MPWD customers have answered the call to conserve water in response to the statewide emergency drought. Thanks to you, we have exceeded our initial goal of 10% water conservation for 2014. Working together and being water wise, *we have saved 15.9%* so far!*

On the heels of the SWRCB*** emergency water savings regulations, MPWD has adopted additional mandatory water conservation measures:

- ✓ *No outdoor landscape watering between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m.*
- ✓ *20% reduction in outdoor irrigation*
