4th Year at LSU · 11th Year as a Head Coach

Coach Matt McMahon has built his

LSU Coach Matt McMahon has built his program around five core values that define his approach both on and off the court: hard work, unselfishness, toughness, accountability and joy.

Those values were among the first principles he shared when introduced as the 25th head coach in program history on March 22, 2022, and they continue to guide every aspect of LSU Basketball today.

Now entering his fourth season at the helm, Coach McMahon leads a Tigers team energized by a strong recruiting class that blends proven transfers with talented freshmen. The 2025-26 squad is poised to build on the foundation laid in recent years, with an emphasis on chemistry, relentless effort, and steady progress.

This current group thrives on its chemistry, playing for each other with toughness, accountability, and an unselfish spirit. Their joy for the game is evident every time they take the floor, uniting players, coaches, and fans alike.

Guided by those five core principles, the Tigers have continued to strengthen the program's foundation, setting the stage for growth in 2025-26. With added talent and depth at all positions, this year's roster is built to take the next step forward.

Player development remains a cornerstone in the Matt McMahon LSU basketball program.

Robert Miller III enters his sophomore season ready to build on flashes of promise from his freshman year. Over the summer, Miller has committed himself to individual skill development and strength training to add both power and polish his game.

Jalen Reed returns for his redshirt junior season after an early December ACL injury cut short what had been a breakout year. Known for his drive and work ethic, Reed attacked his rehab this summer showing steady progress toward a full return.

The summer has given new players valuable time to work closely with the coaching staff and strength and conditioning coach Mike Chatman, focusing on improving their skills and physical readiness for the long season ahead.

The program has already shown it can take measurable steps forward under Matt McMahon's leadership. In 2024, LSU advanced to postseason play after back-to-back wins over No. 11 South Carolina, 64-63, in Columbia and then a 75-74 win over No. 17 Kentucky in BR.

Last season, LSU showed what it was capable of, beating Florida State in its SEC/ACC Challenge game, winning a triple-overtime win at the Greenbrier over UCF, a road victory at Kansas State, and an amazing rally in the final

minute to win at Oklahoma.

McMahon's track record of building winning cultures was firmly established during his seven seasons at Murray State. Coach McMahon led the Racers to a record of 154-67 (.697) including: 93 OVC regular season wins, winning 75 percent of league games.

During his tenure, he has also coached multiple all-Americans and all-conference players. The most notable was Ja Morant, who went on to become the 2020 NBA Rookie of the Year.

Under McMahon the Racers won regular season league titles in 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2022 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2018, 2019 and 2022.

In his final season at Murray State in 2021-22, McMahon coached OVC Player of the Year KJ Williams and two other first-teamers (Tevin Brown, Justice Hill). In addition, McMahon was named the league's Coach of the Year.

McMahon's Racers, in 2021-22, were just the sixth team in league history to go undefeated. Murray State then won the league tournament to advance to the NCAA Tournament where the Racers defeated San Francisco in the opening round.

The 2021-22 team was one of seven teams to win 30 or more games that season and led the nation in win percentage at 91.2 percent.

The 2018-19 team won 28 games and made its mark in the NCAA Tournament when the 12th-seeded Racers won their fourth all-time tourney game over No. 5 seed Marquette.

Morant that year was named the OVC POY, leading Division I in assists and earning first-team All-America honors. In the NCAA Tournament win over Marquette, Morant posted a triple double of 17 points, 11 rebounds and 16 assists as he became the eighth player to record a triple double in the tournament.

He was drafted second overall in the 2019 NBA draft by the Memphis Grizzlies.

Prior to being named head coach, he was a key part of Coach Steve Prohm's staff as assistant at Murray State as the Racers won a pair of Ohio

Valley Conference championships, a CollegelInsider.com Tournament championship and an appearance in the NIT. He was part of a staff that won 104 games from 2011-15.

PRIOR TO MURRAY STATE
Coach
McMahon has had

success in college basketball since his days as a player at Appalachian State.

Known as an excellent shooter and tough competitor, he played on three Southern Conference regular season title teams in 1998, 1999 and 2000. He earned All-Tournament honors in 1999. The Mountaineers won the SoCon Tournament in 2000 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

He played in 117 career games under coach Buzz Peterson and made 135 three-pointers, graduating in 2000.

