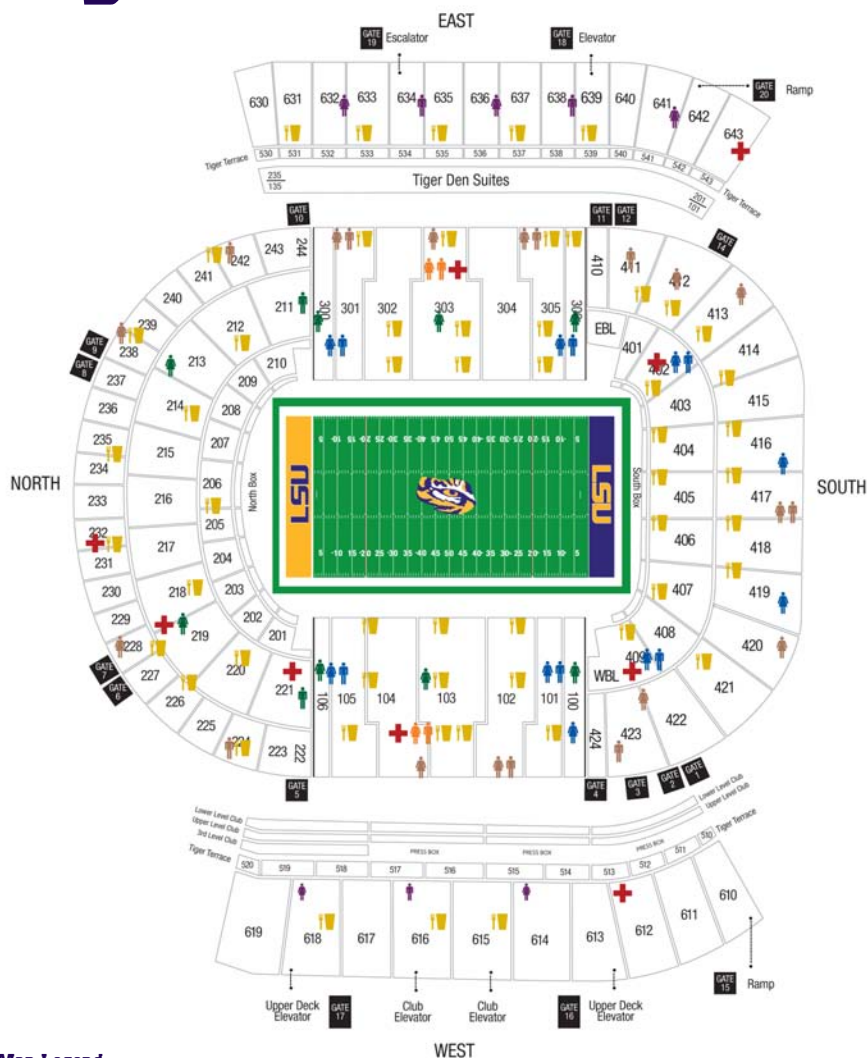


Tiger Stadium SEATING MAP

Les Miles

LSU FOOTBALL HEAD COACH



When Les Miles was named LSU's head football coach in January of 2005, the challenge was to not only keep the Tigers as one of the nation's elite programs, but to also make it better in all phases. Miles accepted the challenge, and in two years at the helm, he's advanced every facet of the LSU football program.

Whether on the field, in the classroom, or in the community, LSU players are demanded by Miles to strive for excellence and pursue an education while representing the University in first class fashion. The response by the players has been overwhelming as they've posted back-to-back 11-win seasons, played an instrumental role in the recovery efforts following Hurricanes Katrina and Rita, while also achieving academic success in the classroom. In two years, 37 LSU players have earned SEC Academic Honor Roll status with another 34 earning their college diploma.

The Tigers finished their second year under the direction of Miles ranked No. 3 in the nation, marking the first time since the 1958-59 seasons that LSU was ranked in the top five in the country in back-to-back years.

In 2006, Miles became the first coach in LSU history to lead the Tigers to consecutive 10-wins seasons. The Tigers also beat two top 10-ranked teams on the road in the same season with wins over No. 8 Tennessee and No. 5 Arkansas.

In six years as a collegiate head coach, which includes four seasons at Oklahoma State, Miles has fashioned a 50-25 overall mark and directed his teams to four bowl games. He is 22-4 overall in his two seasons with the Tigers, giving him more wins in his first two years at the school than any other coach in the history of the program.

Born November 10, 1953, Miles earned his degree in economics from Michigan in 1976. Les and Kathy Miles have four children, Kathryn, Leslie Matthew, Benjamin and Macy Grace.

Miles Traveled at LSU

As Les Miles enters his third year with the Tigers, the foundation for LSU football is more stable than ever. Miles' first two years with the Tigers has been unmatched in the history of the program. The results are impressive and staggering:

22 wins
13 SEC victories
8 wins over top 25 teams

2 bowl victories
1 BCS bowl victory



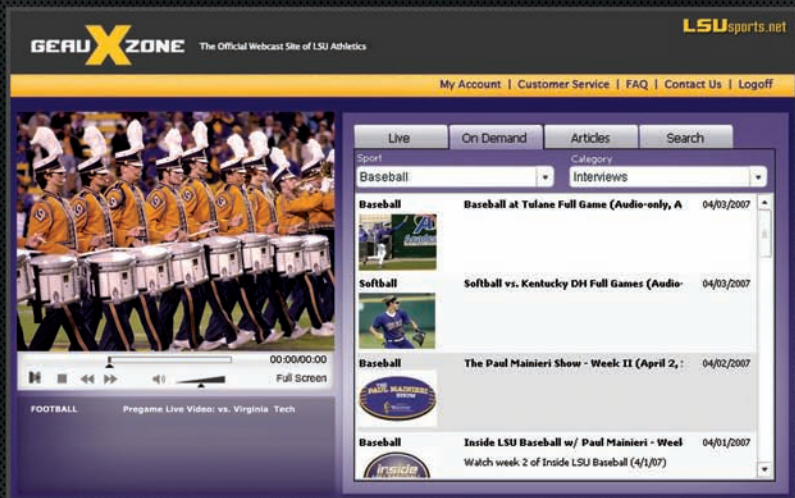
