MISCELLANEOUS AND SERIES NOTES

- Miami leads series 23-9-1
- Miami is 13-5 at Pittsburgh
- Series win streak: eight
- First meeting since 2010
- First meeting as conference opponents since 2003

TEAM NOTES

- Miami scored 17 points in the first quarter, marking the fourth time this season the Hurricanes have scored 17 or more points in the game's opening period.
- Miami scored 31 points in the first half, marking the best first-half offensive output of the season in a conference matchup.
- Miami P Pat O'Donnell forced a fumble on the game's opening kickoff, marking Miami's 26th takeaway of the season.
- Miami scored 41 points in the win, marking the seventh game this season the Hurricanes have totaled 30+ points.
- The Hurricanes' 18-play, 6:36-long drive marked the longest in each category this season.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- With his first touchdown of the first quarter, freshman WR Stacy Coley extended his personal scoring streak to three straight games with a touchdown.
- Freshman WR Stacy Coley recorded two first-quarter receiving touchdowns against Pitt, which marked the third multi-receiving touchdown game for a Hurricane in 2013. Senior WR Allen Hurns recorded two touchdowns against Florida State (Nov. 2), and sophomore WR Herb Waters scored two against Duke (Nov. 16).
- With a 73-yard rushing touchdown in the second quarter, freshman WR Stacy Coley became the only FBS player in 2013 to have recorded a touchdown via reception, punt return, kickoff return and rush through Week 14 of the regular season.
- Freshman WR Stacy Coley's rushing score marked his 10th touchdown of the season, which put him in elite company - he is only the third Miami freshman in the past 20 years to have recorded 10 or more touchdowns, joining Clinton Portis (1999) and Duke Johnson (2012).
- Graduate P Pat O'Donnell recorded his career-first forced fumble on the game's opening kickoff. The fumble was recovered by senior WR Garrett Kidd for his career-first recovery.
- With an 18-yard reception in the first quarter, senior WR Allen Hurns became just the fourth Hurricane to ever record a 1,000-yard receiving season - joining Eddie Brown (1984), Andre Johnson (2002) and Leonard Hankerson (2010). He ended the game with a career-high 173 yards.
- Senior WR Allen Hurns recorded his sixth overall 100-yard receiving game of the season and fourth consecutive against Pitt with a game-high 173 yards. He now has 1,130 receiving yards this season and 1,694 for his career. Hurns now has 70 receptions this season, two shy of the single-season receptions record set by Leonard Hankerson in 2010. Hurns career receptions total is now up to 119, passing Wesley Carroll who was in 9th all-time.
- Senior QB Stephen Morris moved into third place in career passing yards with a 296-yard game against Pitt, passing Gino Torretta (7,690) to move into the top three with 7,736 career yards.
- Senior TE Asante Cleveland scored career-first TD reception in final regular-season game of career.
