- Weather at Kickoff: 72 degrees, partly cloudy. Wind from the E at 14 mph. 61 percent humidity.

TEAM NOTES

- Denzel Perryman's interception return for a touchdown was the first for the Hurricanes since Kelvin Cain returned one 59 yards against Bethune-Cookman on Oct. 1, 2011.
- With his second-quarter TD run, Duke Johnson's became the first Miami true freshman to start and score in a season-opener since Jacory Harris raced 30-yards against Charleston Southern on Aug. 28, 2008.
- Miami is now 57-29-1 all-time in season openers and has won four of the last five. The Canes improved to 16-12 in road openers.
- UM is now 3-3 when starting the season against an ACC opponent.
- Miami now holds a 24-5 advantage in the series against Boston College and a leads 8-3 in Chestnut Hill.
- This was only the second time the teams met in the season opener (1993).
- It was UM's first win at Boston College since 2001.

- RB Eduardo Clements was the first Cane to score in 2012 on a first-quarter 1-yard plunge. It was the second career touchdown for the junior.
- LB Denzel Perryman (2011 Freshman All-American) returned an interception 41 yards for a touchdown to end the first quarter. The interception and touchdown were career firsts for the sophomore.
- RB Duke Johnson scored his first career touchdown on a 54-yard scamper in the second quarter and added a 56-yard score in the third quarter. He totaled 135 yards for the game, the most by a UM true freshman since Javarris James racked up 148 yards against Houston (Sept. 30, 2006).
- WR Allen Hurns recorded a career-high 81 yards in the game.
- WR Malcolm Lewis notched a receiving touchdown in his debut, as three of the Canes' four offensive touchdowns were scored by true freshmen.
- PK Jake Wieclaw connected on both field goal attempts and made all five PAT tries.
- QB Stephen Morris set new career highs with 28 completions and 45 pass attempts in the game. He started the opener for the second time in as many years.
