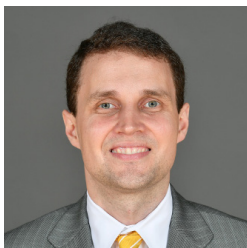

5th Year at LSU • 7th Year as a Head Coach

When LSU basketball won its final regular season Southeastern Conference game of the 2020-21 season, it marked 39 league regular season wins over a three-year period.

It was the most SEC wins by any team in the league over that same period.

It was part of a successfully negotiated pandemic year in which the team and its staff had to stop the program for almost two weeks in December, won 19 games, finished third in the league, made the SEC Tournament championship game for the first time since 1993 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Basketball Tournament.

In a strange new world, the 2020-21 season again showed the consistency of the LSU program to be successful, and that consistency has been a buzzword for Coach Will Wade since he took the job at LSU.

When he arrived in Baton Rouge, Wade wanted to make LSU basketball, a program which has had ultimate highs followed by periods of lows, be a consistent player on the college basketball scene.

He has worked hard to put together a program with good players that produces consistent winning, regular post-season tournament appearances and playing an exciting brand of basketball that would see the Tigers contend for a top spot yearly in the Southeastern Conference.

Now entering his fifth season as the head coach of the LSU Fighting Tigers basketball program, Coach Will Wade has been able to check all the boxes of program building and program stability that he set out to accomplish when he was named the 22nd head coach of the LSU program prior to the 2017-18 season.

In four years, the Tigers have won 86 games with three post-season appearances (and what would have been a fourth in 2020 before post-season was canceled) with an SEC Championship in 2019, a tie for second in 2020 and a third place finish in 2021. The Tigers advanced to the round of 16 in the NIT in 2018, to the Sweet 16 in the 2019 NCAA Championships and to the second round of the NCAAs in 2021.

It was all part of the vision the coach has for the program. It's a vision to have "unwavering commitment to put the team first, to put the state first, to put our school first to represent all of these folks in a first-class fashion. We are going to be a hard-working team that represents this great university that represents this great state."

Frank William "Will" Wade said those words on March 20, 2017 when he was named the head coach at LSU. He came to LSU after a stellar two-year stint as the head coach at Virginia Commonwealth University and two years at UT-Chattanooga.

He was the first Tiger mentor to get the Tigers to post-season play in both of the first two seasons on the job. He is one of just five LSU coaches to lead his team to an SEC Championship and one of just four to take a team to the NCAA Sweet 16.

Wade has also brought analytics and trends to his coaching practices at LSU and his ability to quickly know situations and tendencies has proven beneficial to the Tigers in his first four seasons.

Coach Wade has shown LSU followers that he looks to prepare his team for league play by producing a non-conference schedule that is competitive and among the best in the country. His schedule ranked fifth in the country in 2019 and eighth in the country in 2020.

In 2021, LSU had to make several changes to the schedule because of the pandemic, losing and rescheduling several games in December and having the league change the schedule at one point on less than 48 hours notice with a road trip to Missouri becoming a road game at Ole Miss.

LSU would finish with one home loss for the second straight year, despite playing one less home game than other league schools, finishing at 7-1. The Tigers were third in the league, earning the double bye in the tournament for the third straight year. But this time LSU made the run that fans had been looking for, defeating Ole Miss and Arkansas to get

to the SEC Championship game for the first time since the 1993 season.

The Tigers would proceed to the NCAA bubble in Indianapolis where they advanced to the second round.

The 2021 team would average 81.8 points, marking the third straight year the Tigers averaged over 80 points a game. It was the highest scoring average since LSU averaged 87.5 points a game during the 1991-92 season. The three consecutive years marks the most since LSU had four straight seasons over 80 points from the 1988-89 season through the 1991-92 campaigns.

In 2020, LSU opened with eight straight conference wins as LSU tied for second place in the league one season after winning the league championship.

The highlight of Wade's four years came in 2019 when the Tigers won their first SEC title in 10 years and won two games in the NCAA Tournament to advance to the Sweet 16 for the first time since 2006. But it was also a year in which a coach and a team had to handle the worst possible tragedy, the death of a teammate.

Junior Wayde Sims was killed in the early morning of Sept. 28, 2018 just hours before what was to be the first team workout in preparation for the 2018-19 season.

