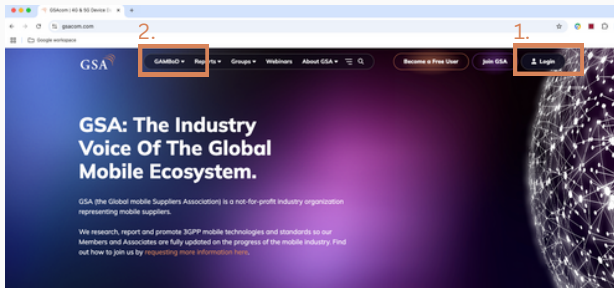

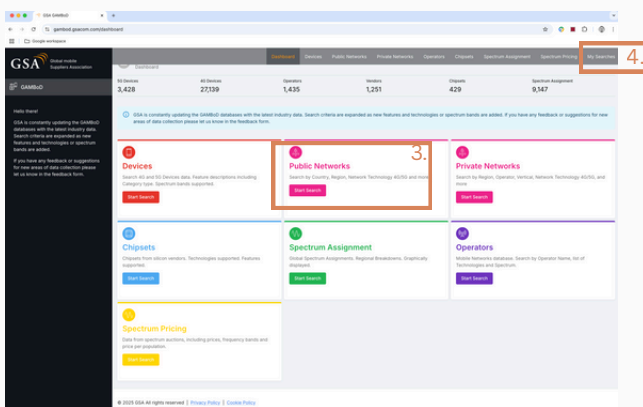

GAMBoD 5G RedCap databases

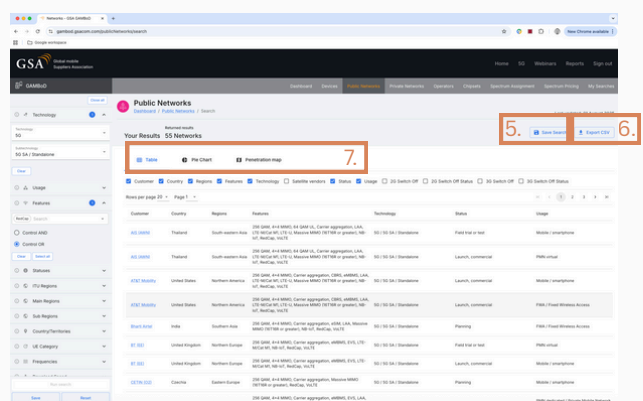


To log into GAMBoD make sure you are first logged in to the GSA website with your business email (1). Then, simply click on the 'GAMBoD' button in the top menu bar to open your dashboard (2).



In your dashboard, you'll see 'Quick start' buttons to launch whichever database you need to use – be it public networks, chipsets or devices (3).

Within each database, you can also save any Searches you make. This means you can easily and quickly see how the global market data is changing direct from your dashboard (4).



Within each database, you see the full dataset and run (and save) your own searches (5).

You can export the results in a table as a .CSV file (6), or download a Pie Chart or Penetration Map of your data as a .PNG file (7).
