When Marcus Randall connected with Devery Henderson on a 75-yard touchdown pass as time expired in LSU's 33-30 win over Kentucky last year in Lexington, many people called it the greatest ending to a football game in school history. While the debate rages on as to which play was the greatest in school history, "The Bluegrass Miracle" certainly ranks with Billy Cannon's "Halloween Run" in 1959, Jones-to-Davis in 1972 and Hodson-to-Fuller in 1988 among the best moments in LSU football history.



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Nick Saban

In 2003, Nick Saban will attempt to become the first LSU coach since Charles McClendon to lead the Tigers to four straight winning seasons. In three years with LSU, Saban has taken the Tigers to an SEC title and back-to-back New Year's Day bowl games for the first time since the 1960s.



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A Look Back at 2002

Bradie James capped an outstanding four-year career at LSU by earning First-Team All-America honors, leading the Tigers to an 8-5 overall mark and a berth in the Cotton Bowl. The "James Gang" defense ranked among the nation's best by allowing 286 yards and 18 points a contest.