The team dedicated the season to Wayde and his parents, which included former Tiger player Wayne Sims. It was a season in which time after time, the Tigers appeared to need a spark to stay alive for a win and things would turn around. LSU would go a perfect 9-0 in the league on the road, winning four overtime games and another at the buzzer. The Tigers would win 16 league games, one of their best overall 18-game league records.

So far in four seasons, LSU under Wade has posted 24 wins in the Quadrant I rankings in the NCAA RPI/NET rankings.

Between 2019 and 2020, the Tigers ran off 12 straight SEC road wins, the third longest streak in school history.

Fans are caring about LSU basketball, not just because of wins, but because of what they have seen on the court.

The fans have seen the things that Coach Wade promised when he took the job – an energized staff that was integrated in the game making coaching decisions and alterations as needed; player that were working hard to enact a game plan and making big plays.

More than anything, LSU fans saw the advancement of returning players under Coach Wade and his staff and the way that the new players blended with the improved veterans.

Wade, one of the younger coaches in Division I at 39, has also proven to be one of the most energetic both in practices and games, and his players have responded in kind.

PRIOR TO LSU

The native of Nashville, Tennessee, directed VCU to a 51-20 record and two NCAA Tournament appearances in 2015-2016 and 2016-2017. The 2016 Rams advanced to the second round of the tournament, defeating

seventh-seed Oregon State before losing to Oklahoma. Wade was

the youngest head coach in the NCAA

Tournament in 2016.

In 2017, VCU lost to St.

Mary's in the first round

of the NCAA tourney.

The Rams were

28-8 over his two

years in the Atlantic 10

Conference, posting

14-4 records both years.

The team was 25-11

in 2016 and earned a

share of the Atlantic

10 Conference regular

season crown. The 2017 team won 26 games and finished second in the league.

Prior to becoming the head coach at VCU, Wade served as the head coach at Chattanooga for the 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons.

His first Mocs squad went 18-15 in 2014, finishing 12-6 and second in regular season Southern Conference play. The 18 wins overall were the most by the program since 2008-09 and the 12 wins in league games was the highest total since 2010-11. The team made the school's first postseason appearance since 2009 in the CIT.

Wade was honored with the Anton Foy Southern Conference Coach of the Year award in 2014.

The Mocs won 22 games in 2015 and finished 15-3 in the league as Wade guided Chattanooga to its first 20-win season since 2004-05. He finished his two seasons there at 40-25 and 27-7 in league play. In the two seasons prior to his arrival, Chattanooga was 24-40 overall and 13-23 in SoCon play.

In his eight years as a head coach, he has a combined record at Chattanooga, VCU and LSU of 174-85 and 101-40 in conference play with six post-season appearances.

Wade's reputation, where ever he has coached, is a person who is a tireless worker and relentless recruiter. Wade was VCU Head Coach Shaka Smart's first hire upon being named the head VCU coach in 2009.

Wade's coaching start came at Clemson where he served as Director of Basketball Operations (2006-07) and Graduate Assistant (2005-06) after four seasons as a student manager (2002-05).

Wade is married to the former Lauren Deason, and the couple has one daughter, Caroline Elizabeth (4).

LAST GAME: LSU 85, MCNEESE 46 (Baton Rouge, 11/18/21)

It was a better start for LSU but still with room to improve for the Tigers in the win over McNeese Thursday at the Maravich Center.

LSU used a 19-0 first half run using steals off the press leading to offense off multiple McNeese turnovers to build a 43-16 advantage at intermission.

LSU would lead by as much as 42 points late in the contest, the first time this season all 14 dressed players saw the court with 10 players scoring. No LSU player played more than 24 minutes.

Tari Eason, the sophomore transfer from Cincinnati, had his third double double in four LSU games with 19 points and 14 boards. Eason hit 8-of-13 field goals with a trey and two free throws to go with an assist, two steals and three blocks.

Senior Darius Days, who now leads all active Southeastern Conference players with 17 double doubles, had his first of the year with 14 points and 10 rebounds.

Sophomore Eric Gaines had 10 points and six assists, while Xavier Pinson had eight assists. Pinson, the transfer from Missouri, had eight assists. LSU's top two point guards combined for 14 assists, four steals and three steals.

