The Series

LSU is 5-14-5 all-time against Tennessee, having beat the Volunteers 1-0 in Baton Rouge the last time they met during the 2023 season. Tennessee soccer entered the 2025 season unranked but quickly entered the national polls after two top-five wins in three matches to start the season. Currently, the Lady Vols are No. 5 in United Soccer Coaches Poll rankings. UT's highest ranking in the program's history came in week four when the squad earned a No. 1 national ranking. The Volunteers concluded their non-conference slate with an unbeaten overall record of 6-0-1. In that timespan, UT also shut out its opponents while scoring 19 goals. Through the seven matches of non-conference play, Tennessee has had eight different goal-scorers. Tennessee shares third place in the conference rankings for most goals thus far with 23 total and are second in the assists category with 27. They've only allowed three goals this season, ranking first in the SEC in shut outs with eight on the year.

Last Time on the Pitch

LSU came up short in a 2-1 battle against Alabama last Thursday night at the LSU Soccer stadium. The Tigers strong effort fell just short due to a deciding 83rd minute goal from Alabama that gave the Tide a 2-1 lead and ultimately leading to the Tigers dropping their SEC home opener. LSU had a three-match win streak at home prior to Thursday's result. Alabama's Nadia Ramadan opened scoring with an Olympic goal before LSU Freshman Sariyah Bailey equalized. Ramadan scored again in the 83rd minute to secure the win for Alabama on Thursday.

Storylines

- The Tigers began their 2025 season in the win column on August 14 as the the program embarks on a new journey to their fifth consecutive NCAA berth this coming November.
- LSU is led by Sian Hudson, who is in her sixth season as Head Coach of the Tigers. Hudson has led the Tigers to postseason appearances in four out of five seasons at the helm thus far.
- LSU had seven players named to the 2025 SEC Preseason Watchlist - Sydney Cheesman, Jazmin Ferguson, Makenna Dominguez, Ava Galligan, Ida Hermannsdottir, Gabbi Ceballos and Amy Smith.
- The Tigers entered the 2025 season placed No. 11 by the league in the coaches poll.
- In their fifth game of the 2025 season, LSU secured their first top-25 victory at home since 2021.
- This year, LSU returned 18 players from last year's roster and welcomed 10 newcomers, including six internationals.
- LSU's roster includes players from around the world - including Spain, France, Canada, Czech and Iceland.

2025 Preseason SEC Watchlist

Ninety-nine student-athletes have been named to the 2025 SEC Soccer Preseason Watchlist. Representing the Tigers on this year's list are Gabbi Ceballos, Sydney Cheesman, Makenna Dominguez, Jazmin Ferguson, Ava Galligan, Ida Hermannsdóttir and Amy Smith.

This year's preseason watchlist announcement marked the second straight year that Cheesman, Ferguson and Galligan were named to the list while it was the third straight year for Hermannsdóttir.

The SEC's 10 NCAA selections in 2024 were the most in conference history and were tied for the most in the nation. Eight of the 10 selections were seeded and hosted their first round matchups.

Cheesman and Ferguson are veterans in the backline for the Tigers as both enter their final season in 2025. The two both played and started in all but one match for the Tigers last season, helping lead LSU to their fourth consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance.

The defensive duo also serve as examples on and off the field, as Ferguson is this year's captain and Cheesman is on the leadership council.

Ceballos is in her second season with the Tigers this year after coming from TCU. The midfielder will begin her junior season having played every match in her debut season last year and scoring two goals.

Galligan also enters her junior season in 2025. With two seasons under her belt at LSU, the forward returns valuable experience to the Tigers offense, owning nine career goals, with five of those coming last year. Galligan was the second highest goal scorer for the Tigers in 2024.

Hermannsdóttir, the Tigers leading goal scorer three years in a row, enters her senior season with 19 goals and 60 appearances on the pitch. The Icelandic forward will look to lead the Tigers attacking efforts once again.

Smith earned a spot on this year's watchlist after an impressive freshman season with the Tigers in 2024. The forward played in 18 matches and scored two goals as she

Dominguez transferred to LSU for her fifth and final season this year from the 2024 National Champions North Carolina. The midfielder adds extensive experience to the Tigers roster this year.

Leadership

This year's squad returned a lot of maturity on and off the field. LSU is captained by the senior duo of Jazmin Ferguson and Kelsey Major in 2025. The two will lead this year's team with the help of a leadership council.

Graduate transfer Morgan Witz, senior Sydney Cheesman and sophomore Ava Amsden serve as the team's leadership council and will help the captains manage balancing responsibility of the team.

Roster Breakdown

This season's roster features 28 student-athletes representing diverse backgrounds from across the globe. Eighteen players return from last year's squad, joined by 10 newcomers—including six international additions.

