# AQUATIC PLANT TIPS

Aquatic plants are generally available March 1st – August 31st . All potted plants come with individual tags. All 4” aquatic plants are shipped 15 per tray; you may mix and match to make up a tray(s) but a minimum of 3 each variety so a total of up to 5 varieties per full tray. One gallon and 8” container plants ship best by truck freight.

Handling of floating water plants:

When receiving floating aquatic plants, particularly water hyacinths and water lettuce, adjust them slowly to direct sun and to air movement or breezes. During shipping, the plants become softened and lush, and even do some growing while in the box. When they are exposed to direct sun or air movement, they may temporarily sunburn and/or windburn. Water lettuce is especially sensitive to burning after shipping, although with care it will thrive in full sun.

Prevent damage to the plants with the following simple procedures. It may not be necessary to use these extra precautions; however, it is the safest way to deal with new floaters.

Upon receipt, keep the floating plants in a cool place until late afternoon. Unload the plants and put them in water. Cover with a shade cloth (or cardboard) for a minimum of 24 hours to rehydrate the plants. If possible, time the removal of the shade cloth for late afternoon or during cloudy or rainy weather.

Once acclimated, floaters benefit from weekly applications of a water soluble fertilizer. If they start turning yellow they are probably nitrogen deficient. For best bloom, give them full sun and just enough nitrogen to keep them green.

## ORDERING:

Orders may be placed by e-mail at sales@dmfgardens.com (preferred), by phone at 515-266-2488, or in person at our office (please have your plant list prepared prior to arrival). Normal business hours are Monday - Friday, 7:30am - 4:00pm. All sales are FOB Des Moines, IA unless otherwise stated. Minimum orders (plant subtotals) and freight charges are as follows:

- Minimum order for delivery (using DMF Gardens equipment and driver) is \$500.00 with the delivery rate of \$3.50 per mile one way (\$1.75 per mile round trip) or \$95.00 per trip, whichever is greater. Each additional stop is \$80.00. Our driver can assist with unloading; however, it is the customer's responsibility to have the necessary equipment and staff available on site to unload the truck/trailer at time of arrival and in a timely manner unless another plan has been mutually agreed upon at the time of delivery booking. Our drivers will call when in route with an ETA. Any time in excess of 1 hour our driver is kept waiting for staff/proper equipment to arrive to the job site or to complete unloading will be an additional charge of \$50.00 per every 30 minutes.
- Minimum order for a pallet shipment (using a 3rd party carrier) is \$500.00 - freight cost will include all shipping & handling fees. Contact the office at time of order placement for a preliminary rate quote if needed.
- Minimum order for parcel shipment (using a 3rd party carrier) is \$165.00 - freight cost will include all shipping & handling fees. Contact the office at time of order placement for a preliminary rate quote if needed.
- Customer pick-up - no minimum order and no charge to pick up, however if you wish to have things pulled to the office and assembled prior to arrival orders must be placed by noon the previous business day. A 15% restocking fee will be assessed if an assembled order is not picked up within 3 days.

## ORDER CONFIRMATIONS:

- An accurate ship date must accompany any order
- A signed copy of the quote/acknowledgement must be received by our office for any order \$10,000.00 or greater before we process your order regardless of item availability if the order is to be picked up more than 24 hours from time of order.
- At DMF Garden's discretion a signed copy of the quote/acknowledgement AND a non-refundable 25% deposit will also be required for any custom grow item(s) or orders containing items above and beyond what we normally keep in stock regardless of total order cost.

- All confirmed orders will be held for up to 30 days beyond the originally requested shipdate. Plant materials listed on any order not picked up within 30 days will be placed back into general inventory (no longer reserved) unless a mutual arrangement is agreed upon.

## **ORDER CANCELLATION**

- Any confirmed order that is cancelled for any reason will incur a restocking fee of 15% if plants are on order with our vendor or already onsite. Custom grow orders cannot be cancelled once planted.

## **PAYMENT:**

All sales are:

- Cash (though we may not be able to make exact change)
- Check (business checks preferred)
- Cashier's check (required in certain cases, a DMF Garden's sales member will advise at time of order confirmation if this method is required)
- Credit card (Visa, Mastercard, Discover or American Express)
- Charge to customers with established credit. Credit limits for charge accounts are adjusted at the end of each year based on a formula comprised of average sales annually over a 3 year period and the average days to pay each invoice within that period. Charges are net 30 days from the invoice date with a finance charge of 1.75% per month (21% per annum), and all collection costs including attorney fees of overdue accounts.

Charges cannot be made to any account that is 30 days or more past due or above the posted credit limit. Payments are first applied to finance charges and then to the oldest balance. Any payments made on account by a credit/debit card will be subject to 3% surcharge fee. Customers will be subject to a \$30.00 return check charge.

## **RETURN POLICY:**

Claims for returns on material shipped/delivered to the customer must be made within 24 hours of receiving the plants and accompanied with an invoice. Returns for items picked up by the customer will not be considered unless agreed to prior to the point of sale with one of DMF Garden's sales staff. Returns will not be accepted if material was planted, untarped while coming back, or material was otherwise returned in poor condition. All returns will incur a 15% restocking fee unless waived at the discretion of DMF Gardens sales staff.

## **CLAIMS FOR CREDIT:**

There is no warranty on any product unless specifically expressed in writing at time of purchase. Shortages and/or concerns regarding plant material must be reported within 24 hours of receiving the plants for consideration. Delays or mishandling of plant material by a freight carrier must be reported on the bill of lading. DMF Gardens is not responsible in any way for claims against us above and beyond the invoiced amount. Plant material accepted while dormant will be customer's risk and not qualify for credit back if not viable.

## **CUSTOM GROWING:**

We can custom grow plant material for you to meet specific market requirements, landscape architect's specifications, etc. Custom orders will require a minimum order for each item needed to be set at the discretion of DMF Gardens. Price quotes are void after 30 days unless otherwise stated.

## **SELECTING PLANTS:**

Customers may come to the nursery/greenhouse and pull their own plants/flag plant material they wish to have as part of their projects.

- Plants may not be removed from site until an order has been generated at the office and customer has a pick ticket/invoice in hand.
- If flagging plants for the future projects, plants must be clearly flagged with customer name, project name, and the date plants were flagged. Also, the main office **MUST** be notified of what has been flagged, for which customer/project, when the ship date is.
- The contractor **MUST** be present if sending clients here to view/select plant stock, homeowners will be turned away if unaccompanied.
- Flagged material will be reserved for up to 30 days beyond originally listed ship date but a 15% holding fee assessed if not taken at time of original ship date. Any flagged material not taken within 30 days of original ship date will be put into general stock, the flag removed, and a 15% cancellation invoice issued (15% holding fee still due as well).

## **VOLUME DISCOUNTS:**

All eligible accounts will be assigned a loyalty volume discount at the beginning of each year based on the previous year's sales volume (a special rate may also be negotiated with your assigned DMF Gardens account manager if you expect a large increase in volume for the coming season). The levels are as follows:

- 3% off of catalog price if last year's sales were \$10,000.00 - \$29,999.99
