2004 NCAA CENTRAL REGION CHAMPIONSHIP

SPARTANS AT THE 2004 NCAA CENTRAL REGION CHAMPIONSHIP

Michigan State's RQS of 196.195 earned the Spartans a trip to Baton Rouge, La., where they will take on five nationally-ranked teams for the 2004 NCAA Central Region Championship, hosted by No. 7 Louisiana State at the Maravich Center on Friday, April 2. The meet, which is scheduled for 6 p.m. (CST), will also feature No. 6 Brigham Young, No. 17 Arizona State, No. 23 Auburn and No. 24 Kent State. The top two finishers at this weekend's meet will earn a bid to Nationals, which will be held April 15-17 at Pauley Pavilion on the UCLA campus.

MSU closed out its regular season in Minneapolis, where it finished fifth at the Big Ten Conference Championship. Michigan State slipped out of the top-25 national ranking after the Big Ten Championship.

NCAA REGIONAL COMPETITION

MSU has faced two of its five opponents at the regional championship already this season. The Spartans matched up against both Louisiana State and Brigham Young once in 2004 and lost on both occasions.

MSU took a 194.875-193.250 loss to LSU in its season debut, a Jan. 9 contest in East Lansing. The Green and White fell to BYU, 197.150-195.875, at Oregon State on March 5.

LOOKING BACK AT MSU'S HISTORY IN THE REGIONALS...

The Spartans are making their eighth trip to the NCAA Regional competition under the direction of head coach Kathie Klages, and their 15th Regional appearance since 1982. MSU's highest Regional finish since Klages took over the Spartan squad was fourth place in 1996.

AND AT THE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS...

MSU has advanced to the NCAA National Championships just once in its history, as the Spartans finished 12th in 1988.

TOUGH COMPETITION

Fifteen of the Spartans' 28 opponents in the 2004 season were selected to compete in the 2004 NCAA Regionals. Six of the Big Ten's seven teams - Illinois, Iowa, Michigan, Michigan State, Minnesota and Penn State - were chosen to compete in the Regional field.

2004 BIG TEN HONORS

The Spartans garnered two specialty honors and two gymnasts named to the All-Big Ten teams in 2004. Victoria Iakounina was named the Big Ten Freshman of the Year, State's second-ever such honoree, and the first since Michelle Ingalls in 1988. Head coach Kathie Klages shared the Coach of the Year honor with Iowa's Mike Lorenzen and Michigan's Bev Plocki.

Sophomore Sarah Alexander was named First-Team All-Big Ten for the second consecutive year, while Iakounina earned Second-Team All-Big Ten honors.

SUPER-HIGH SCORES

State has posted program superlatives in 2004, including setting the program record with a 197.075. That score came in the midst of a season that saw the Spartans post a team score less than 195.00 just three times - each of which was in the opening three meets of the season. From Feb. 21 to March 7, State averaged 196.575 in its four meets.

STEADY VAULT PERFORMANCE

The Spartans have not scored below 49.00 on vault since Feb. 21 against Pittsburgh. In those six meets, MSU has averaged 49.104 in the event.

OK, THEY DON'T GET YOU TO THE REGIONALS, BUT...

State's 18 wins in 2004 are the most since 1998, when the Spartans racked up a season record of 23-6, and are the fifth-most in head coach Kathie Klages' 14 seasons at Michigan State.

QUALIFIED RETURNEES

The Spartans return eight letterwinners from last year's squad, including 2003 All-Big Ten selections Sarah Alexander (first team) and Lauren Simpson (second team).

ALEXANDER ROCKS BEAM

Sarah Alexander has led the Spartans in the balance beam competition this season, posting four 9.900s in the event. One of those 9.900s came at the 2004 Big Ten Championships, earning her a share of second place, and garnering her the position of being MSU's only top-three place winner at the league championships. She also posted a 9.900 on beam the week before at Eastern Michigan.

HEAD COACH KATHIE KLAGES

Head coach Kathie Klages (Central Michigan '77) is in her 14th season at the helm of Michigan State gymnastics. In that time, she has posted a 223-111-2 record, good for a .667 winning percentage. Her teams have participated in seven NCAA Regional Championships in her time at State, including 2002 and 2003. In 2003, MSU finished fifth at the regional. Klages was named NCAA Central Region Coach of the Year in 2000, 1998, 1996 and 1993. She earned Big Ten Coach of the Year honors in 1996. Klages shared Big Ten co-Head Coach of the Year honors with Iowa's Mike Lorenzen and Michigan's Bev Plocki in 2004. She is a member of the National Association of Women's Gymnastics Judges and holds a National ranking.

