2004 Kent State University Gymnastics NCAA Central Regional- April 2, 2004 Louisiana State University-Baton Rouge, La.

KENT, Ohio—The 24th-ranked Kent State University gymnastics team (11-2, 5-1 MAC) makes its second straight trip to the 2004 Central Regional Championship on the campus of Louisiana State University April 2. The Flashes are part of the six-team field that includes No. 17 Arizona State University, No. 23 Auburn University, No. 6 Brigham Young University, No. 7 LSU and No. 26 Michigan State University. The top two finishers will advance to the NCAA Championships at Pauley Pavilion in Los Angeles, Calif. The meet is slated to begin at 6 p.m. CST at the Maravich Center in Baton Rouge, La. Live stats for the meet will be available online at www.lsusports.com.

SCOUTING THE CENTRAL REGIONAL: Brigham Young (15-5) comes in as the top seed in the meet with a regional qualifying score of 197.525. The sixth-ranked BYU squad is led by **Kari Lords**, who is the second-ranked gymnast on beam and 11th-ranked on bars.

Host LSU (14-2) is coming off a third-place finish at the SEC Championships where **April Burkholder** was named the SEC Gymnast of the Year, a year after being named the SEC Freshman of the Year. The No. 7 Tigers are the second-seeded team in the field.

Courtney Puckett and **Rachael Tarantino** led the Tigers to a fifth-place finish at the SEC Championships. Puckett placed sixth on beam while Tarantino finished sixth on floor. Auburn come into Friday's regional meet as the third-seed.

No. 17 Arizona State (10-6) is the fourth seed after the Sun Devils tied for fourth at the PAC-10 Championships. **Ashley Kelly** ranks third nationally on the all-around with a 39.665 qualifying average.

The Flashes are the fourth seed in the meet, followed by the Spartans. **Victoria Iakounina** received 2004 Big 10 Freshman of the Year honors while head coach **Kathie Klages** shared the Big 10 Coach of the Year award.

KENT STATE VS. THE REGIONAL FIELD: Kent State will see new competition at the NCAA Central Regional as the Flashes did not compete against any team in the field this season. In the school's all-time dual-meet series history, KSU has only faced Michigan State and holds a 10-19 record against the Spartans.

THE GOLDEN FLASHES REGIONAL HISTORY: This year marks the 16th time in school history that Kent State has advanced to regional competition, including the 12th time in 14 years.

The Flashes had five different individual champions in the Northeast Regional Championships before moving to the Central Region. In 1997, **Michelle Naessig** won the all-around competition with a score of 39.125. That same year, **Sarah Wolford** took the vault with a score of 9.875. In 1996, **Shelly Stambaugh** won the vault with a score of 9.925. A year earlier, **Rachel Coury** took the beam title, posting a 9.700 and in 1978, **Patti Dannemillen** won the vault with a 9.250.

2003 NCAA CENTRAL REGIONAL: The 21st-ranked Kent State gymnastics team completed its successful 2003 season with a sixth-place finish at the NCAA Central Regional in Tuscaloosa, Ala. April 12. The Golden Flashes tallied a 193.950 while the University of Alabama won the meet with a 197.550.

Kent State had three gymnasts finish in the top 25 on bars. Senior **Jenny Eckel** (Milford, Ohio/Milford) tied for fourth on bars with a 9.825, sophomore **Morgan**

Wiland (Columbus, Ohio/Hilliard-Davidson) tied for 10th with a 9.800, while sophomore **Erika Linnersten** (Cincinnati, Ohio/Finneytown) tied for 15th with a 9.775.

Linnersten also finished 24th on beam with a 9.775.

Sophomore **Earline Feugill** (Weston, Fla./Western) had two top-25 finishes. She tied for 19th on beam (9.800) and vault (9.750).

Junior **Jessie James** (Reynoldsburg, Ohio/Reynoldsburg) tied for 14th on the all-around with a 38.750.

