


## Multiplayer

# **Basic Casting**

This casting technique is an easier, alternate method to the Total Cast Control system.




- 1. Basic cast control is enabled in the settings menu under 'Game Settings' by changing the 'Casting Method'.
- 2. In order to enter the casting 'state', click the left trigger while in game at the waters edge and a power bar will then appear.
- 3. Hold down the right trigger to start filling the power bar.
- 4. Release the button to cast however, avoid going into the red zone as accuracy of the cast with be lost.



# Float Fishing

Float fishing is an interactive, fast paced style of fishing which is perfect for catching the smaller species of fish within Euro Fishing.

Float fishing is ideal for targeting our non-carp species as well as smaller carp. For first time float fishing it is recommended trying Match Lake, L'Arene, or The Observatory. It isn't suitable for Digger Lakes which is a carp only venue.



Once in the lake open the Tackle Box and make sure the Waggler Float is equipped. Bait can be changed to something like Bloodworms or Maggots but Bread is a good option too.



Cast the float into the water, once the float is in the water a float symbol will appear. Watch the float here or look at the Waggler in the water and wait for the fish to take the line. Before a fish takes the bait the line must be nice and tight. If the line is slack, try reeling it in a little to tighten it up.

Try not to move the float around too much while waiting for a bite or the fish will be spooked. Watch out for the float to move as this will indicate a bite. To strike, pull the rod back towards the character or in the opposite direction to the fish's movement, similar to how a cast is performed. Timing is key, strike too soon or too late and the fish will escape. A successful strike will mean the fish is on.

The hook quality will be stated after a successful strike. The hook quality is based on the timing and power of the strike - a poorly timed strike and the hook will not be perfectly set. Coupled with a lot of tension on the line, then there is a high probability the fish will escape. A perfect hook quality will mean there is less potential for the fish to escape on high tension, but it is still ideal to aim for lower tension.

## The Observatory

The Observatory is our mixed introduction lake, which is ideal for a new fisherman or an accomplished angler. It offers great opportunities roach, all whilst in beautiful countryside.

### L'Arène



France, 1 Acre, 17 Pegs

Purposely created for competitive fishing, this French match lake is perfect for anglers looking for a quick and diverse fishing experience. This lake doesn't have any boss fish to ensure a fair competitive environment, but it is well stocked with all species so you'll get plenty of bites

This carp-only lake is a maze of channels, islands and bays. This layout creates a unique fishing experience in an intimate setting without disturbances from other species.



### St John's Lake





St. John's Lake is a good place to try beating your personal best by catching famous big fish such as 'The Big Plated' or carp weighing over 20lbs/9kg. There are also some monster catfish, along with bream, tench and roach, to keep anglers of all skills stalking their next fish.

Tench (weigh up to 11lbs/5kg + 1 boss fish)




Roach (weigh up to 3lbs 7oz /1.7kg + 1 boss fish)

## Presa Del Monte Bravo



Spain, 15 Acres, 17 Pegs

High in the mountains of the Sierra de Grazalema is a picturesque lake that will allow you to truly test your angling abilities. Lurking in its depths are some of the rarest, most monstrous fish waiting to be caught, including a 100lbs/45kg catfish called 'Cheetah'. Keeping you company will be the sun and local wildlife.
