# AUTHORIZING A FY 2021-2022 OPERATIONS BUDGET AMENDMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100,000 TO THE LAWN-BE-GONE PROGRAM

### **MID-PENINSULA WATER DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, the Mid-Peninsula Water District (District) has encouraged customer water conservation through rebate programs such as Lawn-Be-Gone for a number of years; and

WHEREAS, the governor issued an executive order on July 8, 2021, asking Californians to reduce water use by 15-percent from the previous year; and

WHEREAS, the District water supplier, the SFPUC, has also requested wholesale customers, like the District, to voluntarily reduce water consumption by 15-percent from the previous year; and

WHEREAS, the Board approved a budget line item in the amount of \$20,000 for the Lawn-Be-Gone rebate program during FY 2021/2022; and

WHEREAS, the District has received and is processing a Lawn-Be-Gone application for a Homeowner's Association to remove over 15,000 square feet of lawn, which would yield a rebate in excess of \$60,000, or more than the current budget for the Lawn-Be-Gone program; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of achieving its water conservation targets, the District will further promote the Lawn-Be-Gone program to encourage customer use of the remaining budgeted funds.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Directors of the Mid-Peninsula Water District hereby increases the FY2021/2022 budget line item for the Lawn-Be-Gone rebate program by \$100,000 for a new budget of \$120,000.