His coaching career began immediately at Appalachian State as assistant under Houston Fancher in 2000-01. He would rejoin Peterson's staff as a graduate assistant coach at Tennessee before returning to ASU in 2002 as assistant and later associate head coach, where he stayed until the end of the 2009-10 season. A year at UNC Wilmington (2010-11) as assistant coach set the stage for his journey to Murray State, starting first as an assistant in the 2011-12 season and then as head coach prior to the 2015-16 season.

Coach McMahon and his wife Mary, a former standout for the Furman women's basketball team, have three children – Maris, Mason and Mabry.

NOTABLES

LSU has scored 90-plus points in each of the first three games – 96 versus Tarleton State, 93 versus New Orleans and a season high 98 versus FIU. The last time the Tigers started with three straight 90-points games was the 1990-91 season when Shaquille O'Neal was a sophomore and LSU scored 90-plus in the first nine games.

LSU through three games is averaging 46.0 rebounds a game compared to 29.7 for opponents. LSU has a rebound margin of +49 combined in those three games and a rebound margin of +16.33, which as of Friday morning was fifth in the SEC.

LSU has three players averaging at least 6.0 rebounds a game through the first three games – Marquel Sutton 9.7, Pablo Tamba 7.3 and Jalen Reed 6.0. Sutton is ranked fourth in the league.

This is the final week of a five-game opening homestand for the Tigers. After this game and the Friday game with Omaha, the Tigers will be away from the Maravich Center for almost a full month as the Tigers will play four neutral site games with a road trip to Boston College thrown in for the ACC/SEC Challenge.

This will be the 400th non-conference game LSU men's basketball has played in the 55 years of the Maravich Center. LSU is 350-49 in non-conference games.

ALCORN STATE SERIES

This will be the fifth time LSU and Alcorn State have played with LSU winning all four previous meetings. That includes an NCAA Tournament contest in 1980 when LSU was a 98-88 winner. The teams also met in 1999, 2008 and the last meeting was in 2017.

ALCORN STATE UPDATES

Alcorn State is in the midst of a lengthy travel schedule that will not see them play a home game in Lorman, Mississippi until Jan. 17.

The Braves are coming off a 72-64 loss at Howard this past Thursday. Jameel Morris led Alcorn with 15 points, while Tycen McDaniels had 14 and Davian Williams added 11. Alcorn State shot 41.4 percent from the floor with six treys.

Longtime Division I assistant coach Jake Morton is in his first year as the head coach at Alcorn State. He most recently served with

Leonard Hamilton at Florida State. Prior to that he served at East Carolina, Jacksonville State, Miami, Western Kentucky, Coppin State, James Madison, St. Francis (Pa.) and Bowie State.

PETE MARAVICH ASSEMBLY CENTER

The Tigers opened their 55th season of play in the building in 2025-26 with three wins after going 11-7 in the venue last season. LSU is 641-222 in the building. LSU is 350-49 (87.7 percent) in non-conference games.

LSU was 9-0 in non-conference games in the Maravich Center in the 2024-25 season.

The building was originally known as the LSU Assembly Center from its opening in late 1971 until August 1988 when the building was renamed by government legislation following the untimely death of star LSU player, "Pistol" Pete Maravich.

The Maravich Center is the fourth oldest continuous use basketball arena in the league having hosted its first game in January 1972. Memorial Gym at Vanderbilt opened in 1952, Stegeman Coliseum at UGA in 1964 and Coleman Coliseum at Alabama opened in 1968.

RECAP: LSU's strong start to the game and a 15-0 run in the first 10 minutes of the second half spelled the difference as the Tigers held UNO to just 29.9 percent shooting from the field, while again showcasing players talents on the offensive end of the court. LSU hit 10 treys, had two players with 10+ rebounds and four players in double figures while turning the ball over just seven times. Added to that was a 56-36 advantage on rebounding and 21 assists on 31 field goal attempts.

Marquel Sutton had 15 points and 15 rebounds and Pablo Tamba added 10 points with 10 boards. But it was Mike Nwoko who had the big scoring night iwth 22 points. Jalen Reed had another double figure night with 15 points.

THIRD TIME MCMAHON'S TIGERS HOLD OPPONENTS SHOOTING UNDER 30 PERCENT

LSU's defense ability was on display against New Orleans (11/10) as the Tigers held UNO to just 29.9 percent from the field (20-of-67), the third time in Matt McMahon's tenure at LSU, that the Tiger defense kept a team from reaching the 30.0 percent mark from the field.

