PROJECT OWNERSHIP / LOCATION / ROLES

The Owner of the project is Mid-Peninsula Water District (District). The project is located entirely within the Palo Alto Medical Foundation (PAMF) property in the City of San Carlos, California.

West Yost Associates is the project Engineer of Record. John Goodwin, Vice President will be the main point of contact.

PCG will be assisting the District with construction administration services. Kurt Wurnitsch, Senior Engineer will be the main point of contact.

District staff will be inspecting the project. Michael Anderson, Filed Operations Supervisor will be the main point of contact.

PROJECT SUMMARY

The project consists of constructing approximately 700 LF of 12-inch Class 350 DIP, along the onsite PAMF access road, including:

- The new water main will be constructed within a 15' wide permanent easement and access provided by a temporary construction easement (attached) between the District and PAMF as shown on the plans,
- Anode test stations,
- Associated tie-ins and appurtenances as shown on the plans,
- Work also includes roadway restoration including traffic striping and slurry seal.

There will be some concrete flatwork (side walk, curb and gutter, vertical curb, etc.) replacement, which will be paid under various bid items. All concrete flat work shall confirm to existing dimensions per the PAMF record improvement plans.

CITY OF SAN CARLOS ENCROACHMENT PERMIT

Since no work is proposed within the public right-of-way an encroachment permit is <u>not</u> required by the City of San Carlos.

BID DUE DATE, TIME OF COMPLETION

Sealed proposals must be received by the District at 3 Dairy Lane, Belmont, CA 94002, by **Thursday, August 27, 2020 at 2:00 PM**. Proposals received after 2:00 PM will not be accepted.

The District intends to award the project at the Board of Directors **September 24, 2020** meeting with construction beginning in October.

The time of completion of this project from the issue of Notice to Proceed is 30 working days.

BIDDER QUALIFICATIONS

The BIDDER must possess a valid Class A Contractor's license in the State of California at the time of CONTRACT award and throughout the CONTRACT term.

The Contractor must have performed work on three (3) water main installation projects over the last five (5) years. In addition, the project foreman must verify that he/she was in charge of at least five (5) previous projects, three (3) of which are exclusively water main installation projects.

Only contractors who purchase the bid documents from the District qualify to submit bid proposals. The payment must be received prior to bid opening day.

WORK SCHEDULE AND REQUIREMENTS

Construction activity is allowed between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. No work shall be performed on weekends or holidays.

TRAFFIC CONTROL

Traffic control and detailed detour plans for on and off-site road closures shall be prepared and signed by a licensed civil engineer, reviewed by the District, reviewed/approved by PAMF, and reviewed/approved by the City of San Carlos within the public right-of-way.

During slurry seal operation, only one lane closure will be allowed along the on-site PAMF access roadway with traffic control personnel.

PLAN/ SPECIFICATION OVERVIEW

Potholing - Utility locations and clearances are approximate. The Contractor shall pothole for utilities sufficiently in advance of construction to adjust the grade of the water main to maintain desired clearances. No pipe shall be installed until potholing for the entire project is complete. No additional payment will be made for grade adjustments of less than 24-inches unless extra materials are required, such as fittings or concrete encasement.

ENGINEERING ESTIMATE

Engineering estimate for this project is \$400,000.00

STAGING AREAS

Overnight storage of materials and equipment in the public right-of-way is not allowed. The Contractor is responsible for securing their own storage yard.

Bid Item No. 4 – Revised from Contractor will be responsible for construction staking to the District or West Yost Associates will be responsible for construction staking.

Pipe Separation - Plans show 5' clearance between existing PAMF (private) 8-inch sanitary sewer line and new 12-inch water main (centerline to centerline). A copy of the State Water Resources Control Board Division of Drinking Water waiver request letter dated February 10, 2020 is attached.

Total Length of Water Main Pipe – Revised quantity from 696 LF to 674 LF to match Bid Schedule Item No. 4 quantities.

Dear Ms. Rudock:

The State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) Division of Drinking Water (Division) reviewed the Mid-Peninsula Water District's (MPWD) revised waiver request dated January 28, 2020 for the Phase 1 State Route 101 Crossing at Palo Alto Medical Foundation Water Main Improvement Project. The new waiver request proposes shifting the water main another one foot horizontally south-east, which will increase the horizontal separation from the existing 8-inch diameter gravity sanitary sewer to five (5) feet.

The above horizontal separation distance between the proposed water main and the sanitary sewer is greater than the previously-proposed horizontal separation of four (4) feet but is still less than the regulatory requirement of ten (10) feet. The revised plans also indicate that the vertical separation distance between the proposed waterline and the sewer main ranges from five to seven feet. To mitigate the condition of the water pipeline not meeting the horizontal separation requirement specified in Section 64572, Title 22, California Code of Regulations (CCR), MPWD proposes encasing the water main with control density fill, in addition to the use of the following upgraded materials and improvements to minimize the potential for contamination: (a) DR 12 C900 PVC pipeline with restrained joints; (b) In areas with shallow cover, class 350 DIP with hot dip bituminous coating and restrained joints; and (c) No joints in the water mains within 8-feet of a utility crossing.

TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT

This Temporary Construction Easement ("Agreement") is entered into as of April 23, 2020 (the "Effective Date") by and between Sutter Bay Medical Foundation dba Palo Alto Medical Foundation for Healthcare, Research and Education (San Carlos Center), a California nonprofit, public benefit corporation ("Grantor" or "PAMF") and the Mid-Peninsula Water District, a public corporation organized under the provisions of Division 12 of the Water Code of the State of California ("Grantee" or "MPWD").

Recitals

- A. Grantor owns the real property located in San Carlos, San Mateo County, California ("Grantor Parcel").
- B. Grantor and Grantee are parties to that certain Pipeline Easement Agreement dated June 13, 2012, as amended by that First Amendment to Pipeline Easement Agreement dated April 23, 2020 (collectively, the "Pipeline Easement Agreement").
- C. Grantee desires to obtain a temporary construction easement on the Grantor Parcel for the purposes contained herein.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants set forth below, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Grantor and Grantee hereby agree as follows:

1. <u>Grant of Easement</u>. Subject to the conditions described below, Grantor hereby grants to Grantee and its contractors and any subcontractors, engineers, consultants, suppliers and their respective employees solely for the purpose of performing services or providing materials of and related to the scope of work of Grantee as contemplated hereunder (collectively, the "Contractors") a temporary, non-exclusive right ("Temporary Construction Easement") to use a portion of the Grantor Parcel, a legal description for which is set forth at Exhibit A, and a map of which is set forth as Exhibit B attached hereto (the "Temporary Construction Easement Area") for the purposes of moving construction equipment and installing underground water pipelines ("Pipelines").

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- 2. <u>Easement Term</u>. The Temporary Construction Easement shall begin upon the earlier of (1) the commencement of installation of the Pipelines or (ii) the Effective Date of this Agreement and shall terminate on November 30, 2020 ("**Term**"). Notwithstanding the foregoing, Grantee may commence work on any day of the month following the Effective Date.
- 3. <u>Indemnification</u>. Grantee for itself and on behalf of its successors and assigns, hereby agrees to and shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless Grantor and its officers, directors, managers, partners, members, shareholders, employees, agents, contractors successors and assigns from all liability, penalties, costs, losses, damages, expenses, causes of action, claims and judgments (including reasonable attorneys' fees) including death or injury of any person or damage to property (each, a "Claim") suffered or incurred by any of them and directly or indirectly arising or resulting from or in connection with this Agreement or from any use or misuse by any person of the Temporary Construction Easement but excluding any Claim that is the direct result of Grantor's sole and active negligence or intentional misconduct.
- 4. <u>Maintenance of Easement</u>. During construction of the Pipelines, Grantee shall keep the Temporary Construction Easement Area in reasonable repair and shall minimize, in a commercially reasonable manner, any disruption of or interference with Grantor's use and operation of the Grantor Parcel.
- 5. <u>Mechanic's Liens and Removal of Liens</u>. Grantee shall keep the Temporary Construction Easement Area free and clear of all design professional's mechanic's or materialmen's liens which may arise out of any construction on the Temporary Construction Easement Area. To the extent any such liens are recorded against the Grantor Parcel or Temporary Construction Easement Area as a result of such work, Grantee shall immediately cause such lien to be released and removed.
- 6. <u>Insurance</u>. During the course of construction and installation of the Pipelines, Grantee will maintain in full force and effect the insurance policies specified in Section 7 of the Pipeline Easement Agreement.
- 7. <u>Attorneys' Fees.</u> In any action or proceeding arising from or relating to this Agreement, the prevailing party will be entitled, in addition to any other relief, to recover from the other party its reasonable attorneys' fees and costs and costs of its experts and consultants in connection with the action or arbitration.
- 8. Recording. Grantor acknowledges that Grantee intends to record this Agreement with the appropriate recording officer upon execution of this Agreement.
- 9. <u>Entire Agreement</u>. Grantor and Grantee agree that this Agreement contains all of the agreements, promises and understandings between Grantor and Grantee. Any addition, variation or modification to this Agreement shall be void and ineffective unless made in writing and signed by the parties hereto.
- 10. <u>Covenant of Further Assurances</u>. The parties hereby agree to execute such other documents and perform such other acts as may be necessary or desirable to carry out the purposes of this Agreement.
- 11. <u>Partial Invalidity</u>. If any term, covenant or condition of this Agreement or its application to any persons or circumstances will be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this Agreement and the application of such term or provision to other persons or

circumstances will not be effected, and each term hereof will be valid and enforceable to the fullest extent permitted by law.

- 12. <u>Governing Law</u>. This Agreement and the performance thereof shall be governed, interpreted, construed and regulated by the laws of the State of California.
- 13. <u>Binding Effect</u>. This Agreement shall inure to the benefit of and be binding upon the successors and assigns of the parties hereto.
- 14. <u>Counterparts</u>. This Agreement may be executed in several counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, and all such counterparts together shall constitute one and the same instrument. The signature page of any counterpart may be detached therefrom without impairing the legal effect of the signature(s) thereon provided such signature page is attached to any other counterpart identical thereto.
