MISCELLANEOUS AND SERIES NOTES

- Miami takes a 6-5 lead in the series
- Miami snaps three-game losing streak to Miami.
- In Miami, the Canes take a 3-2 series lead.

TEAM NOTES

- First time Miami's first score has been a defensive TD since Oct. 28, 2006 when Glenn Cook had a 19-yard fumble recovery for a TD against Georgia Tech.
- Miami is 5-0 this season when leading at halftime and 16-1 in the AI Golden era.
- For the 10th time in the last 13 games, Miami has scored first.
- Miami now has 17 interceptions for the season, the most since 2003.
- This year's senior class finished their careers with a record of 17-9 at Sun Life Stadium.
- Second time this season Miami has 3+ interceptions in a game.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Tracy Howard with the fourth INT of his career on first play of the game. Scored his career-first TD on the play.
- Stephen Morris' 9th pass of 50+ yards this season - 7 of which have gone for touchdowns.
- Stephen Morris has a touchdown of 50+ yards in three straight game.
- Allen Hurns is now in 10th place on the Miami all-time reception list with 110 career receptions.
- 33-yard field goal Matt Goudis
- Stacy Coley joins Duke Johnson as the only freshman to score 7 or more touchdowns since 1999.
- Ladarius Gunter snagged his third interception of the season and fourth of his career.
- Dallas Crawford scored his 13th touchdown of the season - only the 2nd Miami running back to do so since 2002 (the other is Duke Johnson).
- Allen Hurns' fifth 100+ receiving game this season
- Allen Hurns at 965 receiving yards this season.
- Season long 71-yard punt by Pat O'Donnell
- Career-first interception for Kacy Rodgers II
- Second fumble recovery of the year by David Gilbert - this time, returned it 72 yards for a TD
 - Second-career touchdown - first at Miami.