UNSTOPPABLE RECORD-BREAKING SEASON

Michigan State gymnastics smashed its all-time university record for the second time in less than two weeks, posting 197.075 in a victory over second-

place Boise State (196.925) and Pennsylvania (193.125) at Boise State on Sunday, March 7. The Green and White established its previous best-ever record in a 196.775 win over Ohio State (196.775) and West Virginia (195.975) at MSU's last home meet of the season on Feb. 28 at Jenison Field House. The Spartans smashed the school record after having tied their previous all-time best (196.575) to defeat Pittsburgh in East Lansing on Feb. 21.

BIG TEAM EFFORT, SOLID RESULTS

Michigan State has earned a team score of 195.250 or higher since Jan. 31, 2004. The Spartans have recorded 49.00 or higher on vault for the past five meets, as well as 49.00 or higher on bars in five of the last six meets. MSU has registered scores of 49.00 or higher for 10 consecutive meets, six of which have been 49.325 or higher.

NOTABLE SPARTANS

SOPHOMORE SARAH ALEXANDER (Kernersville, N.C.)

Alexander has earned 9.900 on beam in four meets in 2004, in addition to posting a career-best 9.950 on beam at Boise State on March 7, 2004. She also delivers a potent threat to opponents on the floor, having posted 9.950 two times this season, just .025 shy of her career-best 9.975 on the floor. She also earned 9.900 four times and 9.925 twice for floor performances in 2004.

JUNIOR NICOLE ANDERSON (Kenosha, Wis.)

Anderson has earned 9.800 or higher on the floor in nine of the last 10 meets this season. In 2004, Anderson first tied, then surpassed, her previous 9.875 career-best mark on the floor. Anderson earned a 9.900 on the floor on Feb. 21, 2004 against Pittsburgh and then again the following weekend, on Feb 28, against Ohio State and West Virginia.

FRESHMAN KRISTEN COLEMAN (Cornwall, Ontario)

Coleman established herself as a consistently successful element of the Spartan squad in her debut season. She earned 9.900 as her career-best on vault and twice on the floor in 2004. Coleman also posted a career best 9.825 on the bars two times this season.

FRESHMAN CHAYLA HILL (Hudson, Ohio)

Another successful addition to the 2004 squad, Hill has proven herself to be an indispensable element to Spartan success. She has earned at least 9.900 for all three of the events in which she has competed; vault, beam and floor. Hill has also posted 9.925 on the floor twice this season, which is good for a tie with Victoria Iakounina for the team's second-best floor score of the season, behind Sarah Alexander's 9.950 mark.

JUNIOR ANNA HUNSINGER (Elizabethtown, Ky)

Exactly one year after setting a career-best beam score (9.850) at Michigan in 2003, Hunsinger tied that career best on Jan. 31, 2004, again at Michigan. Her record-matching performance at Michigan was the the junior's last competition of 2004, due to a season-ending injury.

FRESHMAN VICTORIA IAKOUNINA (Woodbridge, Va.)

In her premiere season at MSU, Iakounina has undoubtedly made her mark on Spartan gymnastics. She has posted 9.925 on vault and on the beam in 2004. She also recorded 9.900 on bars this season. Iakounina has posted 9.850 or higher on vault for the last six meets. Her average vault score during this stretch is a 9.867.

FRESHMAN JENNA RIVERS (Hauppauge, N.Y.)

Rivers made her Spartan debut on the floor against Ohio State and West Virginia on Feb. 28 and has competed on the floor in every meet since, a total of five times. Rivers recorded a season-best 9.875 on the floor on March 7 against Boise State, to establish a streak of earning 9.800 or higher in the last three meets. The Hauppauge, N.Y. native's average floor score is 9.842 during that three-week stretch.

JUNIOR LAUREN SIMPSON (Linden, Mich.)

Simpson has spent 2004 smashing personal records across the board, including setting new bests on bars, beam and floor. She earned a career-best 9.875 on beam on Jan. 4 and posted an all-time best 9.875 on bars two times in 2004. Despite a mere four performances on the floor, Simpson managed to surpass her career best with a 9.900 on the floor at the Spartan Invitational on Feb. 14. The momentum of Simpson's accomplishments this season promises to serve the Spartans in the Central Regional Championship and carry them into another successful 2004-05 season.

JUNIOR JENNIFER YARBROUGH (Williamston, Mich.)

Yarbrough has enjoyed consistent success on the floor this season. She smashed her previous best of 9.800 on the floor by earning 9.850 in the event at the Spartan Invitational on Feb. 14, 2004. Yarbrough went on to post 9.850 two additional times on the floor in 2004. She has recorded 9.800 or higher on the floor in six of the last seven meets.