Newcomers Sol Toboada Martínez, Mireia Sánchez, Gadea Blanco González, and Daniela Hellín hail from Spain, Maud Ferrière joins from France, and Sariyah Bailey arrives from Canada. Freshmen Lila Jaillet and Ryann Denecour round out the first-year class.

The sophomore group includes Katelyn Holt, Annaleigh Bruser, Amy Smith, Ava Amsden, Sarah Stadler, Senai Rogers, and Natalie Dvorakova.

Gabbi Ceballos, Ava Galligan, Brielyn Knowles, and Audur Scheving enter their junior campaigns, while the senior class features Jazmin Ferguson, Sydney Cheesman, Kelsey Major, Danielle Shannon, Jocelyn Ollivierre, Sophine Kevorkian, Ida Hermannsdóttir, Makenna Dominguez, and Morgan Witz.

Dominguez and Witz joined the Tigers in the spring as graduate transfers from North Carolina and California Baptist, respectively.

International Flair

This season's roster features 28 student-athletes representing diverse backgrounds from across the globe. Eighteen players return from last year's squad, joined by 10 newcomers—including six international additions.

Newcomers Sol Toboada Martínez, Mireia Sánchez, Gadea Blanco González, and Daniela Hellín hail from Spain, Maud Ferrière joins from France, and Sariyah Bailey arrives from Canada.

Six countries are represented in the squad (United States, Spain, France, Canada, Czech and Iceland).

Of the remaining roster, four are native to Colorado, four to California, two to Louisiana, two to Georgia, two to Virginia, two to Texas and one each from Rhode Island, Wisconsin and Florida.

2025 Season

LSU is currently receiving votes for a spot in the national rankings by the United Soccer Coaches Poll. The Tigers have five wins on their resume this year, last taking down Utah on the road. The Purple & Gold squad owns wins over South Alabama, FGCU, UC Davis and a top-25 victory over No. 21 Wisconsin this year. Their win over the Badgers was the program's first ranked victory at home since 2021.

The Tigers have scored 18 goals on the year and currently sit in the top-10 in the SEC in shots (139), assists (13), saves (29) and goals entering tomorrow's match.

Junior forward Ava Galligan is the Tigers leading scorer with five on the year thus far, which places her amongst the top-10 leading scorers in the SEC (tied for eighth-most). Galligan scored the game winner in LSU's match against No. 21 Wisconsin to secure the win over the nationally ranked Badgers.

Hermannsdóttir, the second-highest active player in the conference with the most career goals (22), follows Galligan with three goals on the year while Witz owns two. Witz is a graduate transfer who joined the Tigers for her final season in 2025.

Freshman Sariyah Bailey has been outstanding on the attack for LSU in her debut season, tallying two goals of her own this year and three assists. Jazmin Ferguson, Kelsey Major, Gabbi Ceballos, Senai Rogers and Ryann Denecour have all tallied one goal each as well.

Senior goalkeeper Sophine Kevorkian started in the first seven matches in between the posts for LSU, tallying a 1.34 goals-against average (GAA), 17 saves and two shutouts through six matches.

Scheving, the junior from Iceland, has earned the starting keeper position for LSU in their last three matches, earning a clean sheet in two. She owns 11 saves on the year.

There are multiple Tigers who have started in every match for LSU this year, including veteran centre back and captain Jazmin Ferguson, as well as Jocelyn Ollivierre, Kelsey Major, and Ida Hermannsdóttir.

Sian Hudson

HEAD COACH • 6th Season



Sian (pronounced SHAWN) Hudson was named LSU's head coach on December 11, 2019. Since that date, she's helped take LSU to places its never been before. A No. 5 national ranking in the fall of 2021, the highest in program history, and she's already amassed five wins over nationally ranked teams. In only her third season as head coach of the Fighting Tigers, Hudson led her squad to the program's eighth NCAA Tournament appearance in 2022 and marked the second postseason appearance in her LSU career. The Tigers first round win over Lamar on November 11 marked Hudson's first victory in the NCAA Tournament. Hudson recorded the program's 13th ten-win season with an overall record of 10-4-7 in 2022. The Tigers shutout five opponents and recorded a draw against three ranked opponents.

Now entering her sixth season at the helm of the LSU Soccer program, Hudson will look to lead the Tigers to their fifth consecutive postseason appearance in the NCAA Tournament. This streak is the longest by any coach in program history.

Hudson and the LSU Soccer program invest in developing their players. In her time as head coach, Hudson has had six players take their talents to the next level. Shannon Cooke, Lindsy Jennings, Alesia Garcia, Brenna McPartlan, Tinaya Alexander and Athene Kuehn were coached and developed by Hudson and are now playing professionally across the world.

