MISCELLANEOUS AND SERIES NOTES

- Heading into the game, Miami was 6-0 for the first time since 2004.
- Miami leads series 8-3.
- Has won seven consecutive games against Wake Forest.
- Miami is 5-0 against Wake Forest in the ACC era.

TEAM NOTES

- Miami is 7-0 for the first time since 2003.
- Miami is one of 10 unbeaten teams left in major college football.
- Of all seven kickoffs this year to open a half, the opponent has not reached farther than the 25-yard line.
- First time in 2013 that Miami did not score in the first quarter.
- Only the second game all season the Hurricanes have trailed at halftime.
- Canes take their first lead of the game with 5:36 remaining in the game.
- Seven different Hurricanes had receptions today.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Asante Cleveland with his first two receptions of the 2013 season.
- Jimmy Gaines had four tackles on the opening drive.
- Matt Goudis 34-yard field goal put the Canes on the board with 9:28 to play in the second quarter.
- Duke Johnson is one of just 19 running backs in program history to surpass the 1,600-yard mark, he had 168 yards today on 30 carries, a career-high, surpassing his previous high of 22 against Georgia Tech earlier this season.
- Duke Johnson passed Chuck Foreman, Don Bosseler and Warren Williams (was 16th with 1,734 yards) on the all-time rushing list with 1,744 career yards to move to 16th all-time.
- Duke Johnson with 168 yards rushing, topping 100 yards for the third time this season and seventh time in his career.
- Duke Johnson surpassed the 200 all-purpose yard mark for the ninth time in his career. Miami is 8-1 when he does.
- Tyrone Cornileus with the first sack of his career.
- Artie Burns with a career-high five tackles, all solo.
- Stacy Coley with his third career game with 100 all-purpose yards.
- Shayon Green has five tackles, one sack, 1.5 tackles for loss and a pass breakup.
- Antonio Crawford with his first-career INT.