The three games in the McMahon era:

- 1 **25.4% (15-59) by Texas A&M (at College Station), 1/6/24**
- 2 **25.9% (14-54) by Akron (at Cayman Islands), 11/22/22**
- 3 **29.9% (20-67) by UNO (at Baton Rouge), 11/10/25**

LSU is 26-5 in the McMahon era when opponents shoot under 40 percent.

THE SHOOTING RECORDS

The Tigers put the game away in the second half against New Orleans thanks to 50 percent shooting of 16-of-32 as LSU scored 49 second half.

This followed a record opener when LSU finished with a shooting percentage school mark of 71.7 percent for the game against Tarleton State (11/5) on Nov. 5.

LSU was 33-of-46 in the contest, sparked by the 16-of-21 in the first half of the game.

It marked the third time that an LSU basketball team has shot 70 percent or better in a basketball game:

71.7% -- vs. Tarleton State (in Baton Rouge) – 11/5/25

71.4% -- vs. Clemson (in Charlotte) – 12/20/69

70.3% -- vs. Centenary (in Baton Rouge) – 1/15/03

According to our content manager Todd Politz, the game also set a record for best two-point field goal percentage (making 25-of-28), topping the mark of a game just the previous season:

89.3% -- vs. Tarleton State (in Baton Rouge) – 11/5/25

87.2% -- vs. Mississippi Valley (in Baton Rouge) – 12/29/24

75.8 -- vs. Memphis (in Lake Buena Vista, Florida) – 11/29/13

LSU in the FIU game (11/13), shot 53.3 percent from the field (32-of-60) and the Tigers are now 14-4 in the Matt McMahon era when the Tigers shoot 50 percent or more.

ON THE REBOUND SIDE

The New Orleans game (11/10) was the third time in the Matt McMahon era that LSU has pulled down 50 plus rebounds:

1 56 – vs. New Orleans, 11/10/25

2 56 – vs. UCF, 11/24/24

3 50 – vs. New Orleans, 12/22/24

A SINGLE DIGIT TURNOVER NIGHT

LSU got its ball security under control against New Orleans (11/10), only losing control of the ball twice in the final 20 minutes, to finish with seven total turnovers. That is only the sixth time in the Matt McMahon era that LSU has turned the ball seven times or less in a game.

JALEN REED CONTINUES STRONG COMEBACK

Through three games, Tiger redshirt junior Jalen Reed, has continued to become more and more comfortable on the floor.

So far, he has played 54:33, scored 36 points with 19 rebounds. He has scored 11, 15 and 10 points with Reed shooting 14-of-20 from the field (70.0%) and making 2-of-3 three-point field goals.

Reed is returning from ACL surgery, an injury suffered in early Decision 2024 against Florida State.

Ahead of projections, he has been able to see the floor in a minutes restricted basis, playing 18:29 against Tarleton State, after a similar amount in the exhibition with UCF. As of now, the game minutes that trainer Grant Smith and strength and conditioning coach Mike Chatman allow Reed are expected to continue to slowly increase.

His first points came at the 14:49 mark of the first half of the Nov. 5 game on a fast break layup in the paint off a pass from Dedan Thomas Jr. Reed finished with 11 points on 3-of-4 shootings, with one trey, an assist and two steals.

MIKE NWOKO OFF TO GOOD START

Junior transfer from Mississippi State, Mike Nwoko, has had a good first three games with LSU, leading in scoring in one game and co-leading in another.

After scoring 11 in the opener, Nwoko had 22 points against New Orleans (11/10) and then had 19 in the FIU (11/13).

The native of Toronto, Canada, has brought the baby hook to his LSU repertoire and he has shown his shooting ability with three shooting games of 5-of-6, 9-of-13 and 6-of-7 for 20-of-26 (76.9 percent) for the first three games. As of Saturday morning, Nwoko has the best shooting percentage in the league.

Nwoko's previous game high was 18 points on two occasions -- vs. Central Michigan, 12/17/24; and, against Pittsburgh, 12/4/24

After three games, Nwoko is averaging 17.3 points and 5.0 rebounds a game

MARQUEL SUTTON

Marquel Sutton has posted back-to-back double double games against New Orleans (11/10) and FIU (11/13). The transfer from Omaha, who will play his former team on Friday, has posted 15 points-15 rebounds against New Orleans and 19 points-12 rebounds against FIU. Sutton has had 15 double doubles.

