TIP-OFF

The ULM men's basketball team (3-7) hits the road for the nonconference finale, facing the Miami Hurricanes (8-2) on Saturday (Dec. 13). Tipoff against the Hurricanes is scheduled for 11 a.m. CT in Miami.

FOLLOW THE WARHAWKS –

Saturday's game will be available on KLIP 105.3 with Mike Hammett on the call. Streaming will also be available for the game on ACCNX. Links to live stats for all games, when available, can be found at ULMWarhawks.com. Navigate to the men's basketball schedule page and select that day's opponent.

SCOUTING THE HURRICANES –

Miami sits at 8-2 on the season, claiming notable wins over Elon, Georgetown, Ole Miss and Southern Miss under first-year head coach **Jai Lucas**. Most recently, the Hurricanes extended to a three-game win streak with a 88-64 victory over Sun Belt opponent Southern Miss. **Malik Reneau**, an Indiana transfer, leads the team with a scoring average of 20.2 points per game. Reneau was also named to the Karl Malone Award Preseason Watchlist, for the top power forward in the country. TCU transfer **Ernest Udeh Jr.** was named to the Kareem Abdul Jabbar Award Preseason Watchlist, for the top center in the country. The center averages 8.9 rebounds and has 11 blocks on the season thus far.

ULM VS. P4 –

The last Power Four opponent ULM defeated was Iowa in 2007, an overtime win of 72-67. The last time the Warhawks saw a Power Five opponent was Ole Miss earlier this season. ULM has not faced an ACC opponent since 2012, when the Warhawks traveled to face Florida State.

FROM THE CHARITY STRIPE –

The Warhawks have attempted double-digit free throws in nine of their 10 contests, attempting a whopping 41 free throws against Arkansas Baptist on December 9, making 31. **Krystian Lewis** led the charge, hitting 15 of his 18 free throws. Lewis also collected double-digit free throws against Mississippi Valley State (Dec. 3), going 12-13 from the line. **LaVell Brodnex** hit a perfect 8-8 from the line against the Buffaloes last game.

DOUBLE-DOUBLES –

Lavell Brodnex has been leading the charge in rebounding since his debut for ULM on November 13 against HCU. Brodnex has scored in double figures four times and posted double-digit boards three times, leading to a double-double. Brodnex is the only Warhawk this season to register a double-double. He is currently on a streak of double-doubles, logging one against SFA (Dec. 7) and another (22 points, 18 rebounds) against Arkansas Baptist (Dec. 9).

LEADING THE TEAM –

MJ Russell leads the pack in scoring, averaging 17.4 points, placing him third in the Sun Belt. He also leads the team in three-point percentage (.370) and blocks (1.3). **Krystian Lewis** averages 3.2 assists, 1.7 steals and 34.8 minutes a game to lead the team. **Lavell Brodnex** has collected 64 rebounds across seven games, averaging 9.1 to lead the Warhawks, also leading in field goal percentage with .508.

MILESTONE MARKERS –

A handful of Warhawks have crossed milestones in the opening eight games of the 2025-26 season. Against HCU, **Renars Sondors** broke the 100-point milestone, since then reaching 152 career points. Just a game later, ULM scoring leader **MJ Russell** reach his own 100-point mark. Russell went on to reach the 200-point benchmark against Arkansas Baptist (Dec. 9). **Micah Caster** sought out that 100-point mark at ETSU, now at 101 on his career. **Krystian Lewis** broke the century mark against Mississippi Valley State, sitting at 142 career points.

INTERNATIONAL FLAIR –

The Warhawks have 15 players from six different countries, including the U.S. Noted countries include: Nigeria, Poland, Spain, Russia and Latvia. **Ayomide Bamisile** takes the cake being the farthest from home, as Monroe is 6,301 miles from Lagos, Nigeria. On the other side of things, junior **Krystian Lewis** is the basketball team's lone hometown resident, as he is from Monroe.

