**Entry Information and Instructions**

**ENTRIES**

1. Entries are unlimited.
2. All entries **MUST** be done through [www.directathletics.com](http://www.directathletics.com) by the entry deadline. If you do not have an account, you should set up your account and roster before the entry deadline.
3. Entry Deadline is noon, Wednesday, September 18. Entries may be made as early as Sunday, September 15. You may make changes as often as you wish until the entry deadline.
4. No Faxed or Phoned entries will be accepted.

**ENTRY FEE**

The NCAA Division I, II, and III Cross Country Executive Committees of the USTFCCCA have launched a new initiative to promote more involvement in our national professional group, the U.S. Track & Field and Cross Country Coaches Association. These Executive Committees have requested that all USTFCCCA members who host regular-season 2013 Cross Country meets offer preferred entry fees for USTFCCCA members.

As part of this initiative, the 2013 Tiger Cross Country Festival will offer preferred entry fees for USTFCCCA Members. Our regular entry fee will be \$125, and our preferred entry fee for USTFCCCA members will be \$75. Just contact [Membership@ustfccca.org](mailto:Membership@ustfccca.org) for access to your program's online USTFCCCA account, where you can pay 2013 USTFCCCA membership dues. Entry fees are to be paid at packet pickup.

**MEET SITE**

The Highland Road Park is located in Baton Rouge on Highland Road, approximately 8 miles south of the LSU Campus and approximately 4 miles from Interstate 10.

The course will have a slight alteration over previous years. Course maps will be available at a later date on [www.lsusports.net](http://www.lsusports.net).

**PACKET PICKUP**

Coaches should pick up their team's meet packet at the Check In area of the course Saturday between 7:00 AM and 8:30 AM. Entry fees are payable at this time.

**DIRECTIONS TO HIGHLAND ROAD PARK**

**Approaching on I-10 from the West:** Take the Siegen Lane exit, turning right onto Siegen Lane. Proceed approximately 2 miles to the intersection of Siegen and Highland Road. Turn left onto Highland Road, and proceed approximately ¼ mile. The park will be on the left at the intersection of Highland Road and Amiss Road.

**Approaching on I-10 from the East:** Take the Highland Road exit, then turn left back underneath the overpass. Turn right onto Highland Road, and proceed approximately 4 miles. The park will be on the right at the intersection of Highland Road and Amiss Road.

**From LSU:** Take Nicholson Drive South approximately ¼ mile. Turn left onto Burbank Drive, and proceed approximately 8 miles until it intersects with Highland Road. Turn right onto Highland Road, and proceed approximately ¼ miles. The park will be on the left at the intersection of Highland Road and Amiss Road.
