1st Year at LSU • 8th Year as a Head Coach

When Matt McMahon stepped to the podium for the first time as the 25th LSU men's basketball head coach he listed the core values of his coaching career and his teams.

"Hard work, unselfishness, toughness, accountability and joy."

Those words are now the cornerstone of LSU Basketball as it moves into a new era as a very successful head coach begins to reshape the program in his image.

The image was on display during the past seven years at Murray State University where the Racers posted a record of 154-67, a .697 winning percentage. He led Murray State to 93 OVC regular-season wins, winning 75 percent of league games.

He has also coached multiple all-Americans and all-league players such as Ja Morant who was named NBA Rookie of the Year in 2020.

The Racers won regular season league titles in 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2022 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2018, 2019 and 2022 (the 2020 appearance was canceled by the pandemic).

Since the native of Oak Ridge, Tennessee, became the third-youngest rookie among D1 coaches in 2015, McMahon has continued a steady move forward with a reputation for developing talent both as an assistant and head coach. He has become known nationally as an excellent recruiter and he is among the best in the nation in the area of player development and game planning.

In his final season at Murray State in 2021-22, McMahon coached OVC Player of the Year KJ Williams and two other recipients of first-team honors (Tevin Brown, Justice Hill). In addition, McMahon was named the league's Coach of the Year.

Two of those players, Williams and Hill, are now at LSU.

Williams, who ranked 12th nationally in 3-pointers made (94), became the third Murray State player to score 1,500 points and grab 800 rebounds. Hill took over point guard duties in a Racer program known for good guards, leading Murray State in assists in 19 games with a plus-101 margin in assists to turnovers.

McMahon's Racers, picked third in the OVC preseason poll, were just the sixth team in league history to go undefeated and the first to do it in an 18-game conference schedule. Murray State then won the two league tournament games to advance to the NCAA Tournament where, as a No. 7 seed, the Racers defeated San Francisco to advance to the round of 32.

The 2021-22 team was one of seven teams to win 30 or more games that season and led the nation in win percentage at 91.2 percent (31-3). The Racers were ranked No. 20 in the final AP poll and No. 22 in the Ferris Mowers Coaches Poll.

McMahon was the first MSU coach to have

three seasons of 25 or more wins and was one of just three Murray State coaches to have four 20-win seasons.

Although the 2019-20 season was called early because of the pandemic, it marked the third year in a three-year run when Coach McMahon led the Racers to three-straight OVC regular season championships (2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20) and two consecutive OVC Tournament titles (2017-18, 2018-19).

Coach McMahon's commitment to defense showed in those years as the Racers ranked as the league leader twice in defensive field goal percentage and each of the three seasons the team led the league in defending the 3-point shot.

The 2018-19 team won 28 games and made its mark in the NCAA Tournament when the 12th-seeded Racers won their fourth all-time tourney game by defeating No. 5 seed Marquette. That season is when Morant stepped to the forefront at Murray State.

He was named the OVC POY, leading Division I in assists and earning first-team all-America honors from the USBWA. In the NCAA Tournament win over Marquette, Morant posted a triple double of 17 points, 11 rebounds and 16 assists as he became the eighth player to record a triple double in the tournament.

He was drafted second overall in the 2019 NBA draft by the Memphis Grizzlies.

In 2017-18, McMahon's team won 26 games and the OVC regular season and tournament championship, sending the Racers to what was at that time the school's 16th NCAA Tournament.

Prior to being named head coach, he was a key part of Coach Steve Prohm's staff as assistant at Murray State as the Racers won a pair of Ohio Valley Conference championships, a CollegeInsider.com Tournament championship and an appearance in the NIT. He was part of a staff that won 104 games from 2011-15.

PRIOR TO MURRAY STATE

Coach McMahon has had success in college basketball since his days as a player at Appalachian

State. Known as an excellent shooter and tough competitor, he played on three Southern Conference regular season title teams in 1998, 1999 and 2000. The Mountaineers won the SoCon Tournament in 2000 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

He played in 90 career games under coach Buzz Peterson and made 124 three-pointers, graduating in 2000.

His coaching career began immediately at Appalachian State as a student assistant under Houston Fancher in 2000-01. He would rejoin Peterson's staff as a student coach at Tennessee before returning to ASU in 2002, where he stayed until the end of the 2009-10 season. A year at UNC Wilmington (2010-11) as assistant coach set the stage for his journey to Murray State, starting first as an assistant in the 2011-12 season and then as head coach prior to the 2015-16 season.

