MISCELLANEOUS AND SERIES NOTES

- Miami leads the all-time series 9-2-1. Saturday was the first series meeting since Louisville's 31-7 win in 2006. It was also the first neutral-site meeting in series history.
- Miami is now 1-2 vs. ranked teams in 2013 and 3-6 vs. ranked teams in the AI Golden Era.

BOWL NOTES

- Miami is now 19-18 in bowl games. The Hurricanes have lost their last four bowl appearances, last winning the 2006 MPC Computers Bowl (21-20, vs. Nevada).
- Miami is now 11-6 in bowl games played in Florida.
- Tonight's game was the fourth time the Canes played in the Russell Athletic Bowl. With the loss, Miami drops to 2-2 in the Russell Athletic Bowl.
- Miami was held to less than 10 points in a bowl game for the first time since the 2005 Peach Bowl (40-3 loss vs. LSU).

TEAM NOTES

- Sophomore defensive back Deon Bush recorded the team's first safety of the season with a first quarter takedown of Louisville quarterback Teddy Bridgewater. It was the team's first safety since a Nov. 10, 2012 matchup with Virginia.
- Miami did not score a touchdown or a field goal in the first half for the first time since Nov. 27, 2010, a 23-20 loss to South Florida.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Stephen Morris, who finished the game with 160 passing yards, surpassed 3,000 passing yards on the season.
- Allen Hurns broke Miami's single-season receiving yards record with a 13-yard reception in the fourth quarter. Hurns, who finished the season with 1,163 receiving yards, surpassed Leonard Hankerson's 1,156-yard season 2010.
- Clive Walford, who led Miami with four catches for 82 yards, surpassed 1,000 receiving yards for his career.
- Gus Edwards scored his fifth rushing touchdown of the season when he scored from two yards out in the fourth quarter. The touchdown was Miami's first in a bowl game since 2010 (Tommy Streeter, 42-yard TD reception from Stephen Morris vs. Notre Dame).
- Deon Bush recorded his second career sack when he took down Louisville quarterback Teddy Bridgewater with 11:51 remaining in the first quarter. The sophomore also recorded his first career safety when he brogught down Bridgewater in the end zone.
- Al-Quadin Muhammad tied a career-high with two tackles. The freshman defensive end also recorded two tackles against Savanah State (Sept. 21, 2013).
- Ladarius Gunter tied a career-high with three pass breakups (at Virginia, Nov. 10, 2012)
