CDS Home Screen		In this video, you will learn how to upload and use a personal svg file (maybe something you purchased on Etsy or downloaded on line) in Cricut Design Space. Before we begin, you will want to make sure you know where you saved your file! After logging in or opening CDS, click the dropdown menu icon and choose canvas.	Have cursor highlighted so it is spotlighted throughout video.Zoom in and show the mouse clicking on the drop down icon and then clicking on Canvas. Insert a click sound effect and magnifying glass tool *cursor effects and zoom in on hamburger menu - scale up in animations and then scale down before moving on.		
Canvas Grid		To upload your image, click the upload button located on the options menu.	Zoom in on and show the mouse clicking on the upload button.		
Upload page		Next, click the upload image button			
Drag/Drop Screen		You can choose to drag and drop your file or you can click on the browse button. Let's look at both ways.			
File folder screen will lead to the file showing up on the prepare to upload page		First, click on the file folder icon to select the folder where your file is saved. Here is the file I've saved. Now I'm simply going to drag it to the gray drag and drop area which will lead to the prepare to upload page. But I also want to show how you can access the file by clicking the browse button, so I'm going to click the back button over here to bring me back to the previous screen.
