STEP 3 Remove the rear seat bracket by removing the three fasteners securing it to the fender.

CAUTION! To avoid damage to the motorcycle, protect painted surfaces with low tac tape.

STEP 4 Place the seat bracket over the backrest tube assembly and align the holes in the seat bracket and the backrest tube assembly.

STEP 5 Insert an included M6 x 1.0 x 25mm screw through the front hole in the seat bracket and backrest tube assembly. Place the flat washer over the protruding end of the fastener.

STEP 6 Carefully position the seat bracket/driver backrest assembly over the front hole and begin to thread the fastener into the hole.

STEP 7 Insert a flat washer between the backrest tube assembly and the fender (as shown in PIC.1); begin to thread in another M6 fastener. Repeat the process for the other side. Leave the fasteners loose for the time being.

STEP 8 Making sure the brass bushings are in place as shown in <u>PIC.2</u>, install the backseat-mounting bracket to the backrest tube assembly using the 3/8-16 x 1.75" bolt and the 3/8-16 locking nut. Place the bracket with the finished chrome facing towards the rear of the motorcycle (see PIC.3) tighten the nut and bolt for resistance.

STEP 9 Place the backrest/bag assembly onto the mounting bracket and secure at the desired height using the M8 x 1.25 x 14mm BHSC screw (shown in PIC.4.)

STEP 10 Place the M8 x 1.25 x 16 mm BHCS screw in the backside of the mounting bracket (seen in PIC.5.) This is used for fine adjustments and angle of the backrest.


STEP 11 Re-install the driver's seat. Carefully adjust the forward/backward position of the assembly and mark the desired location by placing tape on the backrest tube assembly as seen in PIC.6.


STEP 12 Remove the driver's seat and the backrest assembly, then remove the protective tape.

STEP 13 Re-install the backrest assembly (refer to STEP 4 through STEP 7) to the marked location and tighten the fasteners enough to allow for adjustment of the backrest assembly.

STEP 14 Carefully slide the backrest assembly all the way forward and re-install the passenger seat placing the front of it into the tube assembly at an angle as shown in PIC.7. Before securing the passenger seat, move the backrest assembly to the marked location and fully tighten the fasteners. Then re-install the driver's seat.

bracket and the backrest assembly tube.

STEP 15 Backrest pivot tension can be adjusted by loosening and retightening the bolt that is located inside the pad/bag assembly.
