**Entry Information and Instructions**

**Entry Limitations**

1. Each school may enter two athletes per individual event. An athlete may not be entered in more than four events.
2. A school may enter unlimited athletes in the pole vault.
3. Each school may enter one relay team per relay event.
4. All schools must be in good standing with LHSAA and out of state respective high school athletic associations. No clubs will be allowed to compete in the high school divisions.

**Entry Procedure**

1. All entries will be done electronically through [www.directathletics.com](http://www.directathletics.com). A link to this site can also be found by accessing [www.lsusports.net](http://www.lsusports.net), clicking on Track and Field, then on 2010 Meet Info. You should set your account up in advance of the deadline to avoid any problems.
2. Entry Deadline is 11:30 PM, Monday, March 22. Entries may be made as early as Thursday, March 18. You may make changes as often as you wish until the entry deadline.
3. No Faxed or Phoned entries will be accepted.

**Entry Fees**

1. Entry fees are \$5 per individual athlete entered, even those on just the relays, with a maximum charge of \$50 per team (men and women are considered separate teams). This fee must be paid prior to the meet at packet pickup.
2. Relays and the athletes participating in relays must be entered.
3. Only school checks, cash, or money orders will be accepted. Purchase orders and personal checks will not be accepted.
4. This entry fee will provide tickets for all athletes and 5 extra passes for coaches and support staff per gender.
5. Make checks payable to **LSU TRACK & FIELD OFFICIAL's ASSOCIATION**.

2. Performance list will reflect all accepted and rejected athletes and section assignments.

**Minimum Marks and Starting Heights**

For each field event there will be a minimum mark. Efforts less than this distance will not be measured. In the vertical jumps, the starting height will serve as the minimum mark. These marks are:

| Triple Jump | 40-0       | 28-0         |
| Pole Vault  | 10-0       | 8-0          |

**Section Guidelines**

1. All Relay entries will be accepted.
2. In Field Events, the top 36 entries will be accepted. The pole vault will accept the top 32 entries.
3. In the 1600 Meters, the Top 16 Entries will be accepted into the 1600 Meter A Section, others will be placed in the B Section.

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## **Meet Information**

### **MEET SITE**

Bernie Moore Track Stadium is a 5,280-seat facility with two tracks, a 400-meter oval and an interior sprint/hurdle straightaway. Both tracks have nine 42" lanes. Field event areas include three dual directional horizontal jump runways, four dual directional pole vault runways, two shot put areas including six circles, and a multi-purpose high jump area within the oval capable of contesting three high jump competitions at once. At the south end are a synthetic javelin runway, two hammer/discus rings and cages, and two additional discus rings and cages. Bernie Moore Track Stadium is located on the LSU Campus off Nicholson Drive.

### **PARKING**

Parking is available at Bernie Moore Track Stadium off Nicholson Drive, and in the lot at Tiger Stadium.

### **PACKET PICKUP**

Coaches should pick up their team's meet packet prior to competing at Gate 1 (athletes and coaches entrance) at the northwest corner of Bernie Moore Track. Packet Pickup hours are as follows:

Friday, March 26:        11:00 AM – 5:30 PM  
Saturday, March 27:    7:45 AM – Noon

### **MEET PACKETS**

Team packets will include heat sheets, time schedule, relay cards, meet tickets for athletes, and five additional meet tickets for coaches and support staff per gender.

### **MEET ADMISSION**

Athletes and Coaches: Enter at Gate 1 by presenting your meet ticket.

General Public: Enter at Gate 3. Cost is \$6 per day, \$3 for children aged 12 and under on Friday and Saturday.

### **DRESSING FACILITIES**

Locker room and shower facilities are available in the Fieldhouse for both men and women during meet hours. You must furnish your own towels.

### **TRAINING AREA**

Trainers will be available in the Maravich Assembly Center Training Room, near the backstretch of Bernie Moore Track, for emergencies. Team Trainers will be allowed to set in the Carl Maddox Fieldhouse warm up area or on Maravich Assembly Center Lower Concourse just east of Bernie Moore Track.

### **SEATING**

Athletes and coaches must only use sections 1, 2, 10 and 11 in the lower deck. Other sections are reserved for ticket holders.

