For your will to be legally valid, you will need to follow these instructions.

UNDERSTAND



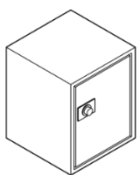
- *Read your will* and make sure you understand everything. If you need help on any words, type “Help” on WhatsApp, and clarify anything you do not understand.
- If you still feel that you do not understand, please make sure you speak to a lawyer.

SIGN



- You will need **two witnesses to sign** the will in your presence, that is, they must be with you when you sign.
- The witnesses must be 14 years and older.
- The witness must be in sound mind, which means that they must not have had anything intoxicating to drink or any other intoxicating substances.
- The **witnesses must NOT be in your will**, that means, anyone that is named in your will is not allowed to be a witness.
- You must use a **BLACK PEN** to sign
- You must initial/**sign your name on each page**, where the blocks are provided.

STORE



- You should keep your will in a safe place.
- You should **let your executor know** that they are your executor and let them know where you have stored your will. The executor is the person that will handle your will when you are deceased.
- If you would like, you can make copies of your will for those people that you would like to share the details with. The Master’s Office will however only accept the original signed will, and not the copies.

KEEP UP TO DATE



- If there are **any big changes** in your life, such as, if you buy or sell a house or car, or you have more children, or if there is a change to any of your relationships that are in the will, then you should **update your will**.
- You can update your will by selecting “Change” in WhatsApp and then generate a new will.
- You will need to re-print and get two witnesses to sign again, to make sure that the new will is valid.

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF TRACY LERATO NGWENYA

1 Declarations

I, Tracy Lerato Ngwenya Identity number 7003044323082 of 23 Dube Flats, Fernhurst Road, Cosmo city being of sound mind and body, do declare that this document is my last will and testament.

In executing this document, I hereby declare that as of the date of this will I revoke and annul all previous Wills, codicils, and other testamentary writings made or passed by me either jointly or severally.

- 1) I have 2 children namely:
 - Lebogang Ngwenya, date of birth 2010-03-17 and
 - Lungile Ngwenya, date of birth 2017-12-15.

All references in this will to my "child" or "Children" are to these named children, as well as any child subsequently born to or adopted by me.

2 Guardians

For all my children under the age of 18 years. I designate the individual(s) below as the named Guardians. If the first choice does not want to accept responsibility, then I nominate the second and third choice:

My first choice is the parent of my child.

My second choice is: Pearl Ngwenya.

My third choice is Roger Twala.

3 Executor

I nominate Siyabonga Ntuli as Executor/Executrix of my last will and testament. If Siyabonga Ntuli is unable or unwilling to serve, then I appoint Alexis Pitso as an alternate Executor/Executrix.

I grant my Executor the following powers:

- 1) The power to exercise all powers of an absolute owner of property;
- 2) The power to retain, sell at public or private sale, exchange, grant options on, invest and reinvest, and otherwise deal with real or personal property;
- 3) The power to divide and distribute property in cash or in kind;
- 4) The power to compromise and release claims with or without consideration;
- 5) The power to pay my legally enforceable debts, funeral expenses, expenses of last illness, and all expenses in connection with the administration of my estate and the trusts created by my Will;

- 6) The power to employ attorneys, accountants and other persons for services or advice;
- 7) Except as otherwise provided herein, the power to make, in my Executor's discretion, any distribution required or permitted to be made to any beneficiary under this Will in any of the following ways when such beneficiary is a minor;
- 8) Any additional powers conferred upon executors wherever my Executor may act.
- 9) I direct that no Executor/Executrix, and no assumed Executor/Executrix, shall be required to furnish security for the due performance of his/her duties, and that the Master of the Supreme Court shall dispense with such security.

4 Distribution of assets

4.1 Real Estate

I leave 2 properties to the persons named below, if I own such property at the time of my death.

I leave all of my interest in my real estate property, located at 12 Baker Road, Diepsloot, at the time of my death (subject to mortgages and loans) to Kamo Ngwenya. If Kamo Ngwenya does not survive me; the gift shall be distributed as the residue of my estate.

I leave all of my interest in my real estate property, located at 23 Dormidero, Fernhurst Road, Cosmo City, Joburg, at the time of my death (subject to mortgages and loans) to my children. If my children does not survive me; the gift shall be distributed as the residue of my estate.

4.2 Vehicles

I leave the following vehicles to the persons named below, if I own such asset at the time of my death.
