## GENERAL RULES

1. **All exhibitors must be amateur beer makers and reside in the county of San Luis Obispo or Santa Barbara.**
2. Please indicate when registering the style of beer to ensure proper judging. BJCP 2015 Style Guidelines
3. Registration is to be done online.
4. Entries must be received between the dates allotted.
5. Each entry consists of two (2) 12 oz. bottles for all classes.
6. Print out entry receipt and rubber band around each bottle accordingly.
7. Due to health and safety regulations, upon submission to the contest, all entries become the property of the California Mid-State Fair.
8. Entries will not be returned to entrant. Score sheets will be mailed to exhibitor with ribbons in a timely manner.
9. Any entry received after the deadline will not be judged or returned.
10. This competition uses [BJCP 2015 Style Guidelines](#)
11. Each exhibitor can purchase up to TWO (2) \$6 one-day entrance tickets. You can purchase when you are adding entries to your cart. They will be mailed in July prior to Fair time. These passes are nonrefundable.