Like his time at Murray State, McMahon coached some outstanding talent in the early stages of his coaching career, including Southern Conference POY Donald Sims as well as all-league picks Jeremy Clayton and D.J. Thompson.

At UNCW, he recruited Adam Smith, a Parade All-America Second-Team selection.

Coach McMahon and his wife Mary, a former standout for the Furman women's basketball team, have three children – Maris, Mason and Mabry.

A NEW DAY FOR LSU BASKETBALL

What all began in 1909 has now begun its 115th season of play as LSU Basketball enters a new age under Coach Matt McMahon. The proven winner from Murray State has had to build a roster completely from scratch as players after the 2021-22 season left for NBA dreams, end of eligibility and the transfer portal. As listed above in some 46 days, Coach McMahon has been able to rebuild his roster from 0 to 16 players which includes 13 scholarship players and three walk-ons. Three players on scholarship returned to be a part of this new day of Tiger basketball -- Mwani Wilkinson, Justice Williams and Adam Miller. Miller is the only one that didn't play last year, having torn an ACL just prior to the team's exhibition contest a year ago.

So, after a combined 36 years of Dale Brown and John Brady, Matt McMahon is the fourth LSU Basketball head coach in the last 15 seasons.

TIGERS PICKED EIGHTH IN SEC

THE SCHEDULE

LSU found itself with one of its most difficult January schedules as assigned by the league. And, even with the win in the opener, here is what it all looks like through the month (ranking at time of playing or Jan. 4 NET rankings):

LSU made 21-of-31 field goals in the second half (67.7) and 6-of-13 three-pointers to keep pace with Winthrop once the Tigers were able to gather the lead. LSU would shoot 54.7 percent for the game, winning for the 17th consecutive time when shooting over 50 percent from the field. LSU turned the ball over just 10 times and had a 21-11 advantage in points off turnovers with Winthrop turning the ball over 12 times.

SOME MATT MCMAHON NUMBERS

Coach Matt McMahon has now won 43-of-48 games dating back to the start of the 2021-22 season. Coach McMahon was 31-3 last year at Murray State and 12-2 this year so far at LSU.

Matt McMahon has now won the last 19-of-20 conference games he has coached entering the weekend, going 18-0 last year at Murray State in the OVC and 1-1 in the SEC this season to date. In his eight years as a head coach, McMahon is 94-32 in conference games.

SEC OPENERS

Coach McMahon became just the second coach to win their first SEC season opening contest in school history with the win over Arkansas (12/28). The other was Dale Morey, who defeated Ole Miss in his first SEC opening game in January 1943. The win over the No. 9 ranked Arkansas team marked the highest ranked opponent LSU has beaten in an SEC opener in program history.

HOME WIN STREAK NOW 13

The Tigers have won 13 straight games at the Maravich Center dating back to the last four games of the 2021-22 season. That ranks T18 in the NCAA as of Thursday..

Kentucky (28 games), Auburn (26), Tennessee (24), Arkansas (18) and LSU (13) are the five SEC schools with present winning streaks of 13 games or more at home. LSU's 13-game win streak is now tied for ninth longest in the 50-plus years of play in the Maravich Center:

23 – 15 games 1980-81 season; First 8 games of the 1981-82 season

18 – three times

17 – Last 3 games 2007-08 season; First 14 games 2008-09 season

16 – Last 4 games 1991-92 season; First 12 games 1992-93 season

14 – twice

13 – five times including last four games 2021-22 season; First nine games 2022-23 season

FINALLY, FOUR

For the first time this season, LSU had more than three players in double figures in a game as four scored 10 or more at Kentucky (1/3). KJ Williams had 23, Adam Miller 15, Trae Hannibal 12 and Cam Hayes 11.

A total of 10 times, three players have been in double figures and three times just two.

ON THE ROAD BACK-TO-BACK

After the close lost at Kentucky, the Tigers will be back on the road for a second straight game against Texas A&M. LSU is now on a four-game road court losing streak dating back to last year.

LSU was 2 and 8 a year ago on the road and in its history, the Tigers have won 40.3 percent on their true road games.

