

CLMS GA 2026 - Call for Posters - Postponed

Pitch Requirements

As in previous years, the CLMS General Assembly will host a poster session and are calling for submissions. The session aims to provide a platform for all CLMS users, including institutions, industry, start-ups, researchers as well as students, to present their innovative ideas, ongoing projects, and recent findings in the field of land monitoring using CLMS and, if relevant, other Copernicus data and products.

Posters offer an interactive format to share work, fostering dialogue, and encouraging collaboration among participants. We particularly welcome submissions on topics such as

- Initiatives building upon and complementing the CLMS products,
- Research activities incorporating CLMS datasets (incl. their validation),
- Value-adding, downstream and business applications involving CLMS and Copernicus datasets,
- Policy (local, regional, national, international) support involving CLMS products,
- Land-related repositories, information systems and networks, contributions addressing other related areas will also be considered.

Authors are encouraged to present conceptual work, case studies, research, or business solutions. Selected posters will be pitched. and displayed throughout the event, and presenters will have designated times to engage directly with the attendees.
