

## Chevrolet Camaro 1982-1992/Pontiac Firehird 1982-1992

#### STEP 1

### Camaro 1982-1992, Firebird 1982-1984:

- . Remove (4) torx head screws from the radio trim bezel.
- · Remove (4) hex head screws securing the factory radio dummy plate and remove the plate. (Figure A)

## Firebird 1985-1992:

- Unclip the radio trim bezel and remove the bezel.
- · Remove (4) hex-head screws securing the factory radio dummy plate and remove the plate. (Figure B) Continue to Step 2


### Camaro 1985-1992, Firebird 1985-1992:

. Cut and remove all mounting tabs on the radio housing except tabs "C". (Figure C)


### Camaro 1982-1984, Firebird 1982-1984: Cut and remove all

mounting tabs on the radio housing except tabs "D". (Figure C)





## Chevrolet 5-10 Pickup 1986-1993, Chevrolet 5-10 Blazer/ GMC 5-15 Pickup/Jimmy 1986-1994, Oldsmobile Brayada 1991-1994

- 1. Unclip the dash trim bezel. (Figure A)
- 2. Remove (4) hex head screws securing the factory head unit and disconnect the wiring.
- Cut and remove all mounting tabs on the radio housing EXCEPT tabs "A". (Figure B)
  Continue to kit assembly



## **Saturn** (all models) **1991-1994**

- Unclip power window control panel. Disconnect and remove panel.
- 2. Pull off climate control knobs.
- 3. Unclip and remove the dash trim panel. (Figure A)

## **Saturn** (all models) **1991-1994**

 Remove (4) Phillips head screws securing the radio. Disconnect and remove the radio. Continue to kit assembly




#### **DIN head unit provision**

- **1.** Cut and remove the shaft supports from the radio housing.
- 2. Slide the DIN cage into the kit and secure by bending the metal locking tabs down. (Figure A)
- Slide the aftermarket head unit into the cage until secure. (Figure A)
- Locate the factory wiring harness in the dash. Metra recommends using the proper mating adapter from

- Metra or AXXESS. Re-connect the negative battery terminal and test the unit for proper operation.
- **5.** Screw the rear support bullet onto the bolt on the back of the aftermarket head unit ("A").
- Mount the radio/kit assembly to the sub-dash with those screws previously removed. (Figure B)
- 7. Reassemble dash in reverse order of disassembly.
