Tier 1	0 - 2 hcf	\$6.51	\$6.97
Tier 2	3 - 8 hcf	9.34	
Tier 3	9 - 20 hcf	11.25	11.71
Tier 4	Over 20 hcf	13.15	13.61

Commercial Rate Tiers

Tier 1	0 - 5 hcf	\$8.45	\$8.91
Tier 2	Over 5 hcf	9.81	10.27

Note: 1 hcf = one hundred cubic feet or approximately 748 gallons.

The rates effective July 1, 2023:

- Direct pass-through of SFPUC wholesale water rate adjustment; and
- Cover revenue requirements for MPWD operations and continuation of capital improvement projects.
