SETTING THE SCENE

- Sunday's meeting is the eighth all-time between the two teams with Miami holding a 7-0 advantage and the first since 2023.
- The Hurricanes are 6-0 when playing in Coral Gables, most recently a 95-55 victory on Dec. 29, 2023.
- The series began in 2007 with each game played in Coral Gables except for the 2016 matchup that the Hurricanes won 94-56 in Jacksonville.

RENEAU-ING HIS GAME

- Malik Reneau has been a force for the Miami offense and has scored 20-or-more points in nine games this season, which is tied for the third nationally.
- Reneau who was named to the Karl Malone Award Watch List, presented annually to the nation's best power forward in Division I men's basketball, has recorded four games with at least 20 points and 10 rebounds, which is tied for third in the country.

- The Miami native opened the season with a 20-point performance against Jacksonville and was 10-of-12 from the charity stripe and followed the game up with 22-point performance against Bethune-Cookman.
- Against Stetson, Reneau recorded his first double-double of the season with 22 points and 10 rebounds before registering 22 points and 11 rebounds versus No. 10/10 Florida.
- Against Delaware State, Reneau registered his third double-double of the season with 24 points and 10 rebounds and was a perfect 10-for-10 from the floor.
- Reneau added 23 points on 8-of-14 shooting and was 3-of-3 from beyond the arc in the win over Georgetown. Nineteen of his 23 points came in the first half where he nearly outscored the Hoyas by himself.
- In the win over ULM, Reneau tallied 22 points on 10-of-15 shooting and hauled in 10 rebounds for his fourth double-double on the year.
- Reneau joined the Hurricanes after spending the last three seasons at Indiana where he earned to All-Big Ten honorable mention recognitions in 2024 and 2025.

UDEH JR. RETURNS HOME

- Ernest Udeh Jr., who was one of 20 players named to the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame's Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Award Watch List, presented annually to the nation's best center, has been a terror on the glass for the Hurricanes, leading the team with 9.4 per game.
- Per KenPom, Udeh Jr. owns the highest jump ball ranking in the country and is 58-15 in his career including a 8-2 record this season.
- Udeh cleaned up the glass and registered his second double-double of the season as he tallied 14 points and hauled in a season-high 15 rebounds.
- The senior made his presence known in his first game in a Miami uniform as he recorded a double-double against Jacksonville with 14 points and 14 rebounds.
- A transfer from TCU, Udeh earned All-Big 12 honorable mention last season and was also named to the NABC Second Team All-Gulf District after averaging 6.6 points and 7.5 rebounds per game.
- A force in the paint, Udeh Jr. averaged 1.3 blocks and was third in the Big 12 with 3.1 offensive rebounds per game.

DIME DONALDSON

- Tre Donaldson returned to his home state for his final collegiate season after transferring to Miami from Michigan.
- Donaldson has made an immediate impact and ranks second on the team in scoring at 14.8 points per game, has scored in double figures every game.
- The Tallahassee native came to Miami to develop as a passer and leads the Hurricanes with 82 assists and has had four games in which he has had at least 10 dimes.
- He has recorded four double-doubles with points and assists, most recently against FIU where he dished out 12 dimes to go along with 10 points. Against ULM, he had 18 points and set a career high with 12 assists. Versus Southern Miss, Donaldson tallied 12 points and 11 assists. In the win over Stetson, Donaldson recorded his first double-double of his career in points and assists with 15 and 10, respectively.

▪ A year ago, Donaldson helped the Wolverines to the Big Ten Tournament title and was one of four players to start all 37 games. Last season, he averaged 11.3 points, 4.1 assists and 3.5 rebounds per game and had 26 games in which he scored 10-or-more points.

▪ Donaldson comes from an athletic family as his mother, Stacie Symonds, was a standout softball player and Florida State and was recently inducted into the USSSA Hall of Fame.

▪ His father, Rhodney Donaldson, is a member of the Troy University Athletics Hall of Fame and was drafted by the Florida Marlins in the 1997 MLB Draft.

BASED ON A TRU STORY

▪ A menace to opposing offenses, Tru Washington leads the ACC in steals (28) and steals per game (2.5).

▪ The Phoenix, Arizona, native has recorded a steal in every game including a season-high four against Bethune-Cookman and Georgetown.

