- Today's Captains: RB Mike James, QB Stephen Morris, CB Brandon McGee and DE Shayon Green
- Weather at Kickoff: 84 degrees, cloudy. Wind from the ENE at 19 mph.
- Head coach Al Golden is now 37-43 overall (7th season), 10-9 at UM (2nd season) and 1-1 vs. UNC.

TEAM NOTES

- Against UNC, both Robert Lockhart Jr. and Ricardo Williams earned their first appearance on the field this season. Through seven games, 21 freshmen have seen action for the Miami Hurricanes, including 16 true freshmen.
- The Canes led the Tar Heels in time of possession, 30:18-29:42. This is the first game since the 2011 season finale against BC that Miami has led in time of possession.
- Miami has trailed at some point in each of its first seven games.
- Miami's offensive line allowed six sacks in the first two games. The men in the trenches have given up only two sacks in last five games.

- Mike James rushed 22 times for a total of 96 yards vs. UNC, both career-bests. James' previous high was 89 yards on 15 carries at Georgia Tech in 2012.
- Denzel Perryman notched double-digit tackles for the first time this season with 11 total, nine of which were solo, tying his career-best vs. BC a season ago. He also had 3.0 tackles for 10 lost yards.
- In the fourth quarter, Ryan Williams entered the game for Stephen Morris. Williams completed 9-of-13 passes for 80 yards, including a 21-yard pass to Rashawn Scott. Prior to the game, Williams had played in three games this season, completing both of his pass attempts for seven yards and one touchdown.
- Ladarius Gunter collected eight tackles against the Tar Heels, a career high. His previous best was four vs. NC State on Sept. 29.
- Mike James scored Miami's first touchdown of the game, a 1-yard rush in the second quarter. The TD was James' 18th career TD, and 15th rushing. It was his fifth TD of the season.
- In the first quarter, LB Eddie Johnson recorded his career-first INT, then collected 24 yards on the return.
- Stephen Morris collected 34 rushing yards in the first half, surpassing his previous career-high of 23 total rushing yards, at Virginia in 2010. Morris scored the Canes' second TD with a 5-yard rush in the third quarter, his first rushing TD of the season and third of his career (one each year). Morris ended the game with 40 rushing yards.
- 17 of Rashawn Scott's 27 catches this season have been for more than 10 yards. Scott is averaging 16.0 yards per catch this season.
- With two tackles for five lost yards, Eddie Johnson now has 5.5 tackles for 17 lost yards this season.
- Gionni Paul recorded a pair of pass breakups after entering the game with zero in his career. He is the first UM player to record a pair of PBU in an ACC game since Micanor Regis did at Florida State in 2011.
- In the third quarter, Maurice Hagens gained three yards on his first carry of the season. Prior to UNC, Hagens had 21 yards from seven rushes.
- Jake Wieclaw connected on two extra points against UNC to continue his perfect mark of 62-of-62 for his career.
- Senior RB Mike James and freshman RB Duke Johnson have combined for 830 of Miami's 985 rushing yards on 162 carries through seven games. Johnson has amassed 428 yards and five rushing TDs on 74 carries, while James has 402 yards and four touchdowns on 88 carries. Johnson (7) and James (5) have combined for 12 of Miami's 24 total touchdowns this season.
