TEAM NOTES

- Miami is the first team during the 2012 season to score first quarter points on the Notre Dame defense. The Canes became the first team since Stanford in 2011 to score in the first quarter after Jake Wieclaw hit a 28-yard FG on UM's second drive of the game.
- The Hurricanes fell to 7-17-1 in the all-time series against Notre Dame.
- Miami is now 2-0 at home, 2-1 on the road and 0-1 in neutral site games this season.
