STEP 1 Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition.

STEP 2 Open the Tour-Pak, locate the hardware that secures the back pad to the Tour-Pak lid. PIC 1

STEP 3 Remove the hardware, set aside for reinstallation. Remove the back pad from the Tour-Pak. Place back pad face-down on a flat surface and locate the mounting brackets.

STEP 4 Remove the two outer brackets (PIC 2), replace with the new mounting brackets included in the kit. The new mounting brackets are longer and have an additional hole for securing the bag mounting straps.

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STEP 5 Reinstall back pad to the Tour-Pak lid. Begin with the center fasteners. Place the support plate over the back pad studs, reinstall the nuts removed in STEP 3. An extra support plate is included in the kit.

STEP 6 Reinstall the draw-string support plate. PIC 1 Place support plate over remaining back pad studs and secure with remaining nuts. Ensure that all hardware is securely tightened.

STEP 7 Ensure the back pad is securely fastened to the tour pak. Close and fasten Tour-Pak lid.

NOTE: The Pakmaster Bag includes a protective cloth for use when installing the Pakmaster on a painted or finished surface. It is acceptable, but not necessary, to use the protective cloth when installing Pakmaster on Tour-Paks equipped with a luggage rack. To remove the protective cloth, remove the front hook and loop strap, located by the handle, and slide the rear straps through the slotted holes. The protective cloth is machine washable and stores easily in the Pakmaster when not in use.

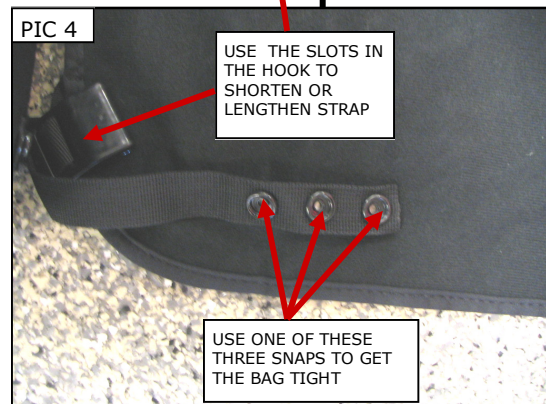
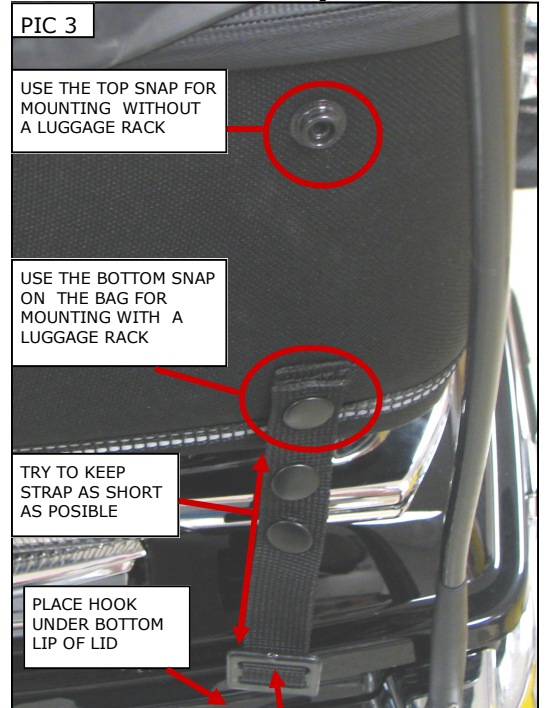
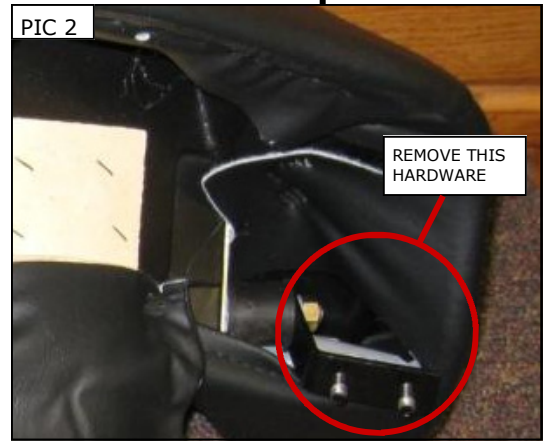
STEP 8 Place the Pakmaster on top of the Tour-Pak or luggage rack. Fasten the rear hooks onto the back edge of the tour Pak, as shown in PIC 3.

STEP 9 Unfasten the hook and loop strap on the front of the bag, thread strap through included front mount hooks as shown in PIC 5 and PIC 6. Fasten the hooks to the hole in mounting brackets installed in STEP 4. Fasten excess strap lengths together using the hook and loop fasteners.

STEP 10 Once all four straps are fastened, evenly tighten each strap until bag is fully secure. PIC 3 and PIC 4

ATTENTION! Secure all straps away from visible painted surfaces, moving parts, pinch points or extreme heat.

ATTENTION! It is the installer's responsibility to ensure that all of the fasteners (including pre-assembled) are tightened before operation of the motorcycle. Küryakyn will not warranty components lost due to improper installation. Periodic maintenance may be required.
