



Stick the blue thermal pad on to the back of heatsink.



Stick the heatsink on to the M.2 SSD and make sure the heatsink is aligned to both edges of M.2 SSD. Please make sure the screw hole and connector is not covered.



If your M.2 SSD is used on an adapter, the gray silicone thermal pad can be stuck between M.2 SSD and adapter and help cooling SSD.

Note :

- In step 3, if your M.2 SSD has dual side of flash, please use the thin thermal pad. If your M.2 SSD has only one side of flash, please use the thick thermal pad.
- Because the silicone thermal pad is sticky, if you want to remove anything attached to M.2 SSD, please be careful and slowly to prevent any possible damage.