CLOSE GAMES

The three-point battle with both Arkansas (12/28) and at Kentucky (1/3) weren't a rarity for this new group of LSU Tigers as they have played seven games with a final margin of four points or less. LSU is 5-2 in those games with the losses the clock mismanaged finish two-point loss to Kansas State in the Cayman Islands Classic championship event and the loss by three to Kentucky.

LSU has played three other games of 10 points or less with a 3-0 record in those games.

Consistency for longer periods of time has been a constant message for this LSU team and that consistency may have shown more defensively in the win over Arkansas.

But in some of these close games, the Tigers have had to rally for wins:

Vs. Wofford – Wofford up five, 71-66, with 4:26 left in the game, LSU rallied to win, 78-75

Vs. UT Arlington – UTA up four, 6:49 left in the game, LSU rallied to win, 63-59

Vs. Wake Forest – WF was up 39-19 with 4:16 to go in first half; down 8 at the half; rallied to win 72-70

Vs. Arkansas – Ark was up six twice midway through 2nd half, LSU rallied to win, 60-57

SATURDAY'S OPPONENT

Wade Taylor IV, Tyrece Radford and Julius Marble each scored 17 points as Texas A&M had a successful start to league play with a 66-63 road win at Florida on Wednesday night. Taylor made what was the winning basket in the lane with less than a minute to play. A&M built a 34-23 lead at the half and forced 20 turnovers in the game, resulting in 21 points. The Aggies shot just 37.7 percent for the game (23-61) and 2-of-16 from distance and made 18-of-28 free throws.

Buzz Williams is in his fourth season as the head coach at Texas A&M.

The Tigers lead the overall series, which actually began in 1917, 28-18. LSU has won the last 10 in the series starting in 2018, including the last five in Bryan-College Station where Texas A&M leads the series, 10-6.

LSU'S LAST 5

In the last five games, LSU is 4-1, including the two Southeastern Conference contests. In those five games, KJ Williams is averaging 19.0 points and 7.6 rebounds with both Cam Hayes and Derek Fountain each at 11.2 points. Fountain is averaging a team best 9.4 boards in the last five games. Adam Miller and Trae Hannibal are at 9.2 points a contest.

Over those games LSU is 139-of-299 from the field (46.5%), while opponents are 135-of-296 (45.6%).

TRAE HANNIBAL EARNS SEC POW; CONTINUES STRONG PLAY AT KENTUCKY

He's been kind of ignored at times as being one of the Murray State transfers that helped Coach McMahon to the 31-3 record a year ago, but in the opening two games of the SEC slate, Trae Hannibal has been a major difference in the ball game for his team of today, the LSU Tigers.

In fact, for his performance against Arkansas (12/28) in the conference opener that LSU rallied from six down in the second half to win by three points, Hannibal was selected as the SEC Player of the Week by the league office.

Hannibal played 22 minutes off the bench, hitting 9-of-14 shots, including 6-of-7 in the second half, to finish with 19 points and six assists, along with a +/- team best number of +10.

Hannibal's game is coming off a screen and driving through traffic through the lane and scoring. He did that again at Kentucky (1/3) when his team needed it most.

Against the Wildcats he posted 12 points, playing 29 minutes off the bench, making 5-of-6 field goals to record 12 points and four assists.

Hannibal has averaged 20.0 minutes a game and is averaging 6.1 points, 4.1 rebounds and 2.8 assists per game. He is tied for the league lead in scoring after two conference games at 15.5 points a game.

In the two league games, Hannibal is 14-of-20 from the field with nine rebounds and six assists. In LSU's last three games, he has seen his scoring average gone from 4.3 to 6.1 points a game.

There have been several moments of contributions, even those that didn't count.

Hannibal apparently got the Tigers to overtime in the Cayman Islands against Kansas State (11/23), scoring the tying bucket that was later overruled when the clock operator failed to start the clock in the final 4.7 seconds.

He has three double figure scoring games coming off the Tiger bench this season.

Against Winthrop (12/17), Hannibal posted six assists and no turnovers in 21 minutes off the bench.

CAM HAYES EARNING PLAYING TIME AND STARTING SPOT

He's come a long way since the second game of the season when NC State transfer Cam Hayes didn't get off the bench (Coach's Decision). Since then there have been six double figure scoring games and starts in the last five games.

In three of those games in December, Hayes had 13 points, 6 rebounds, no turnovers against Wake Forest (12/10); 14 points, 7 rebounds vs. NCCU (12/13) and 25

points, 4 treys against Winthrop (12/27).

