STEP 1

Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition. Let cool.

NOTE: This is a universal kit. It is not made for any specific motorcycle application. A significant amount of wire may be trimmed off of this harness for the neatest installation. The female bullet type connectors (installed) aren't intended to mate with any connectors on any Küryakyn driving light.

WARNING! YOU WILL BE WORKING AROUND THE ENGINE AND EXHAUST SYSTEM DURING INSTALLATION, ENSURE THAT THE ENGINE AND EXHAUST SYSTEM HAVE FULLY COOLED TO PREVENT INJURY.

WIRING CONNECTIONS

FROM PLUG:

- White wire with in line fuse and ring terminal to 12 volt power (battery +)
- Black wires with ring terminal to ground (battery -)
- Group of four wires (encased in plastic wire loom), route to driving lights one white and one black to each light.

ATTENTION! When routing the wiring harness, be sure to keep the wiring away from any moving parts. Küryakyn WILL NOT warranty any electrical component that fails due to pinched, crimped, broken, abraded, or frayed wires.

FROM SWITCH:

• Single red wire to source of switched 12 volt power (on with ignition switch)

NOTE: A "keyed wire" is any wire that gets power when you turn the key on and looses power when you turn the key off. This wire may be determined with a test light or the wiring schematic for your model.

CONNECTION TO DRIVING LIGHTS:

- Each black wire Ground to chassis (bare metal) or light housing
- Each white wire Connect to the single power lead from each silver bullet light

ATTENTION! Küryakyn recommends the use of included dielectric grease on electrical connections.

ATTENTION! When routing the wiring harness, be sure to keep the wiring away from any moving parts. Küryakyn WILL NOT warranty any electrical component that fails due to pinched, crimped, broken, abraded, or frayed wires.

TIPS

- •Solder and insulate all connections.
- •To avoid an excess of wire, lay out your proposed routing first. Trim off any extra wire. This will not only make the wiring easier, but it will make a cleaner job when the installation is complete.
- •Route all wires as neatly as possible keeping in mind all moving parts or "pinch points". Hold wires neatly in place using nylon cable ties.
- •Double sided tape may be used to secure the switch in position.
- •The relay may be mounted to any convenient 1/4" fastener.
