


The Price Cap Mechanism for Russian Crude Oil


- The G7, in coordination with the EU and Australia, set a price cap of \$60 per barrel for Russian crude oil sold internationally via maritime transport.
- Companies in G7 countries cannot provide services like shipping, insurance, or financing for Russian oil transactions unless the oil is purchased below the price cap.

Exports by route (kbd)






Iranian crude oil export sanctions

- The U.S. imposed sanctions on Iranian oil exports in 2018 under Executive Order 13846 after withdrawing from the Iran nuclear deal (JCPOA).
- Sanctions target entities purchasing Iranian oil or providing related services, aiming to cut Iranian oil exports to zero.




Iranian crude exports

Exports by destination country (kbd)




Exports by origin installation (kbd)




Russian LNG sanctions

- On November 2, 2023, the U.S. sanctioned Russia's Arctic LNG 2
 project operator under Executive Order 14024.
- Sanctions ban **financing**, **shipping**, **insurance**, **or logistics services** linked to Arctic LNG 2 or its affiliates.




Arctic LNG 2 timeline






The first ever AIS spoofing event for LNG shipping - The PIONEER



AIS spoofing Gas flaring Dark loading








Sanctioned vessels and companies through the years





Flag registry distribution of the sanctioned fleet






Defining the shadow fleet

A vessel has loaded sanctioned cargo <u>and</u> at least one of these conditions are met:

- Vessel ownership structure is opaque or unknown
- Vessel is not classified by an IACS classification society
- Vessel is not insured by an IGP&I member
- Vessel age over 20 years old
- Dark activity spotted through satellite imagery during AIS Gaps
- AIS spoofing detected




The rise of the shadow fleet






Distribution of white, grey, and sanctioned commercial fleets

Future Outlook

- US commodity exports likely to be a central point of focus in trade negotiations.
- Trump will shift the geopolitical position of America. This includes less support for Ukraine, entrenched disdain for Iran, continued hard line view towards China.
- Tough Iranian stance could pull 500 600 kbd off the market by middle of next year.
- Increased dark vessel activity and AIS spoofing in new regions if hard line stance on sanctioned countries intensifies.