FLASHES TAKE THE SILVER MEDAL AT 2004 MAC

CHAMPIONSHIPS: Posting three top-five career marks on beam, floor and team total, the Kent State University gymnastics team finished second at the 2004 Mid-American Conference (MAC) Championships Friday (March 19) in Mount Pleasant, Mich.

It came down to the last event, but the hosting Chippewas clinched the title for the second straight season, edging the Golden Flashes 197.525-196.850.

KSU's team total was the third-best total in school history. The Flashes also tied for the second-best beam total (49.350) and tied for the fifth-best floor score (49.525) in the Kent State record books.

Junior **Earline Feugill** (Weston, Fla./Western) was named to the All-MAC First Team after sharing the gold medal on floor with a 9.950. Feugill also tied for second on beam with a 9.925.

Senior **Jessie James** (Reynoldsburg, Ohio/Reynoldsburg) placed in three events on her way to an All-MAC second team selection. She tied for second on floor (9.925) and took home a bronze medal on vault (9.900) and all-around (39.450). James was the 2004 MAC Co-Senior Gymnast of the Year.

Junior **April Zentko** (Poland, Ohio/Poland) also received an All-MAC second team nod after a fourth-place finish on beam with a 9.900.

Senior **Morgan Wiland** (Columbus, Ohio/Hilliard-Davidson) tied for third on the event with a 9.875.

JAMES NAMED 2004 CO-SENIOR GYMNAST OF THE

YEAR: Kent State University gymnast **Jessie James** (Reynoldsburg, Ohio/Reynoldsburg) was selected as the co-recipient of the Mid-American Conference (MAC) Senior Gymnast of the Year award. She shared the honor with Bowling Green State University's **Melissa Popovich**.

A two-time MAC Gymnast of the Week, James ranks among the top 10 gymnasts in the conference on all five events; she is tied for the top floor score (10.000) and the third-best all-around score (39.525). She became the first KSU gymnast to tally a perfect 10 on floor and the second in MAC history Feb. 20.

Currently, she is tied for 24th in the nation and sits tied for fifth in the Central Region on the floor exercise with a 9.930 regional qualifying average. James is also tied for fifth in the all-around in the Central Region with a 39.130 regional qualifying average.

A team tri-captain, James is the school's career scoring leader and ranks in the top 10 on all five events on KSU's career list. She also was named the MAC Freshman of the Year in 2001.

FEUGILL NAMED TO THE ACADEMIC ALL-MAC

TEAM: Kent State University gymnast **Earline Feugill** (Weston, Fla./Western) was named to the 2004 Academic All-Mid-American Conference (MAC) gymnastics team, the organization announced.

Feugill, a junior nursing major with a 3.490 cumulative grade-point average (GPA), was an All-MAC first

team selection after sharing the gold medal on floor at the MAC Championships March 19. She also tied for second on beam with a 9.925. On the season, she has tallied a 9.900 or better on floor in all but one meet and tied the then-school record on floor for the second time in her career with a 9.975 Feb. 13. She also recorded a 9.975 on beam Feb. 1, which is tied for the third-best beam score in school history. All told, Feugill has won four floor titles and currently is tied for 19th nationally on the event with a 9.935 regional qualifying average.

MAC STANDINGS: According to the Mid-American Conference (MAC) weekly release March 22, the Golden Flashes boast the top score on bars (49.350) and beam (49.600) and the second-best scores on vault (49.025), floor (49.525) and team total (197.050).

Individually, several Kent State gymnasts are posted on the league's top performance list. **Jessie James** (Reynoldsburg, Ohio/Reynoldsburg) has the top floor score (10.000), tied for sixth on vault (9.900), tied for eighth on beam (9.925), tied for third on the all-around (39.525) and tied for 10th on bars (9.875).