AT THE HELM –

Head coach **Phil Cunningham** gets started in his first year at the helm for ULM, capturing his first win as head coach against Rust College on November 10. He joins the ranks of seven other head coaches to capture their first win at the head of the ULM men's basketball program. Cunningham brings six years of Sun Belt head coaching experience, spending 2013-19 at Troy with an 80-111 record. He spent the 2024-25 season at ULM as an assistant coach, claiming the head coaching gig after former head coach Keith Richard's retirement.

NEXT UP –

The Warhawks will open conference play next week, hosting the South Alabama Jaguars in Fant-Ewing Coliseum. Tip-off for the first Sun Belt game of the season is scheduled for 6:30 p.m. on Wednesday (Dec. 17).

SATURDAY'S MATCHUP: ULM (3-7) at Miami (8-2)

SERIES HISTORY –

The Warhawks will take on the Hurricanes for the second time in program history. The lone meeting between the two teams was November 23, 2003, a neutral site game in Las Vegas, Nevada. Miami outscored ULM 78-60 in the game, as they look to continue the unbeaten streak in ULM's first trip to Miami.

LAST TIME OUT

MONROE, La. – The ULM men's basketball team secured a win over Arkansas Baptist in Fant-Ewing Coliseum on Tuesday afternoon, 79-69. The Buffaloes did their best to stay in the contest, securing three lead changes throughout the game.

Both teams shot 38% from the field, while the four triples for ULM were the difference-maker to Arkansas Baptist's one. Notable was also ULM's free throw shooting, as fouls led to the Warhawks attempting 41 free throws, making 31.

Lavell Brodnex led the charge with 22 points and 18 rebounds, notching the most rebounds by a Warhawk in a game since 2020. Brodnex also secures his second-consecutive double-double. Also in 20-point scoring was MJ Russell, who collected four boards, two assists and three blocks. Krystian Lewis registered 19 points in a game where he hit 15 free throws, also posting three assists and a steal. To round out double-digit scoring, Renars Sondors hit a triple to reach 10 points, along with seven rebounds and two blocks.

It was Arkansas Baptist that started off the scoring, Christopher Hood hitting a jumper in the first 10 seconds. Russell returned the favor for the Warhawks, a layup tying the score. Following that opening shot, however, ULM had trouble getting a shot to drop in the early minutes. The Buffaloes tied the game and captured the lead, the home team playing catch-up. The tides began to turn when Brodnex slammed down a dunk for the lead, Sondors notching a triple to extend it further. The Brodnex dunk led to a 10-0 scoring run for the Warhawks, able to notch the double-digit lead.

All five ULM starters were able to score in the opening half, as Arkansas Baptist began to chip away at the deficit. A six-minute scoring drought for the Warhawks gave the Buffaloes the chance to swing the pendulum in their favor, but both teams had trouble getting points on the board. Sondors broke the drought with a long jumper, as the Buffaloes worked to keep it close, cutting the lead as low as three points with two minutes on the clock. But ULM kept things at arm's length, making it a 32-24 advantage at the half.

Sondors opened the scoring in the second half with an immediate opening layup, looking to set the standard for the Warhawks. But an 8-0 scoring run for the visiting team had ULM clawing to maintain the lead as the advantage whittled down to four. Even as the Warhawks held onto the lead, the Buffaloes were not going away quietly.

ULM was able to pick up the pace in the final minutes of the half, going on a 7-0 run to sit comfortably in a double-digit advantage. The Buffaloes continued to foul, giving the Warhawks opportunities for 25 free throws in the second half. The free throw shooting tipped ULM over into the double-figure advantage, capturing the 79-69 win.

Cunningham served as the assistant coach for the Warhawks during the 2024-25 season and takes the reigns of the storied ULM men's basketball program after Keith Richard announced his retirement.

Cunningham was hired at Troy University in 2013 as the Trojans' head men's basketball coach. He served as the head coach at Troy for six seasons until 2019. As the head coach, Cunningham transformed Troy from a program that was facing serious APR penalties into a winning culture on and off the court. In 2017, the Trojans captured their first Sun Belt Conference Tournament Championship in school history and reached March Madness for just the second time ever. Cunningham's team had the biggest wins turnaround in school history during the 2016-17 season and finished with the most wins (22) since the 2003-04 season.

