MISCELLANEOUS AND SERIES NOTES

- Miami is 16-3 all-time in ESPN Thursday Night games. Tonight's game marks the 75th appearance on ESPN - tied for the most of any college football program.
- UNC leads all-time series 9-8.
- Miami is 2-4 all-time at UNC. The Hurricanes won 30-24 at UNC in 2011.

TEAM NOTES

- Miami is 6-0 for the first time since 2004
- Second time all season Miami hasn't had the lead going into halftime (tied at 17 vs. Georgia Tech).
- Miami is one of 14 unbeaten teams left in major college football.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Tracy Howard picked off his second and third interceptions of the season. First game with multiple INTs
- Matt Goudis's 22-yard field goal gives the sophomore two consecutive games with a field goal made. Finished with two field goals vs. UNC (22,20)
- Stephen Morris connects with Phillip Dorsett for 68 yards. The catch was a career-long for Dorsett.
- Artie Burns blocked Thomas Moore's 47-yard field goal attempt and Ladarius Gunter returned it 67 yards for a touchdown. First time an opponent blocked a FG for a TD against UNC since 2004.
- The blocked FG for a touchdown was Miami's first since 2004 (Devin Hester vs. Florida)
- Second straight game Ladarius Gunter scores a touchdown (INT for a TD vs. Georgia Tech)
- Duke Johnson's 87 rushing yards move him into 19th place on Miami's all-time rushing list (1,605 yards), passing Tom Sullivan (1,541), Frank Smith (1,576).
- Anthony Chickillo third sack of the season.
- Stephen Morris became Miami's 7th QB to tally 6,000 passing yards in their career and moved into 4th place on Miami's career passing yards list, passing Vinny Testaverde (6,058), Craig Erickson (6,056), Ryan Clement (6,004) and Bernie Kosar (5,971).
- Dallas Crawford set a career-high with 137 rushing yards (previous high was 48 vs Savannah State).
- Dallas Crawford career-first 100-rushing yard game.
- Dallas Crawford has rushed for a TD in four consecutive games and five of Miami's six games this season.
- Stephen Morris with sixth career 300-yard passing game.
- 22 of Clive Walford's last 24 touches have been first downs or touchdowns.
- Denzel Perryman with seven tackles in the first half, 12 for the game.
