

Colorado Dog Bite FAQ

Q: What should I do immediately after a dog bite?

A: Seek medical care right away, even if the bite seems minor. Dog bites carry a high risk of infection and need professional cleaning and treatment. Take photos of your injuries, get the dog owner's contact information, and report the bite to Colorado Springs Animal Control.

Q: Why is immediate medical attention important for a dog bite?

A: Dog bites carry a high risk of infection. Professional cleaning and treatment are necessary to prevent complications.

Q: What evidence should I collect after a dog bite?

A: Take photos of your injuries, get the dog owner's contact information, and report the bite to Colorado Springs Animal Control.

Q: Who should I report a dog bite to?

A: You should report the bite to Colorado Springs Animal Control.

Q: What should I do with my medical records after a dog bite?

A: Save all medical records and bills related to your dog bite injury.
