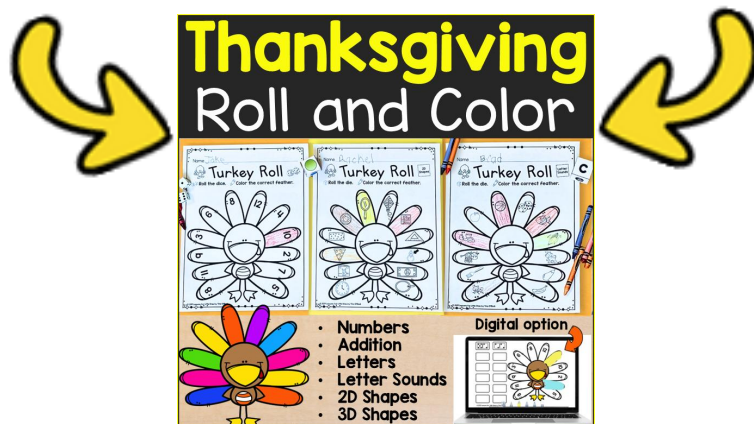

Directions for Use

There are 2 different pages from which to choose - one that uses 2 dice for numbers 2-12 and one that uses 1 die for numbers 1-6.

Students can complete the pages individually or they can play as a game in small groups (students take turns rolling the dice, first one to color all the feathers on their turkey wins).

Print the page that is appropriate for your students.

Give each student a Turkey Roll printable page and either one die or two dice, depending on the page used.

Students roll the dice or die and color the correct feather. If using one die, they count the number of dots. If using 2 dice, they add the dots (numbers) together.

If playing individually and they roll a number that has already been colored, they simply roll again. If playing in a group as a game and they roll a number they have already colored, they pass the dice to the next player (lose a turn).

