1. Questions About What It Is

Q: What exactly *is* the Rising Reader Rescue Kit?

A: A set of interactive digital and printable activities that teach reading step by step—through games, slides, and practice tasks designed for home or tutoring use.

Q: Is this a subscription or a one-time purchase?

A: It includes a single download or a clickable link for the Boom Cards and Google Slides

Q: How is it different from other reading programs?

A: I offer you customized products to meet the needs of your reader. I also offer my personal experience as a special educator, and I utilize my Orton-Gillingham-inspired, hands-on, and multisensory approach. I also utilize my training in the Science of Reading techniques in the kit. 2. Questions About Who It's For

Q: What age or grade is this best for?

A: Level 1 is for Pre-K–1st grade (emerging readers) and Level 2 is for 1st–2nd grade (ready readers).

Q: My child is behind in reading—will this help them catch up?

A: The Rising Reader Rescue Kit is only effective if the reader puts in the time to practice. With repeated practice, the rising reader will demonstrate progress. Progress speed depends on each reader.

Q: Can I use this even if I'm not a teacher?

A: The Rising Reader Rescue Kit is *parent-friendly*, with clear directions, visuals, and activities that make learning feel like play.



3. Questions About How It Works

Q: How do we use the kit?

A: Parents like step-by-step guidance. Briefly outline:

1. Choose your level.
2. Print or open the digital slides.
3. Follow short daily or weekly activities (10–15 minutes a day).

Q: What materials will I need?

A: Just a pencil, iPad, or keyboard skills—keep it simple!

Q: How long should we use it each day?

A: A flexible schedule—“10–15 minutes a day makes a big difference.”

Q: Does it work on tablets or computers?

A: Yes! Your activities can be used on iPads, laptops, or printed for offline practice. iPads are difficult to use on Google Slides.

A: Depending on the time to put into practice, “Most families notice growing confidence and better letter-sound awareness within a few weeks.”

Q: What skills will my child learn?

A: Concrete skills include:

- Letter and sound recognition

- Blending and segmenting words
- Sight word mastery
- Reading fluency
- Comprehension and vocabulary

Q: Does this prepare my child for school or testing?

A: Yes! It builds the exact foundational skills schools expect by 1st–2nd grade.