Hayes against Kentucky (1/3) started 2023 off right with 11 points on 3-of-5 shooting, including a big three-pointer in the corner in the second half and then three free throws when fouled on a distance attempt in the final half minute.

At NC State, Hayes averaged 7.8 points in 20-21 and 7.0 points in 21-22. He shot 38.6 percent as a freshman and 33.5 percent as a sophomore. So far in 14 LSU games, Hayes is 38-of-72 from the field or 52.8 percent. He is also 16-of-38 from the arc and an even 80 percent at the line (20-25).

Hayes at LSU is averaging 8.6 points, 2.0 rebounds and 2.2 assists. He has had six games of three or more assists. In the last seven games, his scoring average has gone from 6.1 points per game average to 8.6.

ALL-TRANSFER TEAM

At the beginning of the New Year Jeff Goodman (@Goodman Hoops) put out his All-Transfer Team for the opening part of the season and KJ Williams was on the list.

"Williams followed Matt McMahon from Murray State to LSU and Williams has been even better so far, going from a 33 percent shooter from beyond the arc to 49 percent," wrote Goodman.

KJ WILLIAMS 106 AND 96 AND COUNTING

Two milestones in this five-year career of KJ Williams took place on against Wofford (11/27) as the Tigers won 78-75.

The game marked his 100th win of his college career in games he has played in. Murray State actually won 101 games in which he has dressed, but a win early in his freshman season at Murray State in 2018-19, Williams did not play-coaches decision. So, he came to LSU with 94 wins in games he participated in and now, after the Arkansas game (12/28) has 106 and counting.

While his consecutive double figure streak was stopped against Arkansas (12/28) at nine games, he has 96 total for his college career.

KJ now has 104 college starts between Murray State and LSU and he has started every game (74) over the 2020-21, 2021-22 and now 2022-23 seasons.

And, when he made his one three-pointer against NCCU (12/13) (with 1:09 to go in the first half), it was his 100th career three-point field goal made. He is now at 111 career made three-pointers.

Earlier in the year against Wake Forest (12/10), he made 7-of-9 three-pointers. After making four against Kentucky (1/3), he is now 11-of-20 in the last four games from the arc.

For the year, he is 29-of-57 (50.9%) from distance and for his career he is at 111-of-288 (38.5%)

2000-1000

It is now just five to go for the first of the milestones.

KJ Williams is in the hunt for 2,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds between Murray State and LSU.

He enters Tuesday's game five shy of 1,000 career rebounds at 995 boards.

Presently, he is 1,930 points, needing just 70 to hit the magic 2,000 mark.

Unofficially, 122 players in college basketball have hit the 2,000-1,000 mark in their careers entering the 2022-23 season including some of the biggest names in the history of the game. Among those of interest in Louisiana would be of course Rudy Macklin of LSU (1976-81) who had 2,080 points and 1,276 rebounds.

Also, from schools in Louisiana are Shawn Long at UL-Lafayette (2012-16) with 2,342 points and 1,447 rebounds; Reggie Jackson at Nicholls (1991-95) with 2,124 points and 1,271 rebounds; Willie Jackson of Centenary (1980-84) with 2,535-1,013; Calvin Natt of ULM (1975-79) with 2,581-1,281; and Robert Parish of Centenary (1973-76) with 2,334 points and 1,820 rebounds.

ADAM MILLER

Adam Miller continues to look for the scoring consistency he was showing in the early part of the season as the calendar turns to league play.

Miller earned all-tournament honors in the Cayman Islands Classic after averaging 15.7 points, 1.3 rebounds and 2.0 assists in the three games of the tournament. He had a best of 23 against Akron when he hit five three-pointers in the Tigers semifinal wins.

Against Wofford (11/27), he was important for the Tigers rallying win, hitting a late three-pointer that gave

the Tigers the winning points in the game.

The Wofford game was the third time that Miller has scored over 20 points this season and the second time he scored 26 (vs. Arkansas State, 11/12; Wofford, 11/27).