The last player to have more than two straight double doubles was Ben Simmons in the 2025-16 who had streaks of four and seven.

Sutton has made multiple threes in each of the games with two points against Tarleton State, four against New Orleans and three against FIU. Sutton is 9-of-19 from the three-point line.

Sutton is averaging close to 30 minutes a game, having played 88:59 minutes.

THE TIGERS AT THE POINT

LSU has found itself a strong start point guard in UNLV transfer Dedan Thomas Jr., who has 22 assists and just six turnovers in the first three games of the season. Thomas had eight assists against both Tarleton State and New Orleans and six assists against FIU.

Thomas has made 12-of-23 from the field (52.2 percent) and 15-of-16 from three throw line (93.8 percent).

Thomas has two double figure games to date, scoring 16 versus Tarleton State (11/5) and 15 in the most recent contest against FIU (11/13).

Thomas is also averaging 4.3 rebounds a game.

For his career, Thomas is 91 points shy of 1,000 career points. He has 318 career assists and just 130 turnovers, a 2.45 assist-to-turnover ratio.

Jalen Reece, a freshman, handles the backup point guard role and has played almost 40 minutes this season in three games with seven assists. He is averaging 2.3 points a game.

A 45 +/- ON THE STAT SHEET

While Marquel Sutton had a very nice 15 points, 15 rebounds game against New Orleans, but when you glanced at the stat sheet, you found that the plus-minus for Sutton was a pretty amazing +45.

College basketball's plus/minus is determined by tracking the point differential of the game for each player on the court. It's calculated by summing the points scored by a player's team when they are in the game and subtracting the points scored by the opponent during the same period.

THE LSU COACHING TIES

As Coach Matt McMahon enters his fourth season at LSU, there are a lot of familiar faces on the LSU coaching staff, including some of those who donned the purple and gold during their college careers.

Ronald Dupree -- General Manager -- a first time position for LSU basketball ... Dupree, recently inducted to the LSU Athletics Hall of Fame, was an 11-year pro and long-time NBA scout, executive with the Milwaukee Bucks ... Played at LSU (1999-03), member Sweet 16 team in 2000 and is ninth in career scoring (1,726 points) ... Scouting work contributed to 2021 Bucks NBA title.

Jalen Courtney-Williams -- Assistant Coach -- Second year on the LSU staff ... Three-year letterman at LSU (2010-13); played in 61 games ... Came to LSU from Creighton where he served for three seasons, including a Sweet 16 year in 2024 ... Hosts the popular podcast "No Timeouts" on LSU+ and various podcast locations.

Tasmin Mitchell -- Assistant Coach/Director of Personnel -- In his ninth year as member of the LSU staff; second stint as Assistant Coach beginning in 2025-26 season ... One of the most popular former LSU Basketball stars; member of 2006 NCAA Final Four team ... Third all-time in scoring at LSU with 1,989 points (14.5 ppg average); sixth in rebounds (950), school record 4,692 minutes; 136 career starts ... One of three Tigers with 1,000 points, 500 rebounds, 200 assists and 100 steals.

David Patrick, the Associate Head Coach, is also familiar to Tiger fans in the second year of his second stint in the program. He served as Assistant/Associate Coach from 2012-16 during the Johnny Jones head coaching tenure. **Vince Walden,** who was at Texas A&M last year, and fourth year assistant, **Casey Long,** completes the on floor coaching staff.

IMPORTANT WORDS

Coach Matt McMahon has had his five core value words since he arrived at LSU: hard work, unselfishness, toughness, accountability and joy.

All five of those are a vital part of this program's DNA, but this year the players as a team have picked out three words that they want to be the standard for the LSU program. Those words are on a lot of the team shooting shirts and coaching shirts the team wears. Those words are:

THINGS TO WATCH

Some points to watch in the non-conference:

TURNOVERS -- LSU averaged 13.1 turnovers a game last season and will be looking to try to lower that number this season ... LSU had just five games with single digit miscues in 2024-25. LSU turned the ball over 419 times compared to 409 assists. The Tigers were 14th in turnover margin at -1.47 and 15th in assist-to-turnover ratio at 0.98.

THREE POINT SHOOTING -- A season ago, LSU made the third most three-point field goals in school history (250), but took 50 more shots than any LSU team had attempted to make those 250 (820) for a percentage of just 30.5 percent. The Tigers were 16th in the league in three-point percentage in 2024-25. LSU made the second most three-pointers in 2023-24 (256), but needed 103 less shots to achieve those makes.

