The National Curriculum has been strengthened to include new digital technologies learning, with two new technological areas for both English and Māori medium within the revised Technology Learning Area and Hangarau Wāhanga Ako of *The New Zealand Curriculum* and *Te Marautanga o Aotearoa*.

The Digital Technologies & Hangarau Matihiko curriculum content is about learning how digital technologies work, and building capabilities to become creators in the digital world. Schools and kura will be teaching the new curriculum content in 2020.