LSU shot 44.6 percent for the game (33-of-74) with seven treys, while McNeese hit just 17-of-59 field goals (28.8%) and four treys.

FIELD GOALS

In the second half combined in the four games, LSU has allowed just 32 total field goals with only McNeese (11) getting double figures in the second half.

ULM scored just four field goals in the final 20 minutes in LSU's 101-39 win, while Texas State made just 8.

Neither ULM or Texas State made a three-pointer in the final 20 minutes of play as both teams were 0-of-6 from the arc. LSU has outscored the four opponents, 192-103, combined in the final 20 minutes.

Regarding ULM's 4 field goals in the second half (11/9), the last time LSU held an opponent to fewer than 4 FGs in a half was Jan. 8, 2011, at Auburn when Auburn made just 2-of-24 in the first half.

McNeese (11/18) made just 6-of-31 first half field goals (19.4%)

For the season, LSU is 126-of-257 (49.0%), while opponents are hitting 69-of-206 (33.5%).

HOLDING UNDER 60

In the four games, ULM scored 39, Texas State 59, Liberty 58 and McNeese 46 points.

The last time LSU opened a season holding teams under 60 points was in the first four games of the 2006-07 season under former head coach, now radio analyst John Brady (LSU was 3-1 in those 4 games):

If somehow, LSU was able to extend the streak to five games under 60 to open the season, research shows that you would have to go back to the start of the 1946-47 season when the Coach Harry Rabenhorst led Tigers would run off 20 straight games holding teams under 60 in a different era of college basketball. POSSESSION NUMBERS

Against Texas State (11/12), LSU scored on 23-of-34 second half possessions and scored 1.529 points per possession, while the Bobcats were 11-of-34 and a points per possession of 0.647.

In the second half against Liberty, LSU scored on 22-of-37 possessions with 1.324 points per possession. LSU held Liberty to just 14 scores on 35 possession in the second half.

The numbers bear out what happened in the first half in the game with McNeese (11/18) as the Cowboys scored on just 7-of-39 possessions, scoring .410 points per possession. LSU scored on 39-of-73 possessions in the game and 1.164 points per possession.

In the four games, LSU has scored on 153-of-277 possessions (55.2%).

SHOT CLOCK VIOLATIONS

In the first two games of the season, the Tigers forced nine shot clock violations – 4 against ULM and 5 against Texas State. The total for four games is 11 as LSU forced two in the McNeese game (11/18).

The Tigers caused 52 turnovers in the last two games (25 against Liberty, 27 versus McNeese) and 89 through four games (an average of 22.25 a game). LSU has turned the ball over 54 times in four games (13.50 a contest).

A DIFFERENCE OF HALVES

LSU was down 37-32 at the half against Texas State (11/19) and turned the game around to an 84-59 advantage ... The 35-point differential between its 1st half (-5) and 2nd half margins (+30) was its largest since March 3, 2004, vs. Ole Miss (-11, +24) - 555 games ago.

LSU was able to turn a one-point deficit halftime into a 17-point differential for the Tigers in the 74-58 win against Liberty (11/18).

To the question if anyone has made seven three-pointers in a half as Days did against ULM (11/9), it happened in 1990 when Mahmoud Abdul-Rauf made 7-of-10 in the second half of that 10-trey game.

100 POINTS

The Tigers went to 5-0 under Will Wade when scoring 100 in the ULM game (11/9) and LSU has now won 19 straight games when hitting the century mark and 41-of-the-last-42. LSU is 104-8 overall when scoring 100 or more.

UNDEFEATED TEAMS

It means so little now other than numbers to toss around but since Ken Pomeroy is counting it down every time someone loses, as of Saturday morning, LSU was one of 70 remaining undefeated teams in Division I less than two weeks into the season.

LAST YEAR QUICK RECAP

LSU finished its season on March 22 when it lost in the NCAA bubble in the round of 32 to Michigan. The Tigers defeated St. Bonaventure in its opening round game, marking two consecutive NCAA Tournaments (2019, 2021) that LSU won at least one game in the tournament. That hadn't happened for the Tigers since the 1986 and 1987 tournaments. LSU made the tournament for the first time in back-to-back events since the 2005 and 2006 seasons.