Against Kentucky (1/3), Miller was able to hit five threes in a 15-points effort. It was the fifth time he has hit four or more threes in a game this season:

6 – vs. Wofford (11/27)

5 – at Kentucky (1/3)

5 – vs. Akron (11/22)

4 – vs. Arkansas State (11/12)

4 – vs. Kansas City (11/9)

Miller hadn't played in a counting regular season game since March of 2021 when Illinois played its final game of the 2020-21 season. He transferred to LSU but tore his ACL prior to the team's exhibition game and missed the entire 2021-22 season. He was medically cleared during the summer for a full go this season and Tiger fans couldn't be happier.

Miller has started all 45 games he has played in (31 at Illinois), averaging 8.3 points at Illinois. At LSU, he is averaging 13.1 points and 2.1 rebounds to go with 1.5 assists.

Miller is at 34 made three-pointers this season to give him 86 for his two seasons of playing.

HILL AT THE POINT

Justice Hill's fake of the defender and drive through an open lane was a game-winner for the Tigers against Wake Forest (12/10) with 1.2 seconds to play at Holiday Hoopsgiving.

Hill hit three three-pointers in each of the last two games to score nine in 27 minutes against Winthrop (12/17) and nine against ETSU (12/21) in 35 minutes. He had three assists against Winthrop and five assists against ETSU, his sixth game of five assists or more this season.

He is averaging 3.6 assists a game with an assist-to-turnover ratio of 2.83. He is third in the league in assist-to-turnover ratio with 51 assists and just 18 turnovers.

Like KJ Williams, he is one of the transfers who played for Coach McMahon at Murray State. He is in his third year of playing for Coach after beginning his career at a junior college.

Hill had seven assists in the opening game and added 11 points. He was in double figures again against UNO (11/17) with 12 points, five assists and three steals and an early season best +32 in plus-minus numbers.

He recorded his season high points game against Akron (11/22) with 14 points on 5-of-11 shooting.

Hill's next three-pointer will be his 100th of his career in Division I basketball. In his three years (two at Murray State and one at LSU) he has 317 career assists and 129 turnovers. He is averaging 7.6 points and 1.9 rebounds.

DEREK FOUNTAIN

Derek Fountain moved into the starting lineup before the Wake Forest game (12/10) and has posted very good numbers with double figures in four of the six contests, including his two collegiate double doubles:

Vs. ETSU – 27 minutes, 11 pts, 8 rebs, 4-5 FG, 2 asts, 1 steal

Vs. Arkansas – 29 minutes, 14 pts, 10 rebs, 5-9 FG, 1 asts, 1 steal

In his last six games, Fountain has scored 76 points, pulled down 58 rebounds and made 29-of-44 field goal attempts.

Fountain is averaging 7.7 points, 5.9 rebounds and 1.6 steals a game. His average in the last seven games has gone from 4.7 to 7.7 points. His rebound average has gone from 3.4 rebounds to 5.9.

Fountain's best season of his two at Mississippi State was the 2020-21 campaign when as a freshman he started 10-of-19 games and averaged 5.4 points. Ironically, his career high came against LSU in Baton Rouge when he scored 20 points.

In 14 games at LSU, he already has more field goals than he had in his sophomore seasons at Mississippi State in 25 games. He has also passed the 102 points he scored at State in the 2020-21 season.

PLUS-MINUS NUMBERS

The box scores this season are including the plus-minus numbers on each the players individually. This number represents how much the team scores while they are on the floor versus how many points the team gives up at the same time which gives a player a plus or minus total for the night.

Derek Fountain who had a five-game run in December of double figure plus games is the team leader for the season of +120 (with 12 plus game), while KJ Williams is at +118 for the year (11 plus games), with Adam Miller at +84 (10) and Cam Hays +80 (9).

JALEN REED

The freshman from Jackson, Mississippi started the first eight games before coming off the bench since then but continuing to play double figure minutes.

His best game came against UNO (11/17) when he scored eight points, hitting all three field goal attempts in 21 minutes. He added six rebounds and a steal in the game.

For the season, Reed is averaging 3.1 points and 2.9 rebounds. He is averaging 16.7 minutes a game. Reed is the son of the late SEC star Justin Reed, who played at Ole Miss (2000-04).

MWANI WILKINSON

Mwani Wilkinson elected to come back to the LSU program after briefly entering the transfer portal following the 2021-22 season. He is the veteran scholarship returnee, having been a part of the Tiger team in both 2020-21 and 2021-22. He has been a part of two NCAA teams and a team that went to the finals of the SEC Tournament in 2021.