MOST RECENT ACTION

MSU's 196.025 earned them fifth place in the Big Ten Championship in Minneapolis, Minn. on Saturday, March 20. Standout freshman Victoria lakounina was named Big Ten Freshman of the Year, while Spartan head coach Kathie Klages shared Co-head Coach of the Year honors with Iowa's Mike Lorenzen and Michigan's Bev Plocki. Sarah Alexander earned First-Team All-Big Ten honors for the second time in her two seasons at MSU, while lakounina was voted to the league's second team.

Michigan took the Big Ten Championship title with a 197.800, followed by Penn State at 196.625. Iowa and Minnesota took third and fourth with respective scores of 196.500 and 196.325 - less than .500 separated third place from MSU's fifth-place finish. Illinois and Ohio State rounded out the competition at 195.400 and 194.450.

LOOKING AT THE CENTRAL REGION FIELD...

CHECKING OUT No. 17 ARIZONA STATE

No. 17 Arizona State posted an RQS of 196.830 to make it to Baton Rouge. The Sun Devils posted a team total of 196.775, their best road score of the season, to tie for fourth of seven at the PAC-10 Conference Championship at Arizona on March 20. ASU's season-high team total is 198.45, the highest of any competitor entering the Central Region Championship. The Sun Devils also boast the highest vault (49.650), bars (49.600) and floor (49.825) scores of the season, of all six teams at the Central Regional.

ASU has finished as one of the top 10 teams in the nation for 14 of the

past 18 years.

Four Sun Devils have earned perfect 10.00 scores in 2004; Maggie Germaine on vault and floor, Cassandra Jusino on vault, and Kari Muth on balance beam and on floor exercise. Ashley Kelly has earned perfect 10.00 scores on vault, balance beam and floor.

Sun Devil Head Coach John Spini is 289-103-2 (regular season) in his 24th year at ASU.

CHECKING OUT No. 23 AUBURN

No. 23 Auburn earned a place in Regional Championship competition with its 196.435 RQS. Auburn enters the meet after having placed fifth in the SEC Championship for the third-consecutive year. The Tigers posted a season-high team total score of 197.00 in 2004, just .075 points below the Spartans' season-high score of 197.075. Auburn is ranked 3rd in the Central Region.

Auburn's Rachael Tarantino posted a perfect 10.00 on the beam this season, which marks the Tigers' highest individual score of the season.

Tiger head coach Jeff Thompson is 29-44-0 in his fifth year at Auburn.

ANOTHER GLANCE AT No. 6 BRIGHAM YOUNG

Brigham Young prevailed in the only contest of the season between BYU and Michigan State, 197.150-195.875, at Oregon State on March 5, 2004. BYU is the No. 1 seed entering the contest, but posts an RQS of 198.025 that is second to Arizona State's 198.45 RQS. The Cougars' most recent competition was against No. 5 Utah in a meet on March 19. Despite posting its highest team score of the season, the Cougars fell to the Utes, 198.600-197.800.

Cougar Jaime Mabray posted a perfect 10.00 on vault in 2004, making her the only Cougar to record a perfect score this season.

BYU head coach Brad Cattermole is in his 16th season.

CHECKING OUT No. 24 KENT STATE

No. 24 Kent State (17-3-0) enters the regional competition with an RQS of 196.360. The are ranked 4th in the Central Region, just ahead of No. 5 Michigan State. Kent State enters regionals after finishing second of eight teams in the MAC Championship in Mount Pleasant, Mich. on Friday, March 19. KSU earned its third-best team total in school history at the conference championship, posting 196.850 to take the silver.

Golden Flash junior Earline Feugill, an All-MAC first team selection, posted a 9.950 on the floor at the MAC Championship to tie for the title in that event.

KSU's Brice Biggin is in his 13th season as head coach, but has been involved with Kent State gymnastics for more than two decades.

ANOTHER GLANCE AT No. 7 LOUISIANA STATE

LSU closed out the season 11-4-0 and went on to take third in the SEC with a team total of 197.275 against Alabama, Georgia, Florida, Kentucky Auburn and Arkansas. Georgia took the conference crown, posting 198.175, followed by second-place Alabama (197.950) LSU is ranked second in the Central Region.

Tiger April Burkholder recently received South Eastern Conference honors, being named SEC Gymnast of the Year. Burkholder was named SEC Freshman of the Year earlier in the season.

Tiger Head Coach D-D Breaux is 428-270-7 in her 27th season at LSU.