LSU finished 19-10 in a season that started later, had several schedule changes and included almost two weeks when the team couldn't play because of COVID-19 protocols that involved the coaching staff and players.

In the league, LSU was 11-6 (one canceled) to finish third in the SEC. LSU defeated Ole Miss and Arkansas to get to the finals of the SEC Tournament for the first time since 1993, where they lost to Alabama by just one points in the championship game.

LSU WINS

The numbers under Will Wade:

LSU has won 39 Southeastern Conference regular season games over the last three seasons (16, 12, 11), the most in the SEC in that time span. Five schools won 30 or more games in those three seasons combined:

LSU 39

Kentucky 38

Tennessee 34

Alabama 32

Auburn 30

Over the last three seasons, LSU's 69 wins is tied for third as the most in a three-year period in school history. LSU's four-year total (2018-21) of 87 victories is tied for the fourth most in a four-year period in school history.

LSU is looking for a fifth consecutive winning season which would tie for the fourth longest streak of consecutive winning campaigns in school history. (LSU had a 5-year streak from 2012-2016 and 1977-81).

LSU after the first four games needs six victories to record the 600th on-court win in the Assembly Center. LSU is 594-199 (74.9%). LSU will play its 800th men's basketball game in the building on Jan. 15 against Arkansas.

WINNING STREAK

With the four home wins to start the season, LSU enters the McNeese game with a seven-game win streak at the Pete Maravich Assembly Center. LSU defeated Tennessee, Auburn and Vanderbilt last season in its final three regular-season home games.

BELMONT NOTES

The Bruins are 3-1 on the young season after Friday's 97-78 win on the road at Kennesaw State. Belmont shot 53 percent and made 10 three-pointers. Nick Muszynski led Belmont with 25 points, with Will Richard scoring 17 and Michael Shanks 16.

In the last 10 years, Belmont has won less than 23 games on just two occasions – 2016 (20) and 2015 (22). In the last four seasons, the Bruins have won 103 games. Belmont has earned postseason invitations 14-of-the-last-16 seasons, including nine NCAA Tournament berths. The Bruins join Gonzaga, Kansas and San Diego State to win 19 or more games in 16 consecutive seasons.

Belmont returns 97 percent of its offensive production and minutes from last season and the Bruins have earned wins over SEC teams Vanderbilt, Georgia, Alabama and Missouri in recent years.

FIFTH GAME IN 14 DAYS

Tonight's game is LSU's fifth in 14 days at home before Thanksgiving to open the Tigers season. Of course, last year, the season didn't start until a couple of days prior to Thanksgiving because of the pandemic.

LSU opened with six straight home games in the 2012-13 season, but three of those games were after Thanksgiving. The Tigers had eight straight at home in the 2008-09 season, but again some of those games were played after Thanksgiving.

The Tigers also started with long opening homestands in 2003 and 2004 but in those years the NCAA college basketball season did not start until Nov. 19 or later.

After Monday's game, the Tigers will head to Niceville, Florida for the Emerald Coast Classic in which LSU will play Penn State on Friday (Nov. 26) and then either Wake Forest or Oregon State on Saturday (Nov. 27). LSU's next home game after Belmont will be Dec. 1 against Ohio (7 p.m.)

NUMBERS, NUMBERS

There are again some number changes on players returning to the LSU roster for the 2021-22 season:

Mwani Wilkinson goes from "0" to "5" this season.

Eric Gaines drops the five from "25" and is just "2" this season.

Shareef O'Neal has changed from "32" to "24" for the 2021-22 season.

Parker Edwards has upped his number to 30 for this campaign.

But for the first time in his career, Darius Days did not change numbers, staying with the "4" he picked up prior to the 2020-21 season. Days has worn "22" as a freshman, "0" as a sophomore before picking up his high school number "4" for his junior season.

FATHERS AND SONS

Hopefully as he is finally getting cleared to practice again with the Tigers, LSU fans will get to see more of Shareef O'Neal in uniform in 2021-22. He appeared in 10 games, averaging 2.4 points and 4.4 rebounds a contest.

This year only two players (Days and Tari Eason) are averaging in double figures through the first four games, but five other players are averaging at least 6.5 points a game.

LSU, which has averaged over 80 points a game each of the last three seasons, is averaging 86.0 points a game while giving up just 50.5 points in the first four games.