Wilkinson had a good opening night (11/9) for the Tigers with nine points making 3-of-4 three-pointers, tying his career highs in threes made in a 22-minute start for LSU.

Wilkinson is averaging 2.6 points and 1.6 rebounds. Wilkinson is 8-of-18 from the arc.

KENDAL COLEMAN

Coleman played 11 minutes against Wofford (11/27), making both field goal attempts and 3-of-3 at the line to finish with seven points, his second highest total of the season.

In the next game against UTA (12/2), Coleman played 13 minutes, making 3-of-4 field goals to again score seven points with six rebounds.

Against NCCU, he made the most of his six-plus minutes, making both field goal attempts with a rebound and a block. It has been the case when asked, Coleman has made the most of his minutes. In the Winthrop game (12/17), Coleman made 2-of-4 from the field with five points and two blocks and for the second time this season grabbing seven rebounds.

The Northwestern State transfer is averaging 2.5 points and 2.4 rebounds

Coleman's season high at LSU was eight points versus Illinois St. in the Cayman Islands (11/21).

JUSTICE WILLIAMS

He hadn't been on the court since the Nov. 17 game against UNO where he suffered an injured left ankle, but when called upon to return to action against Wake Forest (Dec. 10) after missing five games, sophomore Justice Williams was ready.

Last season, he missed the entire non-conference schedule as a freshman before being thrust into action due to other injuries at the start of conference play.

Williams played 17 minutes against the Demon Deacons, scoring five points with a rebound, two assists and a steal.

He has scored in every game since his return in early December.

For the season, Williams is averaging 3.4 points. He has already made more field goals (14) than last year and his 31 points is only three off the 34 he scored last year.

SHAWN PHILLIPS

The freshman, saw his first action since Nov. 21 against Arkansas (12/28) and his longest stint of the season with close to five minutes with an offensive rebound. He also played three minutes at Kentucky.

For the season, Phillips has played in six games.

TYRELL WARD

Dematha Catholic freshman Tyrell Ward has seen action in seven games this season and 5.2 minutes per game. He played 10 minutes in the win over New Orleans in November, scoring three points.

TURNOVERS - ASSISTS

The Tigers were finally able to keep turnovers in the single digits against Wake Forest, recording only seven in the Dec. 10 game. Against one of the top teams in forcing turnovers and points off turnovers in Arkansas (12/28), the Tigers turned the ball over 10 times and the Razorbacks only got four points off turnovers.

And the news was good again against Kentucky (1/3) as in Rupp Arena, the Tigers turned the ball over just nine times, the second time they were in single digits this season.

After posting a negative assist-to-turnover ratio in the first eight games of 102 assists and 111 turnovers, in the last six games the Tigers have dished out 92 assists and 63 turnovers. For the season, the Tigers are averaging 13.9 assists and 12.4 turnovers, while opponents are averaging 11.4 assists and 14.0 turnovers.

STEALS

Last year, the Tigers had their best season ever at stealing the basketball with 373 steals.

So far this season, LSU has also been good at getting steals with 113 steals, an average of 8.1 per game. LSU had a season high of 17 against UNO (11/17). Opponents have only recorded 76 steals.

SHOT CLOCK VIOLATIONS

Last year, LSU was the Division I leader in shot clock violations drawn according to @CBBAnalytics with 38, four more than Richmond and Virginia in college basketball. The total so far this season is nine.

FIELD GOAL PERCENTAGE

Last year, LSU was 16-1 when opponents shot under 40 percent and LSU is 4-0 this year in that category as Kansas City (32.8%), Arkansas State (38.6%), Akron (25.9%) and UTA (37.5%) have shot under 40 percent overall.

The Tigers are 56-2 since the start of the 2017-18 season when opponents shoot under 40 percent.

However, LSU was 6-10 last year when opponents shoot 40 percent or better from the field. LSU is 7-2 this season when teams shoot over 40 percent.

Offensively, the Tigers have won the last 17 games when shooting 50 percent or more in a game and LSU is 104-9 in the last 112 games when LSU shot 50 percent or better since the start of the 2007-08 season. The 50 percent games this season:

LSU vs. UNO (11/17) – 30-of-58, 51.7%

LSU vs. Wofford (11/27) – 28-of-53, 52.8%

LSU vs. Winthrop (12/17) – 35-of-64, 54.7%

FROM THE ARC

The Tigers last season shot just 31.6 percent from the arc and LSU has not shot over 35 percent from the arc since 2012-13 season.

