# SWAP #1: FACILITATE

(verb)

## COMMON SWAP:

Help

## IMPRESSIVE UPGRADE:

Facilitate

### Definition:

To make a process easier or smoother. Often used when helping a team or project move forward.

### Use It Professionally:

"I can **facilitate** the next steps so our team moves forward with confidence."

## SWAP #2: RESOLVE

(verb)

### COMMON SWAP:

Fix

### IMPRESSIVE UPGRADE:

Resolve

### Definition:

To settle a problem or bring something to a clear end. Used when closing an issue professionally.