In five years, Hudson and the Tigers have shattered LSU Soccer Stadium attendance records. Two of the program's top ten all-time largest crowds were under Hudson as LSU continues to be one of the top program's nationally with fan attendance, earning Top 15 status in 2021. The 2021 fall season started off about as good as it could have with the Tigers winning eight straight under the direction of Hudson. Included in those eight straight wins were triumphs over three ranked squads – No. 15 USF, No. 19 UCF, and No. 21 Arizona State. Pair those eight wins with the final three from the spring season of 2021 and LSU had won a program record 11 straight games.

The LSU Soccer Stadium has welcomed three of the program's top-10 largest crowds in total thanks to Hudson's efforts.

LSU tallied a total of four ranked wins during the 2021 season. The aforementioned three above in an 11-day span from late August to early September, and then the biggest one of them all came in the regular season finale against No. 4 Arkansas. With LSU's season on the line, the Tigers came out with a fiery passion under Hudson on Oct. 28, 2021, as the Tigers handed the Razorbacks their first and only loss of the conference regular season with a 4-2 victory. The win solidified LSU's positioning in the SEC and NCAA Tournament and was the highest ranked win in program history.

LSU scored 40 goals on the season while only conceding 25 times in 2021; that goal differential of 15 was the highest for the program since 2009. The 40 goals were the most in program history since 2009 as well. Fourteen different players factored into the scoresheet with goals to match the program record for most individual goals scorers in a single season.

Only three months into her gig at the helm of LSU soccer in March of 2020, the COVID-19 pandemic struck and halted all of collegiate athletics, but Hudson didn't let that deter her. Fast forward five months and the LSU soccer team returned to campus and began practice for the 2020-21 season, its first under Hudson. Hudson's first win of her LSU career came on November 13, 2020, as the Tigers shutout Alabama for a 2-0 win over Alabama in the first round of the SEC Tournament in Orange Beach, Alabama. The Tigers followed that up with a 2-1 win over No. 14 Ole Miss two days later to advance to the SEC quarterfinals in their first SEC Tournament appearance under Hudson's reign.

The 2020-21 season featured fall and spring games counted towards LSU's team record and Hudson made the most of the spring with her team. She led her squad to a record of 6-1-1 in the spring of 2021 and the level of expectation within the program has risen heading into the fall of 2021. The Tigers ended the 2020-21 season with an RPI of 54.

Hudson came to LSU with nearly 20 years of coaching experience. She came to Baton Rouge after serving as the head coach at the University of Colorado at Colorado Springs for the past three seasons. During her time as head coach at UCCS, Hudson led the Mountain Lions to a 52-10-4 record. Each of those three seasons saw UCCS qualify for the NCAA Tournament, the first three appearances in school history, including a run to the national semifinals in 2017. Her win totals in each of

The LSU Soccer Stadium saw the 2007 and 2015 seasons standing out the most with unbeaten records on the home pitch. 2007 saw the Tigers go 5-0-3 and 2015's unbeaten record at home was 8-0-4.

The impressive run with an unbeaten 5-0-3 home slate in 2007 was followed by an impressive 8-1 campaign in 2008, a 7-1-2 season in 2009, a 6-2-1 mark in 2010 and a stellar 7-1-1 season in 2011. While winning four SEC Western Division championships and making four trips to the NCAA Tournament from 2007-11, the Tigers posted a 33-5-7 record with a .811 winning percentage. They most recently finished the 2015 season unbeaten at home with an 8-0-4 mark in 12 matches played in Baton Rouge.

In fact, LSU's home performance is highlighted by a school record 18-game home unbeaten streak that came to an end on Oct. 26, 2008, with a 2-1 defeat to the No. 6-ranked Florida Gators.

2022 marked the 27th season in the life of the LSU Soccer Stadium, which was first opened on Sept. 13, 1996, when the Tigers hosted SEC rival Tennessee.

The 2021 season saw multiple record breaking moments for the Tigers. LSU had the longest winning streak in the program with eight straight victories. The soccer stadium also saw a record breaking attendance in the 2021 season. In the Tigers match against Mississippi State on September 17, a crowd of 3,021 people showed out to watch the Tigers defeat the Bulldogs 2-0 at home. The attendance marked the highest in program history. LSU averaged 1,334 fans per home match during the 2021 season to set the program record, and that average ranked as the 12th highest in the nation.

In 2022, Hudson drew in the sixth largest crowd in program history against Missouri with 2,004 fans on September 22.

This year, Hudson and the Tigers continued to shatter LSU Soccer Stadium attendance records as they welcomed another Top-10 crowd in program history in a conference matchup against Florida.

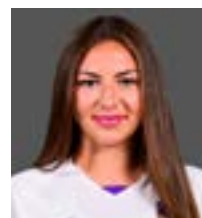