DAYS PRESEASON ALL-SEC SELECTION

Back for his fourth season, Darius Days is beginning to put his name in the LSU record book and has been an integral part of this Tiger team for three seasons now. The numbers started off in a very positive way for Days with his first four games that have him averaging 21.8 points and hitting 58.5 from the field and three-point arc ... Some other numbers:

98 career games played with 65 starts.

939 points, 61 away from 1,000.

601 rebounds, tied for No. 27th on the school rebound list presently.

72 wins in games he has played in for LSU.

LSU's last four-year player, Skylar Mays, had 77 wins in his four years for the Tigers (2017-20), while current assistant coach Tasmin Mitchell is one of the leaders in wins over the last couple of decades with 85 wins in his career that included the 2006 NCAA Final Four season and the 2009 SEC Championship team.

Days, who averaged 11.6 points and 7.8 rebounds a year ago, was selected first-team preseason All-SEC by the league coaches in their vote last month ... He shot over 50 percent last season, making 123-of-237 (51.9%) with 52 three-pointers. He has posted 20 games in double figures in 2020-21, 48 over his career with eight double doubles, 17 at present in his career.

The native of Raleigh, Florida was third in the SEC in rebound average a year ago and also defensive rebound average at 5.3 a game. He was sixth in the league in offensive rebound average at 2.5.

By the way, it should be pointed out he missed his first three-point attempt of the season in the Nov. 9 opener at the 18:22 mark and then made his next nine straight stretching to his first attempt of the Texas State game (11/12).

Since the start of the 2020-21 season, the Tigers are 23-1 when Days scores in double figures.

TARI EASON, DAYS AND THE DOUBLES

Each of the last two seasons, Darius Days had eight double doubles. Thursday he got his first of the year and his 17th of his career, the active leader in the league.

But in the first four games, double double talk has been more about the sophomore transfer from Cincinnati, Tari Eason.

Eason kind of made his name known in the charity exhibition at Nicholls when he scored 22 points and grabbed 15 rebounds in October.

But in the first four games, he has doubled three times, including a 19-14 effort in the last game against McNeese (11/18). That was a college career high for rebounds and one off his 20-point game at Tulane while playing for Cincinnati.

Eason is 22-of-42 from the field in the first four games (52.4%) with three treys and he is averaging 13.3 points and 9.3 rebounds a contest. He is averaging 21.7 minutes off the bench.

X-MAN

It's officially X-avier when it comes to pronouncing the Missouri transfer's name but one thing is certain that he has moved in to the point guard position held by Javonte Smart very well for the LSU Tigers. Pinson has 31 points (7.8 average) with 25 assists and just 10 turnovers to go with six steals.

Pinson has had seven assists twice and then eight assists against McNeese (11/18) in the last game.

Pinson played three seasons for Missouri before transferring to LSU for his fourth season.

Pinson needs just 66 points to get to a career college total of 1,000 points. Pinson is averaging 24.7 minutes a game this season.

MORE ON PINSON'S ASSISTS

After 4 games, Xavier Pinson's assists per minute (.253) are the most for LSU Basketball since Randy Livingston ran the point for the Tigers in the 1994-95 season (.275) Livingston played just 16 games that year due to injury.

Pinson is the team leader at the moment in assist-to-turnover ratio at 2.50 (25-10).

ADAM MILLER

It was three transfers for the Tigers with Adam Miller, coming to LSU from Illinois, to go with Tari Eason and Xavier Pinson. Miller, however, injured his knee last month in practice and has had ACL surgery and is expected to be out 6-to-9 months.

ERIC GAINES

The transition from freshman to sophomore has been good for Eric Gaines and other than Darius Days, he is one of the elder statesmen on this team and he has been one to help the younger guys get used to what they are in for in college basketball.

Gaines has come off the bench in all four games and has played no less than 23 minutes in each game. Three time he has posted 10 points, he has 10 steals and three games of five or more assists.

Gaines is averaging 9.5 points, 5.3 assists, compared to just 2.5 turnovers and 2.5 steals per game.

He is also 13-of-14 at the free throw line.

EFTON REID

The five-star freshman has made his presence felt in a lot of ways and none bigger than when he stepped out to the corner and made his first college three-pointer. But the center has the post moves and rebound ability to help LSU.

