive team without a hit for the first 5.1 innings of his outing ... Holman worked a total of 5.2 innings, allowing just two runs on two hits with three walks and four strikeouts
- Posted a win over sixth-ranked Vanderbilt on April 4, limiting the Commodores to four earned runs on four hits in 5.2 innings with no walks and 10 strikeouts ... he threw 97 pitches in the outing, recording 62 for strikes, and he pitched 4.1 perfect innings before allowing a Vanderbilt baserunner in the fifth inning
- Defeated sixth-ranked Florida on March 22, limiting the Gators to one run on one hit in 6.0 innings with three walks and a career-high 13 strikeouts ... he threw 104 pitches in the outing, recording 65 for strikes, and he allowed only two Florida players to advance beyond second base ... Holman retired nine straight Florida batters to complete his outing, including four by strikeouts
- Fired 6.0 scoreless and hitless innings on March 8 in a win over Xavier ... Holman limited the Musketeers to no hits with two walks and 10 strikeouts ... he threw 97 pitches in the outing, recording 59 pitches for strikes, and he did not allow a Xavier player to advance beyond second base ... Holman retired nine straight Xavier batters to complete his outing, including six by strikeouts
- Worked 5.2 shutout innings March 1 in a win over No. 13 Texas in the Astros Foundation College Classic ... Holman limited the Longhorns to three hits with one walk and a career-high 12 strikeouts ... he threw 91 pitches in the outing, recording 61 pitches for strikes ... he retired nine of the final 10 batters he faced to complete his outing ... for the effort, he was named SEC Co-Pitcher of the Week on March 4 ... he was also voted NCBWA National Pitcher of the Month for February, and he was named to the Astros Foundation College Classic All-Tournament team
- Fired seven shutout innings Feb. 24 in a win over Northern Illinois ...
