Entry Information and Instructions

Invitation

Entry into the meet is by invitation. A school desiring consideration for meet entry should email Todd Lane at toddlane@lsu.edu by November 1.

Number Restrictions

Relays:	2 teams per school
60m, 60m Hurdles:	unlimited entries
200m, 400m, 800m:	3 per school
Mile, 3000m, 5000m:	unlimited entries
Vertical Jumps:	3 per school
Throwing Events:	3 per school
Horizontal Jumps:	2 per school, plus athletes who meet the Special Standards below.

Special Horizontal Jump Standards

In the Horizontal Jumps each school will be allowed only two competitors per gender. Extra entries (above the limit of 2) will be permitted into the meet if they have met the following standards in collegiate competition:

	Men	Women
Long Jump	24-9	20-3
Triple Jump	52-0	42-0

Teams who have entries meeting these standards that are not included among the two allowed entries should email these entries to toddlane@lsu.edu, with a web link to document the mark.

Special Entry Events

Special Entry Events will be contested in two sections, a Championship section and a Non-Championship section. Championship Sections will be formed as stated below by meet management. All other entries will go into the non-championship section.

400 Meters:	Top 12 entries in a 2 heat final against time
800 Meters:	Top 8 entries in a single heat final
3000 Meters	Top 12 Entries in a single heat final
Mile Run:	Top 10 entries in a single heat final
Long Jump:	Top 10 entries in a single flight final

Entry Information and Instructions

Entry Procedure

1. All entries will be done electronically through www.directathletics.com. A link to this site can also be found by accessing www.lsusports.net, clicking on Track and Field, then on 2008 Meet Info.
2. Entry Deadline is 11:30 PM, Tuesday, January 15. Entries may be made as early as Sunday, January 13. You may make changes as often as you wish until the entry deadline.
3. No Faxed or Phoned entries will be accepted.

Entry Fees

1. Entry fees are \$300 per team (men and women are considered separate teams).
2. This fee must be paid prior to the meet at packet pickup.
3. Checks should be made payable to LSU Athletic Department.
4. This entry fee will provide tickets for all athletes and 5 extra passes for coaches and support staff per gender.
5. **Unattached athletes** must make payment online at www.directathletics.com with a credit card.

Meet Information

MEET SITE

The LSU Carl Maddox Fieldhouse is a 3,000-seat facility with a 200-meter tartan track. The lanes are 42" wide, with 7 lanes on the oval and 10 for straightaway races. The high jump area is Tartan, and the long/triple jump and pole vault runways are rubber covered boards. The throwing circles are plywood. The LSU Field House is located just off Nicholson Drive on the LSU campus.

PARKING

Parking is available at Bernie Moore Lot off Nicholson Drive, near the Southwest Portal of the LSU Field House (athletes and coaches entrance).

PACKET PICKUP

Coaches should pick up their teams meet packet prior to competing Saturday between the hours of 8:30 AM and 3:00 PM at the Southwest Portal (athletes and coaches entrance) of the Fieldhouse. Unattached athletes should collect their packets there during the same time period.

MEET PACKETS

Team packets will include heat sheets, time schedule, coaches infield passes and instructions, meet tickets for athletes, and five additional meet tickets for coaches and support staff per gender

MEET ADMISSION

Athletes and Coaches: Enter at Southwest Portal by presenting your meet ticket.

General Public: Enter at Southeast Portal. Admission is \$5 for adults, \$3 for students and children.

DRESSING FACILITIES

Locker room and shower facilities are available in the Fieldhouse for both men and women during meet hours. You must furnish your own towels.

TRAINING AREA

Trainers will be available in the Northeast Portal of the Fieldhouse for emergencies. Team trainers must set up behind the bleachers adjacent to the Southwest Portal (athletes and coaches entrance). Trainers will not be allowed to set up in any other area.

SEATING

Athletes and coaches must use only sections 4, 5, 6, and portable bleachers located in the Southeast and Southwest corners of the LSU Field House. All other sections are reserved for ticket holders only.

TIME SCHEDULE

A copy of the tentative time schedule is enclosed. Running event times are approximate. We will run an event by event schedule. Coaches should prepare their athletes for this rolling schedule and for possible advances or delays. A revised schedule will be in your packet, and will be posted on the web site www.lsusports.net Thursday, January 17 by 8:00 PM. Go to Track & Field and click on Purple Tiger Invitational Heat Sheets.

UNATTACHED ENTRIES

Unattached athletes should obtain a password for entry from the LSU Track and Field Office by emailing toddlane@lsu.edu. Phone calls will not be accepted or returned. After obtaining this password, unattached athletes should enter the meet through Direct Athletics at www.directathletics.com. Follow onscreen instructions to enter. A credit card will be required, and the \$20 entry fee must be paid online as part of the entry process. Athletes who have not entered and prepaid the entry fee in this manner will not be allowed to enter or compete. Unattached athletes should pick up their packets at the Southwest Portal Friday between the hours of 1:00 PM and 4:30 PM, and bring their printed receipt indicating payment from Direct Athletics in case of difficulty.

SPECIAL MEET RULE(S)

- No radios or portable stereos will be allowed through the gates of the Fieldhouse. Please remind your athletes of this policy. (Walkman-type individual radios are OK.).
- NCAA rules pertaining to electronic equipment will be strictly enforced on the arena floor of the Fieldhouse

HEAT SHEETS & RESULTS

Heat sheets will be posted on the web site www.lsusports.net Thursday, January 17 at 8:00 PM. Go to Track & Field and click on Purple Tiger Invitational Heat Sheets. They will also be in your packet at check in. Individual event results will be posted at the conclusion of that event in the Southwest Corner of the Field House. Final results will be available to teams from the press box after the meet, and will be posted on the same web site.

INFIELD PASSES AND COACHING AREAS

Included in the meet packet will be one infield coaching pass per gender. This pass permits entry into either of two coaching boxes. These boxes are located next to the pole vault runway on the infield, and directly in front of the temporary bleachers in the southeast corner of the Fieldhouse just outside the oval.

RELAY CARDS

Relay teams should pick up a relay card in the Clerking area, fill it out, and turn it in to the clerk of course. This constitutes the checking for the relay event.

ATHLETE CHECK-IN

Running Events: Athletes must check in one event prior to their own event at the check-in area (Clerk of Course, in the Northwest Portal).

Field events: Athletes must check in 15 minutes prior to the start of their event with the Head Judge of that event at the event site.

Relay Events: Relay teams should check in one event prior to their own event at the check-in area (Clerk of Course, in the Northwest Portal). Relay teams should pick up a relay card in the Clerking area, fill it out, and turn it in to the clerk of course.

QUALIFYING

In the 60 and 60 Hurdles, the Top 10 times will advance to the finals. All other running events will be contested as sections against time. In field events, the top 10 marks for the preliminary rounds will advance to the finals.

SCORING

This will be a non-scoring meet.

IMPLEMENT INSPECTION

Throwing implements will be inspected in the Northwest Portal of the Field House. Inspections will begin 1½ hours prior to the event and conclude ½ hour prior to the event. Implements will be transported to the event area one half hour prior to the event's starting time.

STARTING HEIGHTS

See entry restrictions page above.

WARMUPS

Running Events: Warm ups for all running events will be outside on Bernie Moore Track or the grass field outside the Northwest Portal of the Fieldhouse.

Field Events: Athletes will have access to field event venues for warm ups approximately 45 minutes prior to the scheduled start of competition. Warm ups for field events will be terminated ten minutes prior to the scheduled start of the event. In the high jump, measuring tapes may not be used within 30 minutes of starting time.