Fans and media feel he is the old-school type of center and through four games he is averaging 9.8

points, and 5.3 rebounds.

Reid has made 18-of-31 shots (58.1%) and is averaging 19.7 minutes in his four starts.

BRANDON MURRAY

The freshman from Baltimore has started the first four games and is averaging 8.3 points with 3.3 rebounds a game.

Murray has hit 12-of-26 shots, with five being three-pointers. Murray is averaging 27.6 minutes a game. Murray's best scoring game came against Texas State when Murray scored 14 points on 4-of-5 shooting, including three treys.

RECRUITING CLASS FOR 2021-22

The recruiting class that LSU brought in for this 2021-22 season was ranked seventh in the national team rankings and LSU fans have seen some of those players in action early on.

Efton Reid was a five-star recruit and four-star recruit Brandon Murray highlighted that class.

THE STEALS

In LSU's first four games, the Tigers had double figure steals in three-of-the-four contests highlighted by 16 against Liberty and 17 against McNeese.

Mwani Wilkinson and Eric Gaines are in double figures for steals through four games with Wilkinson at 12 and Gaines at 10. Alex Fudge has eight steals, Brandon Murray 7 and Xavier Pinson 6.

Last year, LSU had 225 steals for the season. Although it is impossible to keep the pace up for a full season, the early pace of LSU would be good for over 400 steals this year.

THE YOUNG TIGERS

The Tigers are listed No. 325 of 358 teams on the Kenpom.com list based on experience this year. For the first time in several years, there are no Southeastern Conference teams below LSU on that list.

LSU is listed at 1.20 years with the D1 average at 1.89 in experience.

NOW ON TO THE RECRUITING CLASS FOR 2022-23

LSU signed two players in the early signing period and has another five-star inking players for Coach Will Wade.

Five-star forward Julian Phillips from Blythewood, South Carolina and Link Year Academy in Branson, Missouri, will be the sixth five-star recruit to play for Will Wade. Phillips is ranked No. 14 nationally by both ESPN, Rivals and 247sports.com. He is ranked No. 2 at the position by 247sports and No. 5 by ESPN.

This past year, Phillip averaged over 20 points this season for Blythewood High School.

LSU's other signee is Terry, Mississippi native Devin Ree who is now at Oak Hill Academy in Virginia. Ree was all-state last season at Terry High, averaging 23.2 points and 12 rebounds. He was ranked No. 84 in the nation by the recruiting services and the No. 1 player in the state of Mississippi.

DEFLECTIONS

So far this season, LSU has two games with 41 deflections (ULM and Liberty) and posted 44 deflections against McNeese.

The complete season list for each player is on the CHART at the stats portion of the game notes.

So far, the season high is NINE with Mwani Wilkinson getting nine against ULM (11/9) and then Darius Days and Tari Eason getting nine each against Liberty (11/15).

A total of 11 different players had deflections against McNeese (11/18) with Tari Eason getting eight and Xavier Pinson seven.

Just for the official record, Webster's Dictionary defines a deflection as "a turning aside or off course" which is what happens with the basketball when there is a deflection.

After the opening show there will be a week off and then the December show dates are: Wednesday, Dec. 15, Monday, Dec. 20 and Monday, Dec. 27.

MTE TIME: TIGERS HEAD TO NORTHWEST FLORIDA

It's time for the multi-team event and this year back on Thanksgiving Weekend as LSU travels to Niceville, Florida for the Emerald Coast Classic.

Two separate four-team divisions taking part in the event with Penn State, Wake Forest and Oregon State in LSU's division.

Penn State and LSU will meet in the first semifinal on Friday at 6 p.m. followed by Oregon State and Wake Forest at 8:30 p.m. The Championship round is set for Saturday (Nov. 27) with the third-place game between semifinal losers at 3 p.m. and the championship game at 6 p.m.

CBS Sports Network will televise both semifinals and the championship game in the LSU bracket.

Florida State defeated Purdue in the last Emerald Coast Classic in 2019. Cincinnati defeated Ole Miss in 2018.

The tournament is held at the Northwest Florida State College in Niceville at Raider Arena with a seating capacity of just under 2,500.

LSU's next home game back in Baton Rouge is Wednesday, Dec. 1 against Ohio.