Cunningham signed and coached two of the most talented players in Troy basketball history in Wesley Person Jr. and Jordon Varnado, who both hold the top two spots on Troy's all-time leading scorers list. Person Jr. was a four-time All-Sun Belt selection and became the second player in conference history to be named all-conference in four consecutive seasons. He was voted 2017 SBC Tournament MVP and was the 2015 SBC Freshman of the Year and holds the conference record for most career 3-point field goals (361). Varnado was a three-time All-SBC honoree and was recognized on the 2017 Sun Belt All-Tournament Team and 2018-19 Julius Erving National Small Forward of the Year Watch List.

While at Troy, Cunningham prioritized academic achievement. In the classroom, Troy earned the highest team GPA in the Sun Belt during the 2016-17 academic year. Under Cunningham's watch, the Trojans won two Sun Belt Team Academic Awards with all 16 players who competed as seniors earning their degrees.

As an assistant coach, Cunningham had two separate stints at Western Kentucky, where he was an associate head coach from 2019-23 and an assistant coach during the 2012-13 season. As an associate head coach, Cunningham led the Hilltoppers to the 2021 Conference USA Regular Season title and an NIT Quarterfinals appearance. In his first stint as an assistant coach in Bowling Green, the Hilltoppers earned an NCAA Tournament berth after winning four games in four days at the SBC Tournament to claim WKU's second-straight conference title. The Hilltoppers narrowly fell to No. 1 seed Kansas by seven points in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament.

Cunningham spent 12 seasons as an assistant coach at Mississippi State from 2000-12 under Rick Stansbury. While in Starkville, Cunningham was a part of six NCAA Tournament appearances and 10 total postseason appearances. The Bulldogs won five Southeastern Conference Western Division crowns, one regular season conference championship and a pair of SEC Tournament titles during Cunningham's tenure as an assistant. Mississippi State averaged over 20 wins per season during Cunningham's 12 seasons in Starkville.

All 12 recruiting classes Cunningham was involved with at Mississippi State were nationally recognized. Cunningham helped sign highly touted prospects such as Jarvis Varnado, Jamont Gordon, Arnette Moultrie, Charles Rhodes and 2004 Gatorade National Player of the Year Monta Ellis, who went directly to the NBA after signing with Mississippi State.

Before Mississippi State, Cunningham spent five seasons as an assistant coach under Naismith Hall of Fame head coach Charles "Lefty" Driesell at James Madison and Georgia State. Cunningham, who was promoted to Driesell's associate head coach his final two seasons at GSU, was instrumental in helping transform the Panthers into one of the winningest basketball programs in the Atlantic Sun Conference. His recruiting efforts at Georgia State proved pivotal in the Panthers landing successive conference player of the year recipients Thomas Terrell and Shernard Long.

Prior to moving to Georgia State with Driesell in 1997, Cunningham spent the 1995-96 and 1996-97 seasons as an assistant coach on the staff of Driesell at James Madison.

Cunningham's first job as a head basketball coach was at Sue Bennett College in London, Ky. Taking over a former junior college program making the jump to four-year competition in the NAIA, Cunningham paced Sue Bennett to 48 victories during his three seasons at the helm of the Dragons, including postseason tournament appearances during each of the school's first two years of postseason eligibility status.

Cunningham cut his teeth at the Division I level at Mississippi State as a graduate assistant for the 1991-92 season, where he learned from head coach Richard Williams, who led the Bulldogs to a Final Four appearance in 1996. He earned a master's degree in physical education with an emphasis in sports administration from Mississippi State.

Cunningham began his coaching career in the 1990-91 season as an assistant coach on his father's staff at Campbellsville University after graduating with a bachelor's degree in business administration. He helped lead the Tigers to the District 32 championship and an appearance in the NAIA Tournament.

After graduating from Taylor County, Cunningham began his collegiate playing career at Kentucky Wesleyan and won a NCAA Division II National Championship in 1987. Citing a desire to play for his highly respected father, Cunningham subsequently transferred to Campbellsville College, now Campbellsville University, where he finished his career ranked among the school's all-time leaders in career assists.

Cunningham has one daughter, Shelby, who holds an undergraduate degree from the University of Buffalo and master's degree from Columbia University.
