- Today's Captains: Mike James, Stephen Morris, Brandon McGee, Shayon Green
- Weather at Kickoff: 79 degrees and clear. Wind: ENE 9mph
- Head coach Al Golden is now 37-44 overall (7th season), 10-10 at UM (2nd season) and 0-2 vs. FSU.
- The Canes are celebrating their 78th Homecoming game and their second of a three-game homestand.
- At halftime the 1987 National Championship team was honored.

TEAM NOTES

- In the first quarter, the Canes scored their first touchdown in 1:47 following a fumble by the Seminoles. 13 of Miami's 30 scoring drives this season have needed less than two minutes, including five that have needed less than 60 seconds.
- Miami scored first in the game against FSU, only the second game this season the Canes put points on the board first. The other game was at Georgia Tech.
- The Canes led by as many as 10 points in the first half, the first time Miami has led a ranked team this season.
- Miami has trailed at some point in each of its first eight games.
- With six pass break ups vs. FSU, the Canes defense has had multiple PBU in all four home games this season, notching five in three of those four outings.

- Denzel Perryman forced and Jimmy Gaines recovered a fumble that set up Miami's first score. The FF was Perryman's first of the season and third of his career and the FR was Gaines' first of his career.
- Mike James rushed nine yards for Miami's first touchdown of the game. The TD was James' fifth rushing and sixth overall this season.
- Jake Wieclaw connected on one extra point against FSU to continue his perfect mark of 63-of-63 for his career. He put the Canes ahead, 10-0, with a 19-yard field goal, then hit a 27-yard attempt in the third to pull the score within three, 16-13. This is the first home game of his career with multiple made field goals.
- With 4:27 remaining in the first, Tyriq McCord recovered a fumble, the first of his career.
- With less than a minute left in the game, Rashawn Scott caught his third TD pass, an 8-yard reception from Stephen Morris. It was Morris' 10th passing TD of the season and 17th of his career.
- Morris totaled 223 yards through the air against Florida State. He has at least 155 passing yards in each game this season and now has 2,214 yards through the air this season.
- In the third quarter, QB Stephen Morris picked up six yards on his first-career reception, a pass from Phillip Dorsett, his second career toss.
- Brandon McGee recorded his first sack of the season and second of his career.
- Mike James reeled in eight catches for 75 yards, both career highs. His previous bests were four catches vs. UNC last week and 53 yards vs. NC State in 2012.
- Denzel Perryman collected 12 tackles, nine of which were solo, which ties a career-best. He has now had nine solos three times, with the last vs. UNC in 2012.
- Shayon Green registered eight tackles, tying his career high, which he has done twice. The last time was vs. Bethune-Cookman in 2012.
- Gabriel Terry notched his first tackle of his career, a solo takedown.
- Senior RB Mike James and freshman RB Duke Johnson have combined for 882 of Miami's 1014 rushing yards on 178 carries through eight games.