### **TIME SCHEDULE**

A copy of the tentative time schedule is enclosed. Running event times are approximate. A revised schedule will be in your packet, and will be posted on the web site [www.lsusports.net](http://www.lsusports.net) Wednesday, March 24 at 9:00 AM. Go to Track and Field and click on LSU Tiger Relay Heat Sheets.

### **UNATTACHED ENTRIES**

Unattached entries are not permitted. All athletes must compete with an affiliation.

### **SPECIAL MEET RULE(S)**

- No radios or portable stereos will be allowed through the gates of Bernie Moore Track Stadium. Please remind your athletes of this policy. (Walkman-type individual radios are OK.)

### **PERFORMANCE LISTS & RESULTS**

Performance lists will be posted on the web site [www.lsusports.net](http://www.lsusports.net) Wednesday, March 24 at 9:00 AM. Go to Track and Field and click on LSU Tiger Relays Heat Sheets. They will also be in your packet at check in. Individual event results will be posted on the concourse of Bernie Moore Stadium. Final results will be available from the press box after the meet, and will be posted on the same web site.

### **PREMEET PRACTICE**

Bernie Moore Track will not be available for team practice.

### **RELAY CARDS**

Relay teams should pick up a relay card in the Clerking area, fill it out, and turn it in to the clerk of course. This constitutes the checking for the relay event.

### **ATHLETE CHECK-IN**

Running events: Athletes must check in one event prior to their own event at the check-in area. This area is located at the northwest corner of Bernie Moore Track near the athlete's entrance (Gate 1).

Field events: Athletes must check in 15 minutes prior to the start of their event with the Head Judge of that event at the event site.

### **QUALIFYING**

In the 100 meters, 100/110 hurdles, 400 hurdles, and relay events with qualifying heats, the top 9 times from the preliminary rounds will advance to the final. In straightaway qualifying races, boys will run on the gold straightaway track, while girls will run on the west straightaway of the red oval. All other running events will be multiple section finals against time. In the field events, the top 7 marks for the preliminary rounds will advance to the finals.

### **SCORING**

The Meet will be scored in Boys and Girls Divisions, no team awards will be given.

### **IMPLEMENT WEIGH-IN**

Implement inspections will be held in the weigh in facility, located in the LSU Track and Field Pavilion and accessible through Gate 1B. Inspections for all throwing events will begin according to the schedule below, and will terminate one hour prior to the scheduled start of competition in each throwing event. Implements will be transported to the event site one hour prior to the scheduled start of competition.

Friday, March 26: 1:00 PM

Saturday, March 27: 7:30 AM

### **STARTING HEIGHTS**

### **WARMUPS**

Running Events: Warm ups for all running events will be inside the LSU Fieldhouse or on the adjacent grass field.

Field Events: Athletes will have access to field event venues for warm ups approximately 45 minutes prior to the scheduled start of competition, with the exception of the vertical jumps. Athletes in these events will be allowed access approximately 75 minutes prior to the scheduled start of competition. Warm ups for field events will be terminated ten minutes prior to the scheduled start of the event. In the high jump, tape measures may not be used within 30 minutes of the start of competition.

### **POLE VAULT SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS**

All vaulting poles must be brought in through Gate 1 of Bernie Moore Track for certification. Certification will begin 75 minutes prior to the start of the event. Also, at this time, each athlete's coach must sign the certification form. Warm ups will begin one hour prior to the start of the event.

### **AWARDS**

Individual awards will be presented to the top 3 places in each event and members of the top 3 relays for both boys and girls divisions as follows. The meet will be scored in boys and girls divisions. Team awards will not be presented. Awards can be collected at the South end of the track near the throws field. Athletes should make every effort to collect awards during the meet, as uncollected awards will not be mailed. No awards will be given in B sections of any event.

1<sup>st</sup> Place, Individual Event: Medal and T-Shirt

2<sup>nd</sup> Place, Individual Event: Medal

3<sup>rd</sup> Place, Individual Event: Medal

1<sup>st</sup> Place, Relay Event: Medals and T-Shirts for Team Members

2<sup>nd</sup> Place, Relay Event: Medals for Team Members

3<sup>rd</sup> Place, Relay Event: Medals for Team Members
