MISCELLANEOUS AND SERIES NOTES

- Miami leads series 29-26.
- 55th game between the two teams
- Miami has won four of their last five games against opponents from Florida.

TEAM NOTES

- Largest home crowd for a Canes game at Sun Life Stadium (76,869) in history. Next largest was 75,115 on Oct. 10, 2010 against Florida State.
- First win over top 10 team since 2010, when the Canes beat No. 8 Oklahoma.
- First Canes punt blocked since 2009.
- In 2008, in second game of season, Matt Boshier punt was blocked against Florida.
- The #Canes forced three turnovers while the #Gators offense was in the red zone. #UFvsMIA
- Hurricanes allow first touchdown in 171:56 minutes.
- All scoring drives this year have been 2:49 or less.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Before Stephen Morris did it today, the last QB to throw two first-quarter TD passes vs. Florida was JaMarcus Russell in 2005.
- Stephen Morris becomes 11th all-time leading passer in UM history with 5,190 yards - surpassed Brock Berlin.
- Rayshawn Jenkins with the 2nd INT of his career.
- 60 yard punt from Pat O'Donnell, his longest of season.
- First career fumble recovery for Thurston Armbrister.
- First career fumble recovery for Curtis Porter.
- Fourth career forced fumble and first of season for Denzel Perryman.
- Tyrone Cornelius had fifth pass break-up of career, second of season.
- Denzel Perryman was one tackle shy of matching a career high of 14, which he set freshman year (2010) against Boston College.
- Duke Johnson has 100 or more all-purpose yards in five of his last six games.
- Stephen Morris has a passing touchdown in each of his last seven games for a total of 15 over that stretch.
- Tracy Howard with first INT of career.

Team Notes

- ♦ Miami now leads all-time series, 29-26, with the series tied in Miami, 14-14.
- ♦ Gator junior Loucheiz Purifoy blocked a punt in the first quarter deep in Miami territory, the 13th blocked kick in head coach Will Muschamp's 28 games at Florida.
- ♦ Miami converted a Gator fumble into a touchdown reception on its opening drive and scored another touchdown on the ground in the fourth quarter following a Florida fumble.
- ♦ Gators' turnover margin: -4 (three fumbles, two interceptions for Florida; one interception for Miami)
- ♦ Florida was 2-for-6 in the red zone: touchdown, interception, turnover on downs, fumble, field goal, interception.
- ♦ The Gators limited Miami to 2 yards of offense in the second quarter on 7 plays.
- ♦ UF's defense forced 2 straight 3-and-outs to begin the second half and had a stretch of 4 in a row in the game (not including a kneel-down at the end of the first half by Miami).
- ♦ The Gators controlled the time of possession: 38:20-21:40.
- ♦ Florida totaled 413 yards of offense and yielded 212 yards to Miami.
- ♦ The Gators had 22 first downs, compared to 10 for the Hurricanes.
- ♦ UF gave up just 50 yards rushing on 28 carries (1.8 yard avg.) and had 122 yards on 44 carries. After 186 yards rushing last week, UM's Duke Johnson was limited to 59 yards on 21 carries (2.8 avg.)
- ♦ The Gator defense forced Miami into going 1-for-11 on third downs.

Individual Notes

- ♦ Junior QB Jeff Driskel was 22-of-33 for a career-high 291 yards, with two interceptions, one scoring toss and a fumble. He also scored the Gators' first touchdown.
- ♦ Senior WR Solomon Patton had career highs in receptions (6) and receiving yards (118) and scored his first career receiving TD with a 21-yard grab from Driskel in the fourth quarter. He entered the season with eight career catches for 79 yards.
- ♦ Patton became the first Gator receiver to surpass 100 yards receiving in a game since Andre Debose had 3 catches for 151 yards against Furman on Nov. 19, 2011.
- ♦ Freshman DB Vernon Hargreaves III switched from the No. 16 that he wore in the season opener against Toledo to No. 1 this week. Hargreaves is the first true freshman Gator to wear No. 1 since Keiwan Ratliff in 2000.
- ♦ Hargreaves collected his second interception of the season in the fourth quarter.
- ♦ Sophomore RB Matt Jones gained a first down with a 9-yard carry on the Gators' opening drive, his first carry of the season.
- ♦ Jones finished the game with 18 rushes for a team-high 47 yards (2.6 avg.).
- ♦ Redshirt junior WR Quinton Dunbar has now caught a pass in 18 straight games, he had a season-high 22-yard grab on the first drive.
- ♦ Dunbar registered career highs in receptions (7) and receiving yards (98), with a long catch of 32 yards.
- ♦ Senior WR Trey Burton established a personal-best with 6 receptions and had 64 yards receiving (10.7 avg.).
- ♦ Junior DB Loucheiz Purifoy now has blocked 3 kicks in his Gator career: field goal vs. Missouri and a punt vs. Louisiana last season and a punt this afternoon.
- ♦ Driskel scored on a 9-yard run in the first quarter, his first rushing TD of the season and the fifth of his career.
- ♦ Patton hauled in a 46-yard reception from Driskel late in the first quarter, the longest catch of his career.
- ♦ Junior DL Darius Cummings saw his first action as a Gator in the second quarter.
- ♦ Redshirt freshman K Austin Hardin narrowed the gap to 14-9 in the third with a 33-yard field goal, the longest of his career.
- ♦ Junior Kyle Christy had 4 punts for 170 yards (42.5 avg.), with 2 inside of the 20 and a long of 45 yards.