▪ Washington is holding opponents to 27.4% shooting, 31.5% effective field goal, 20.7% from beyond the arc and 1-of-11 on isos.

▪ Offensively, Washington has been imposing, averaging 13.9 points per game and shooting at a 51.8% clip from the floor.

▪ Last season at New Mexico, Washington led the Lobos in steals with 71, which ranked third among all Mountain West players.

SHELTON'S STAGE

▪ Jai Lucas quickly showed South Florida his recruiting prowess, signing the fourth-highest recruit in program history by 247Sports Composite in Shelton Henderson.

▪ Henderson tied the school's freshman record for most points in a game with 30 in the win over FIU where he shot 10-of-12 from the field and 10-of-11 from the charity stripe.

▪ Henderson is fourth on the team in scoring at 13.2 points while shooting 60-of-100 (60.0%) from the floor.

▪ The freshman has scored in double figures in eight of Miami's 11 games and had his most complete game of the season at Ole Miss in which he registered season highs in points (18) and assists (5) and tied his season high in rebounds with nine.

▪ A Houston native that attended the same high school as Coach Lucas, Bellaire, Henderson was named the Houston Chronicle All-Great Houston Player of the Year.

▪ Henderson was a five-star recruit and was ranked as the No. 14 overall recruit by 247Sports. He earned a composite ranking of 0.9920.

▪ Henderson is the nephew of Pro Football Hall of Famer Eric Dickerson and his grandfather, Elmer Seals, and cousin, Ricky Seals-Jones, also played in the NFL.

THREE-MO MALOVEC

▪ Affectionately known as Timo 'Three-Mo' Malovec, the junior Slovakian leads the team in 3-pointers made with 22.

▪ Malovec is shooting the ball efficiently from beyond the arc at 41.5%, the highest on the team among qualified shooters.

▪ He had his best game of the season in the win over ULM as he scored 12 points and dished out a career-high eight assists.

▪ Against Southern Miss, he spurred the team's offense in the second half and scored a season-high 16 points.

▪ Malovec spent the last two seasons in the ABA League for Mega Superbet and represented Slovakia at the 2025 FIBA EuroBasket Qualifiers where he averaged 8.7 points and 6.0 rebounds.

CULTURE OF DEVELOPMENT

▪ Lucas's first coaching staff is full of new faces but features a wealth of experience and roots to South Florida.

- All four on-court coaches in Erik Pastrana, Charlton "C.Y." Young, Andrew Moran and Russell Springmann bring head coaching experience from all levels of basketball while Pastrana, Young and Moran hail from South Florida.
- Pastrana, who was instrument in Oklahoma State signing the No. 4 recruiting class in 2020, served as the head coach at Daytona State College and compiled a 19-12 record. Four of his players were named to the Mid-Florida All-Conference Team.
- A staple in city's basketball community Young played high school at Carrol City before playing collegiately at Georgia Southern where he ranks 14th all-time in program history in career points and still holds the school's 3-point field goal percentage record, shooting 40.9 percent in his four-year career. Young spent four seasons as the Eagles head coach and helped Georgia Southern to a second-place finish in his third season.
- Moran, who was recently named the 2025 Naismith National High School boys basketball coach of the year, comes to The U after serving as the head coach at Miami's Christopher Columbus High School for the past six years where he led the Explorers to four state championships and a 145-34 record.
- Moran founded the Miami Hoop School, a basketball skills training program in 2012 and was the first I'm Possible trainer to be introduced to the State of Florida. He has trained athletes of all levels from high school to NBA players, including

Tim Hardaway Jr, Tyler Herro and James Johnson, among others.

- Springmann brings over 20 years of coaching experience to the Miami program having progressively moved up the ranks from being a graduate assistant at Florida in 1996 to the head coach at Oral Roberts the past two seasons.
- Throughout his time coaching, Springmann has worked with 18 NBA draft picks, including the likes of Kevin Durant, LaMarcus Aldridge and Tristan Thompson. He was also an assistant coach at Texas during Lucas' two years as a Longhorn (2008-11).

HEAD COACH JAI LUCAS

FIRST SEASON AT MIAMI | 12TH SEASON OVERALL | TEXAS, 2011

Jai Lucas was named the 14th head coach of the University of Miami men's basketball program on March 6, 2024.