On beam, **Erika Linnersten** (Cincinnati, Ohio/Finneytown) and **Earline Feugill** (Weston, Fla./Western) are tied for first with a 9.975, while **April Zentko** (Poland, Ohio/Poland) is tied for fourth with a 9.950. Feugill also is tied for third on floor (9.975). **Morgan Wiland** (Columbus, Ohio/Hilliard-Davidson) shares the first spot on bars with a 9.950 and tied for eighth on beam with a 9.925. Linnersten is tied for fifth on bars with a 9.900. Zentko is eighth on the all-around (39.350) while sophomore **Carrie Mayle** (Fremont, Ohio/St. Joseph's) is ninth in the event with a score of 39.200.

BIGGIN NABS 100th CAREER VICTORY: Kent State's wins over George Washington and Bowling Green helped propel head coach **Brice Biggin** (Kent State '83) past the 100-win plateau Feb. 20. In 12 seasons at the helm of the Golden Flashes, he has compiled a career record of 102-65 (.611). Biggin is the third Kent State coach to reach that milestone this season, joining head field hockey coach **Kerry DeVries** and head volleyball coach **Mora Kanim**.

Since being named head coach in 1992, Biggin has been selected the MAC Coach of the Year five times (1993, 1994, 1996, 2001 and 2003), NCAA Northeast Region Coach of the Year two times (1995 and 1996) and NCAA Central Region Coach of the Year in 2001. Biggin has led the Golden Flashes to MAC championships on four different occasions (1994, 1996, 1997 and 2001). During his tenure, Biggin has coached 12 different All-MAC gymnasts, four NCAA regional champions and one All-American.

TWO FLASHES RECEIVES WEEKLY LEAGUE HONOR: Senior tri-captains **Morgan Wiland** (Columbus, Ohio/Hilliard-Davidson) and **Jessie James** (Reynoldsburg, Ohio/Reynoldsburg) received Mid-American Conference (MAC) Gymnast of the Week honors for the 2004 season.

Wiland was a co-recipient Feb. 2, while James was named twice (Feb. 23 and March 15).

Wiland received the honor after she took the bars crown with a then-career-high 9.925 against Eastern Michigan University Jan. 30. Two days later she bettered her personal-best as she tied the school's individual bars record with a 9.950.

James won her first award of the season after leading the Flashes to a pair of wins over Bowling Green State University and George Washington University Feb. 20. She became the first Kent State gymnast and the MAC gymnast (at the time) to register at perfect 10 on floor. She also notched a career-best 9.925 on beam in helping KSU set a school record on beam with a 49.600 composite score.

For the week of March 15, James led the Flashes to a school-record team score of 197.050 against Western Michigan University March 14. She won vault (9.875) and all-around (39.525) while tying for second on floor (9.925) and third on beam (9.900). James' all-around mark is the third-best score in school history.

WILAND DOES IT AGAIN: As if tying the school record on bars wasn't good enough, senior tri-captain **Morgan Wiland** (Columbus, Ohio/Hilliard-Davidson) did it again against the University of Pittsburgh Feb. 13. She registered a 9.950 to win her sixth consecutive bars title of the season and helped the Golden Flashes tally the fifth-best bars score in KSU history for the second time. She first recorded the mark Feb. 1 and was named the MAC Co-Gymnast of the Week Feb. 2, after leading KSU to two school-record scores on bars against Eastern Michigan University and NIU.

OUT WITH THE OLD: During the course of the 2004 season, Kent State rewrote the team record book 14 times, including all five beam records. The '04 Flashes hold the all-time beam record with 49.600 (vs. Bowling Green and George Washington Feb. 20) and the all-time team total record with 197.050 (vs. Western Michigan March 14).

"We're obviously real excited to compete at LSU. All six of the teams are ranked in the top 26 in the country so we're really looking forward to the competition."

On the atmosphere of the NCAA Regionals:

"We know that Baton Rouge is a great sports town so we're excited about the fans the meet will draw and we can't wait."

On Kent State's game plan:

"We're hoping to accomplish what we've done all season long. We want to be consistent. We want to concentrate, make our routines and represent the Mid-American Conference in a positive way."
