Rapid Rockstar Instrument Guide

This guide will help you choose the right instrument for your child.

Guitar



Students will need an **acoustic guitar for lessons and home practice.**

The size of the guitar depends on your child's **age and height:**

- 1/4 or 1/2 size → younger students
- 3/4 size → older students

Nylon-string guitars are recommended for beginners as they are easier on the fingers.

You'll need:

- Guitar
- Guitar bag
- Picks

Ukulele



Students will need a **soprano or concert ukulele.**

Ukulele is a great option for younger students and beginners.

You'll need:

- Ukulele
- Soft case



Bass

Students will need a **standard 4-string bass guitar**.

Bass is ideal for students who enjoy rhythm and playing in a group.

You'll need:

- Bass
- Strap
- Small practice amp (for home)

Drums

Drum kits are provided at school. Students only need to bring their own drumsticks.

Stick size:

- 7A → thinner, lighter (recommended for younger students)
- 5A → slightly thicker, more common standard

You'll need:

- Drumsticks
- Practice pad (optional)
