MISCELLANEOUS AND SERIES NOTES

- Series now moves to 5-1 in favor of Miami.
- Miami won the final three games of the series.
- 49 points by Miami is most points scored in a game by either team in this series.

TEAM NOTES

- One of eight teams in the nation to have not trailed at any point in the 2013 season
- Miami's 6-game win streak is longest since winning 8 straight in 2005. Canes haven't trailed for last 357 minutes, dating back to UVA, 2012
- Miami is 4-0 for first time since 2004
- Canes 7-14 on third down.
- Canes with four fumbles for first time since October 15, 2005 at Temple.
- Outscoring opponents 118-16 in first halves - including first half today.
- USF's 7 points in 1Q more than UM allowed in first quarter of first 3 games combined (6)
- Through 4 games, Miami has surpassed last season's sack total of 13. 14 already this year.
- Four sacks for Miami today
- First defensive touchdown since Denzel Perryman 41-yard INT TD return at Boston College in 2012.
- First defensive points since safety against Virginia in 2012.
- First time since in Al Golden's tenure that Canes have a defensive touchdown, rushing touchdown, passing touchdown in first half. Last time it happened was in 2002.
- Held USF to 2-of-13 on third downs.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Stephen Morris moves to 8th on all-time passing list. Passed Steve Walsh on the 55-yard pass to Dorsett.
- 18 of Walford's last 19 touches have been first downs or touchdowns.
- Duke Johnson has 100 or more all-purpose yards in seven of his last eight games.
- Stephen Morris has a passing touchdown in each of his last nine games.
- Duke Johnson has scored a touchdown in eight straight games dating back to last year's 30-12 win over Virginia Tech.
- Thurston Armbrister with second career sack.
- Tyriq McCord with his second INT in last two games.
- Maurice Hagens first catch of season goes for 17 yards.
- Duke Johnson's second career fumble in 187 career touches – both on opponent's 1-yard-line
- 47 yard punt for Pat O'Donnell - first punt since week 2 against Florida.
- Dallas Crawford has 5 TDs in last 2 games.
- Career-high receiving night for Stacy Coley - 96 yards
- Shayon Green gets first sack of career.