But so far this year, LSU had been better from the three-point arc. For the season, LSU is 107-of-299 (35.8%).

LSU has hit double figure treys in three-of-the-last-six games and four for the season:

FALL 2022 LSU SIGNEES

Corey Chest, New Orleans, La. Link Academy, Brandon, Mo.

The four-star recruit will play this season at Link Academy in Brandon, Missouri. Chest (6-8, 210) played the 2021-22 season at Eleanor McMain High School in New Orleans. He is ranked No. 75 in the 247sports.com and 89 in their national composite rankings. He is listed No. 95 in the ESPN Top 100 for the class of 2023.

Chest was a Class 4A First Team All-State selection in Louisiana averaging 17 points, 10 rebounds, three assists and four blocks. McMain was 28-8 last season and reached the Class 4A title game each of the last two years.

This season, he is listed by 247sports as the No. 16-ranked power forward and No. 2 player in the state of Missouri. He was previously listed as the No. 1 player in the state of Louisiana for the class of 2023 at the end of the 2021-22 basketball season.

Chest also played in the NIKE EYBL circuit for team LIVOn-Fleur De Lis and played for former LSU star and NBA player, Randy Livingston.

Mike Williams, Baltimore, Md. Bishop Walsh HS

Williams, who will play for Bishop Walsh High School in Cumberland, Maryland, is listed at 6-3, 180 pounds and is listed at No. 96 in the nation by 247sports.com and 101 by On3.com.

Williams made a midseason switch to Bishop Walsh this past season which will play in the National Interscholastic Basketball Conference against some of the top schools in the country. In the 60th Alhambra Catholic Invitational Tournament, billed as the most prestigious Catholic high school tournament in the country, Williams averaged 16.7 points per game, 3.9 rebounds, 1.3 assists and 2.0 steals.

In the PrepHoops.com web site for Maryland, Williams is listed as the No. 4-ranked player in the state entering his senior season.

Williams was one of the prospects in the class to show great improvement this summer on the UAA Circuit with Team Thrill of Maryland which won Under Armour Association championship.

THE MARAVICH CENTER

The Tigers are in their 52nd season of play in the Pete Maravich Assembly Center, originally known as the LSU Assembly Center until 1988 when the building was renamed by government legislation followed by the untimely death of the star LSU player.

The Maravich Center is the fourth oldest continuous basketball arena in the league having hosted its first game in January 1972. Memorial Gym at Vanderbilt opened in 1952, Stegeman Coliseum at UGA in 1964 and Coleman Coliseum at Alabama opened in 1968.

LSU was 15-2 a year ago in the building and in 815 games the Tigers have an on-court record of 614-201 (75.3%) ... LSU is 283-157 in conference games (64.3%)

ITS A FATHER AND SON THING

There are a couple of guys who knows something about the Southeastern Conference because their fathers played in the league with good success.

Director of Player Development Ronrico White's father, Tony, was an All-America at Tennessee. Tony White played from 1983 to 1987 at Tennessee.

Then there is freshman Jalen Reed from Jackson, Mississippi, whose late dad, Justin, was an All-America at Ole Miss and the SEC Freshman of the Year in 2001. Justin Reed was an All-SEC selection in each of his four years at Ole Miss, guiding the Rebels to a first ever "Sweet Sixteen" appearance for the program.

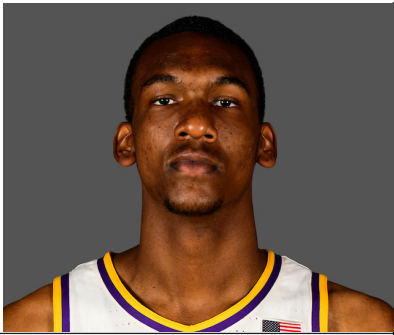

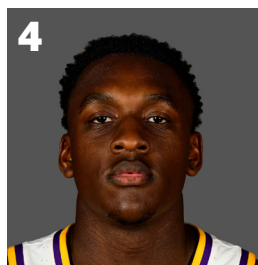

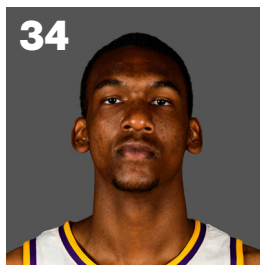