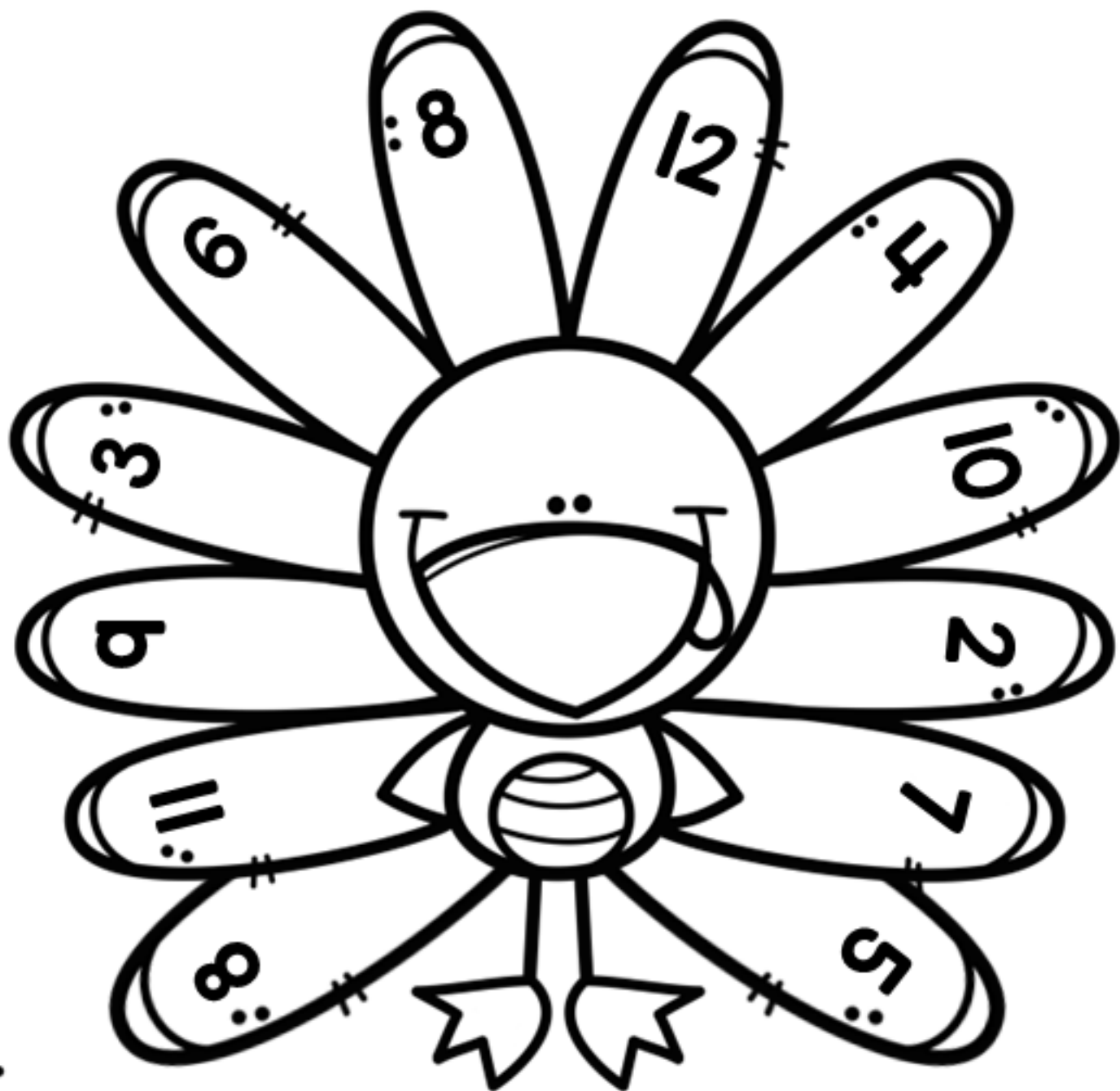

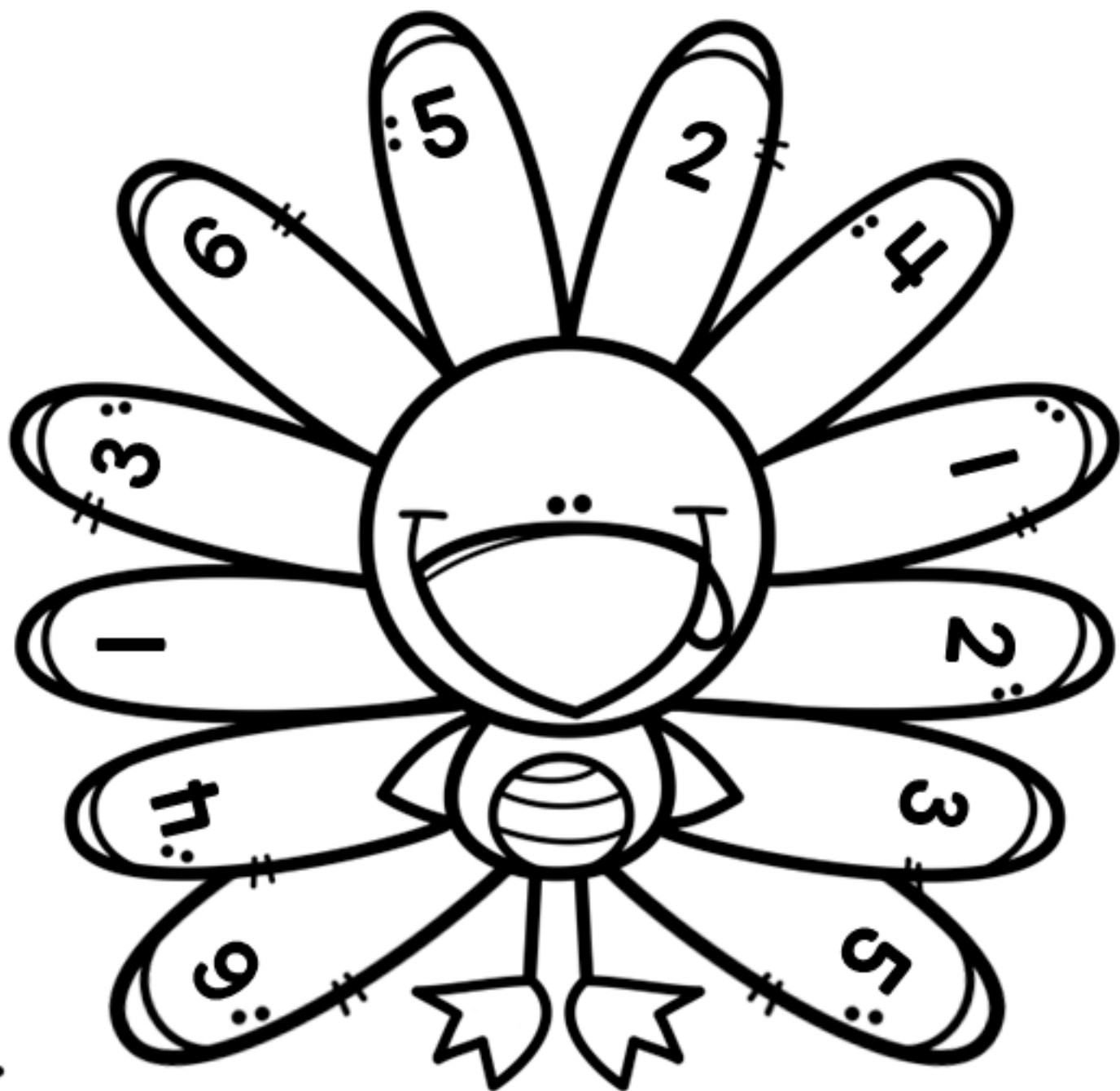
