

Mounting Suggestions 2008-&\$%/Harley-Davidson® Road King, Road King Classic, FLHX, FLTR, FLHT Rear Seat

Tools Required:

Phillips Screwdriver

Hardware:

- Stock Rear Fender Screw
- Black Nylon Washer (Included)



Baseplate Features:

Rear seats are built on 16 gauge formed steel baseplates and have two slots in the front of the baseplate and a single chrome rear mounting tab.

Removal of Stock Passenger Seat

- 1. Remove the rear fender screw. This screw will be used later to secure your new Mustang Rear Seat.
- 2. Slide the passenger seat back and up.

Mounting of Mustang Rear Seat

- 1. Front of baseplate is slotted and engages into the slotted nuts (Mustang Part #78032 or H-D Equivalent) at the rear of the solo seat.
- 2. The supplied black nylon washer goes between the rear mounting tab and the fender.
- 3. Secure with stock rear fender screw. The black retention clip that holds the nut insert in the fender must remain in place.