FREE THROWS -- The Tigers had their first game since 2022 when they failed to convert at least 50 percent of their free throw attempts and that was kind of how the free throw shooting went in 2024-25 as it was up and down, culminating in a 13-of-26 performance in the SEC Tournament game. LSU was 437-of-612 or 71.4 percent.

WHAT MAKES THIS YEAR'S TEAM DIFFERENT?

There are several factors that offer the potential for this year's team to be a different LSU team in 2025-26:

AGE, MATURITY – In 2023-24, the average age of the players was just over 19 ... In 2025-26, the average age is right around 22. In fact, as Coach McMahon said to some media, he had never celebrated a player's 24th birthday before. The roster has four freshmen (three from high school, one from the Israeli pro league), one sophomore, three juniors, two seniors, three 5th year seniors and a grad student.

ROSTER MANAGEMENT – The Tigers put together the players that it feels will help them make the necessary strikes during this season. A larger, more physical front-court, wings that can shoot the three and a point guard that can be trusted to run the team, score the ball and distribute the basketball.

CONNECTIVITY AND CHEMISTRY – This group of players that were good at their respective schools has blended together and understood the mission. Do what is necessary to make LSU relevant again in the SEC. They've accepted that mission that they have to work together and the chemistry shown in practice over the summer and preseason is something that coaches and attendees at practice have noticed quite quickly.

SONS OF THE FATHER

Two Tigers have fathers who also did well in the college basketball game in the past.

Jalen Reed's late father, Justin, starred at Ole Miss, where he was an All-America and the SEC Freshman of the Year in 2001. Justin Reed was an All-SEC selection in each of his four years at Ole Miss, guiding the Rebels to two NCAA Tournament wins en route to a first ever "Sweet 16" appearance for the Rebels. He was a second-round pick in the 2004 NBA Draft by the Boston Celtics and played for Boston and Minnesota in his NBA days. He passed away from cancer in 2017.

Point guard DJ Thomas Jr., is the son of UNLV star Dedan Thomas Sr. Senior played from 1991-94 at UNLV, He would earn honorable mention All-America honors and has his name throughout the UNLV record book.

Also, Robert Miller III is the son of a couple of former athletes. His dad, Robert Miller II, was an LSU defensive lineman in college, while his mom, Teana, earned All-America basketball honors at Tulane, also playing four years in the WNBA.

ROBERT MILLER III DOING SOME PASSING THINGS

Sophomore Robert Miller III, one of the two returnees on this team along with Jalen Reed, had six points in the game against New Orleans (11/10), but what was more impressive was that he contributed four assists in just one turnover in 20 minutes.

In the first three games, Miller is averaging 7.7 points, 4.3 rebounds and 2.0 assists, playing an average of 22.9 minutes per game.

PABLO TAMBA

Tamba, the transfer from UC Davis, has a double double to his credit this season with 10 points and 10 rebounds against New Orleans (11/10) and he has had good rebound numbers in all three games, averaging 7.3 a game (second on the team).

Tamba is 9-of-13 from the field (69.2%)

FORMER LSU PLAYER GETS A TRIPLE DOUBLE

Former LSU star Trendon Watford made a big impression for his new team, the Philadelphia 76ers on Nov. 8 when in his first start for the 76ers he posted a triple double.

Watford had 20 points, a career high 17 rebounds to go with a career high 10 assists. Watford made 8-of-10 field goals.

According to the NBA as of Nov. 8, Watford joined Nikola Jokić, Josh Giddey & Russell Westbrook as the ONLY players to record 20+ PTS, 15+ REB & 10+ AST in a game here in the early season.

Watford is one of six former Tigers on NBA rosters.

The Tigers five-game homestand concludes on Friday with the Omaha Mavericks coming to the Maravich Assembly Center at 7 p.m. Fans can use their Western Kentucky football ticket and get into the game for free.

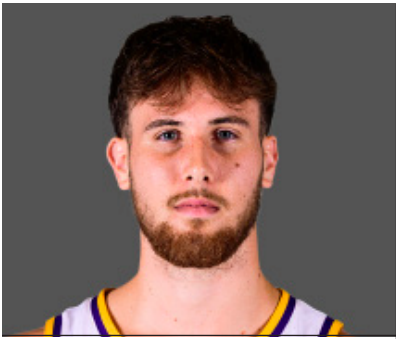