Lucas took over the reins of the Miami men's basketball program after spending the past three seasons at Duke, where he served as an assistant coach for one campaign before being elevated to associate head coach in 2023.

One of the nation's most respected assistant coaches and recruiters, Lucas has spent 12 overall seasons on the staffs at Duke, Kentucky and Texas, helping those programs to seven NCAA Tournament appearances.

While at Duke, Lucas played a pivotal role in helping the Blue Devils secure the nation's top recruiting class in both 2024 and 2025. As associate head coach, he served as the program's defensive coordinator. The Blue Devils finished the 2024-25 season ranked seventh in the nation in scoring defense (62.8 points per game) and fourth nationally in field goal percentage defense (38.4). KenPom rated Duke as the fifth-best defense in the country with an adjusted defense efficiency rating of 90.8.

In 2023-24, Duke's defense held opponents to 66.3 points per game, which ranked 28th nationally and second in the ACC, while the team posted records of 27-9 overall and 15-5 in conference to advance to the NCAA Elite Eight. In Lucas' first season in Durham, the Blue Devils yielded just 63.6 points per game, a .406 field goal percentage and .305 three-point percentage – each top 30 nationally and each top two in the ACC, en route to capturing the ACC Tournament championship.

Before arriving in Durham, Lucas was on staff at Kentucky for two seasons, joining the Wildcats as recruiting coordinator in August 2020 before a promotion to assistant coach/recruiting coordinator for the 2020-21 season. In two seasons in Lexington, he helped UK sign five players who played in either the McDonald's All-American or Jordan Brand Classic games and was instrumental in landing three student-athletes ranked in ESPN 100's class of 2021 rankings and two in the 2002 class.

Lucas began his coaching career at his alma mater Texas, where he spent seven seasons on staff. The Houston native began as a special assistant with the program from 2013-15 before serving as director of basketball operations in the 2015-16 season. He was promoted to assistant coach in June 2016 and, in his first year, helped the Longhorns win 20 games and earn a spot in the NCAA Tournament.

In his first two recruiting cycles as an assistant coach, Lucas helped the Longhorns ink two Top-10 signing classes. The 2017 class was rated No. 5 nationally by Rivals while the 2018 class was tapped No. 8 in the country by ESPN and 247Sports. His debut season as an assistant also helped spark a three-year streak in which a Texas freshman was selected in the first round of the NBA Draft -- Jarrett Allen (No. 22 to Brooklyn in 2017), Mohamed Bamba (No. 6 to Orlando in 2018) and Jaxson Hayes (No. 8 to Atlanta in 2019). was named before going No. 8 overall in 2019. The selection of Hayes -- the Big 12 Freshman of the Year -- meant Texas joined Duke and Kentucky as the only programs with a lottery pick in consecutive drafts.

Lucas played two seasons at Texas, helping the Longhorns earn back-to-back NCAA Tournament bids. He played at Florida as a freshman in 2007-08 and was named to the SEC All-Freshman Team. Lucas later spent three seasons in the professional ranks, including one in Latvia with BK Valmiera of the Baltic Basketball League (2011-12) and two in the NBA Development League with the Idaho Stampede (2012-13) and Canton Charge (2013).

Lucas was a McDonald's All-American, a Jordan Brand Classic selection and a Parade All-America Second Team honoree as a senior at Bellaire (TX) High School in the Houston area. He started for three seasons and was a three-time District Player of the Year while leading Bellaire to three consecutive district titles.

Lucas graduated from Texas in 2011 with a degree in corporate communication. He and his wife Kori have two sons, Jaxin and Kalib, and he has a son, Xavier. His father, John II, is a former head coach of the San Antonio Spurs, Philadelphia 76ers and Cleveland Cavaliers who most recently served as an assistant coach for the Houston Rockets. The elder Lucas played 14 seasons in the NBA after earning All-America honors in both basketball and tennis at Maryland.

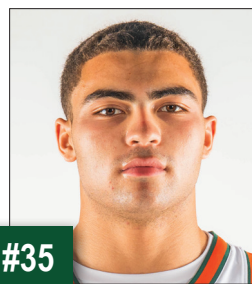
