MISCELLANEOUS AND SERIES NOTES

- Miami leads the series 9-2
- Miami is now 5-1 in Durham.
- Saturday was the fourth series meeting with Miami ranked in the AP Top 25.

TEAM NOTES

- Miami has 21 takeaways in 2013 (had 22 in 2012).
- Miami is 3-13 in the AI Golden era and 2-3 this season when trailing at the half.
- Prior to Saturday, Miami was flagged for a combined four penalties in its previous two games (both losses). Miami was flagged for seven penalties at Duke.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Senior QB Stephen Morris became the fourth QB in Miami history to eclipse the 7,000-yard career passing mark. Morris now has 7,226 yards. Morris joins **Ken Dorsey** (9,565), **Jacory Harris** (8,826) and **Gino Torretta** (7,690).
- Morris now has eight career 300-yard games. He has posted four 300-yard passing games in each of the last two seasons.
- Senior WR **Allen Hurns** surpassed 100 receptions for his career (104). He needs two more to tie **Glenn Denison** (106) for 10th on Miami's career list.
- Sophomore WR **Herb Waters** recorded a career-high 9 receptions and 116 receiving yards.
- Waters posted his second career 100-yard receiving game.
- Sophomore RB **Dallas Crawford** his second career 100-yard rushing game, finishing with 115 yards on 19 carries. Both of Crawford's 100-yard rushing games have come in the Tar Heel State (137 at UNC on Oct. 17).
- Freshman **Stacy Coley** became the first Miami Hurricane since Devin Hester in 2004 to return a punt and a kick for a TD in the same season. Coley had an 88-yard kick return for a TD earlier this season vs. Savannah State.
- Senior FB **Maurice Hagens** with career-long 33-yard reception in the second quarter.
- First time this season with multiple 100-yard receivers in the same game. Happened three times last year: Georgia Tech, NC State, USF.
